GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River mooring on the Tartaro-Canalbianco; ships tie up directly at the bank

Best For: Venetian villa architecture, cycling the Po plain, quiet Veneto countryside

Walk to center: Canda village center is steps from the mooring — flat, easy walk

Don't Miss: Villa Nani Mocenigo and its garden of stone statues

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  €30–€50 to Rovigo (~20 km); confirm in advance

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Villa Nani Mocenigo & Historic Mansions** — The 16th-century Villa Nani Mocenigo (also known as Villa Bertetti) is Canda's star attraction — a sprawling manor with...
- Day Trip to Rovigo** — The provincial capital Rovigo (~20 km east) is well worth a half-day.
- Cycling the Po Plain** — The flat Polesine landscape around Canda is perfect cycling country.
- Churches of Canda** — Two churches make a short walking loop: the parish Chiesa di San Michele Arcangelo on Piazza Dante Alighieri...
- Po Delta Regional Park** — About 30-40 km southeast, the Po Delta is one of Italy's most important wetland reserves — a UNESCO candidate ecosystem...

BEST WALKS

- Canda Village Mansions Walk** ~1 km | 20-30 mins | Easy | Flat riverbank town — From the ship mooring, walk along the Canalbianco towpath into the village center.

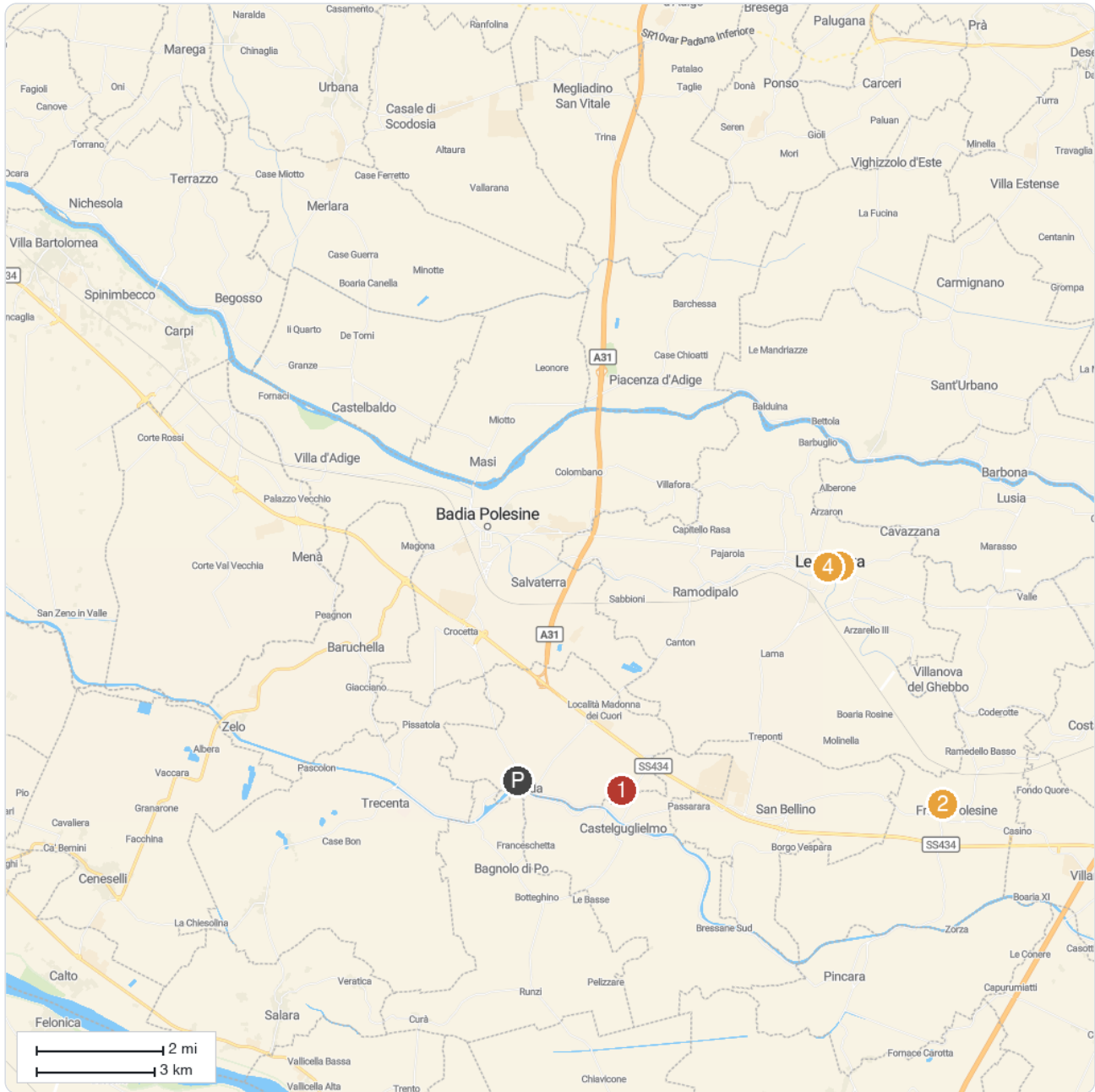
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Overnight stop: Canda is typically an overnight port call — ships arrive in the evening and depart late morning. You have peaceful morning hours to explore before most tourists...
- Bikes beat taxis here: Ask your ship if bikes are available. The flat Polesine plain is ideal cycling territory and much of what's worth seeing is reachable on two wheels.
