Docking: Cape Town Cruise Terminal (E-Berth, Duncan Dock)

Walk to centre: Short walk/shuttle to Waterfront shops & restaurants; 20-min Uber to City Bowl

Don't miss: Table Mountain cable car or hike; Robben Island ferry

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Table Mountain Cable Car** — Ride the revolving cable car to the 1,086 m summit for sweeping views over the Cape Peninsula, harbour, and Robben...
- **Robben Island** — Board the ferry from the V&A Waterfront for a guided tour of the island where Nelson Mandela was imprisoned for 18 years.
- **Boulders Beach African Penguins** — Drive 45 minutes to Simon's Town to walk among a colony of African penguins on a sheltered beach.
- **Cape Point & Cape of Good Hope** — Journey to the dramatic tip of the Cape Peninsula — sheer cliffs, wild ocean, and the famous Cape Point lighthouse.
- **Cape Winelands — Stellenbosch & Franschhoek** — Head 40 minutes inland to the Cape Winelands for estate tastings, award-winning restaurants, and mountain scenery.

BEST WALKS

- **V&A Waterfront & Clock Tower Stroll** 1-2 hrs · Easy · Free — Explore the working harbour directly from the terminal.
- **Green Point to Sea Point Promenade** 2-3 hrs · Easy · Scenic — Uber or walk to Green Point and follow the paved Sea Point Promenade along the Atlantic Ocean.

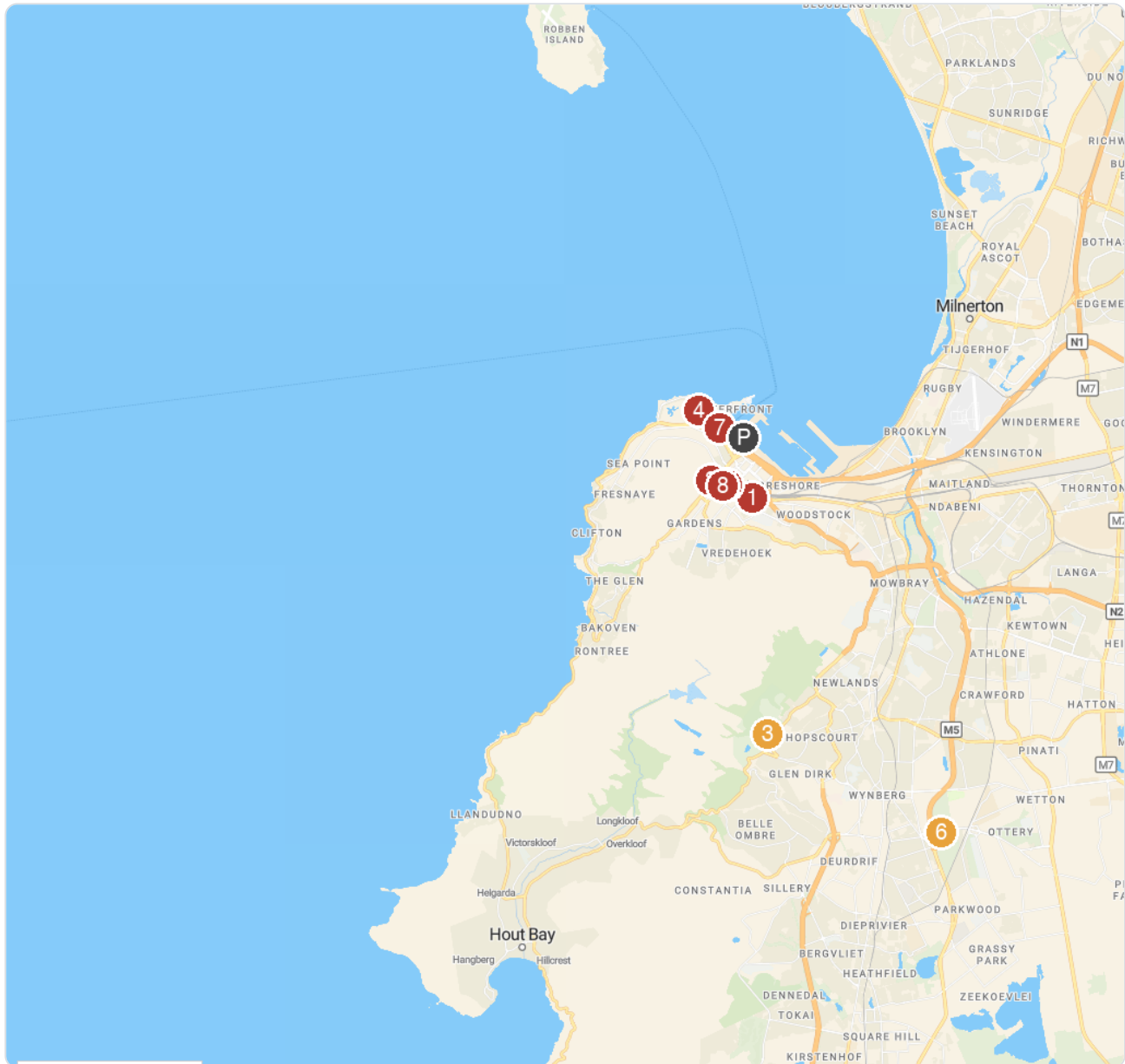
