GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Small pier or tender; no deep-water cruise terminal. Mostly boutique and expedition ships call here.

Best For: Colonial history, UNESCO architecture, pirate fortifications, Mayan archaeology.

Walk to Center: ~10-15 min walk or short taxi ride from the waterfront to the historic walled city.

Don't Miss: Strolling the Baluartes (bastions), Calle 59, and the panoramic views from Forte de San Miguel.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **UNESCO Walled City Walking Tour** — Walk the circuit of 17th-century bastions (Baluartes) built to repel pirates, pass through the Puerta de Mar and Puerta...
- **Edzná Mayan Ruins** — About 55 km from the city, Edzná is one of the Yucatán Peninsula's most impressive — and least crowded — Mayan sites.
- **Fuerte de San Miguel & Archaeological Museum** — This hilltop 18th-century fort southwest of the city houses the Museo Arqueológico de Campeche, displaying...
- **Malecón Stroll & Calle 59** — Walk the breezy Gulf waterfront promenade past sculptures and monuments, then head into the walled city via Calle 59...
- **Los Petenes Biosphere Reserve Boat Tour** — North of the city, the Los Petenes reserve protects one of Mexico's most unusual ecosystems — freshwater springs...

BEST WALKS

- **Baluartes Circuit Walk** 2 km loop | ~45 min | Easy, flat — Walk the full circuit of Campeche's 17th-century defensive bastions that ring the historic center.
- **Calle 59 to the Malecón** 1.5 km one-way | ~20 min | Very easy — Enter the walled city through the inland Puerta de Tierra (Land Gate), walk the length of Calle 59 — the most photogenic street in...
