TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Tobago Cays Marine Park Boat Trip** — A 20–30-minute speedboat ride drops you into a protected lagoon where sea turtles graze on sea grass and coral gardens...
- **Grand Bay Beach Day** — The long white-sand arc of Grand Bay is a short walk or taxi ride from the jetty.
- **Snorkeling Canouan's Reefs** — Canouan is ringed by extensive coral reefs — its Atlantic side holds one of the Caribbean's longest barrier reefs.
- **Mount Royal Hike** — The island's highest point rewards the climb with sweeping views across the Grenadines — Mustique, Mayreau, and Union...
- **Golf at the Jim Fazio Championship Course** — Canouan's 18-hole course was designed by Jim Fazio and sits above the Caribbean with dramatic sea views on every hole.

BEST WALKS

- **Charlestown Village Stroll** 30 min · Flat · Paved — A short loop from the jetty through the village.
- **Jetty to Grand Bay Beach** 20–25 min walk · Flat — Head north from the jetty along the road to reach the long sandy arc of Grand Bay.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash, preferably USD or EC dollars. Card readers are rare outside resort properties. Eastern Caribbean Dollars (EC\$) give you the best rates locally; USD are universally...
- Taxis are extremely limited. Disembark early if you need a driver, and always negotiate a flat rate and a specific jetty return time before you set off.
- Book Tobago Cays before you sail. Tours sell out quickly on busy ship days. Pre-booking through your cruise line or a local operator guarantees your spot.
