GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — all ships anchor offshore and tender to Marina Grande

Walk to center: Funicular or bus from Marina Grande to Capri Town (5 min / €2)

Don't Miss: Blue Grotto, Faraglioni rock arch, Gardens of Augustus

Getting around: Taxi €17–€25 fixed fare · Rideshare not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Blue Grotto (Grotta Azzurra)** — Row into this sea cave to experience its otherworldly electric-blue glow, caused by sunlight refracting through an...
- Boat Tour Around the Island** — Circumnavigate Capri by motorboat to see the Faraglioni sea stacks, the White and Green grottos, and the dramatic...
- Villa Jovis & Roman Ruins** — Hike 45 minutes from the Piazzetta along Via Tiberio to Emperor Tiberius's largest imperial villa (1st century AD).
- Monte Solaro Chairlift, Anacapri** — Ride the single-seat chairlift from Anacapri's Piazza Vittoria to the island's highest point (589 m) for 360° views...
- Capri Town & Gardens of Augustus** — Stroll the iconic Piazzetta, wander Via Camerelle's boutiques, then slip into the Gardens of Augustus for tiered...

BEST WALKS

- Piazzetta to Villa Jovis** 4 km round trip | ~2 hrs | Moderate (uphill) | Mostly paved — From the Piazzetta, follow Via Longano → Via Sopramonte → Via Tiberio up to the Roman ruins.
- Gardens of Augustus & Via Krupp Viewpoint** 1 km | 30–45 min | Easy | Paved — A short stroll from the Piazzetta through the Giardini di Augusto to the panoramic belvedere overlooking the Faraglioni and the famous...
- Sentiero dei Fortini (Coastal Trail)** 5 km one-way | ~2.5 hrs | Moderate | Rocky coastal path — Capri's most scenic hike connects three Napoleonic-era forts (Orrico, Mesola, and Pino) along the wild western coast between the Blue...

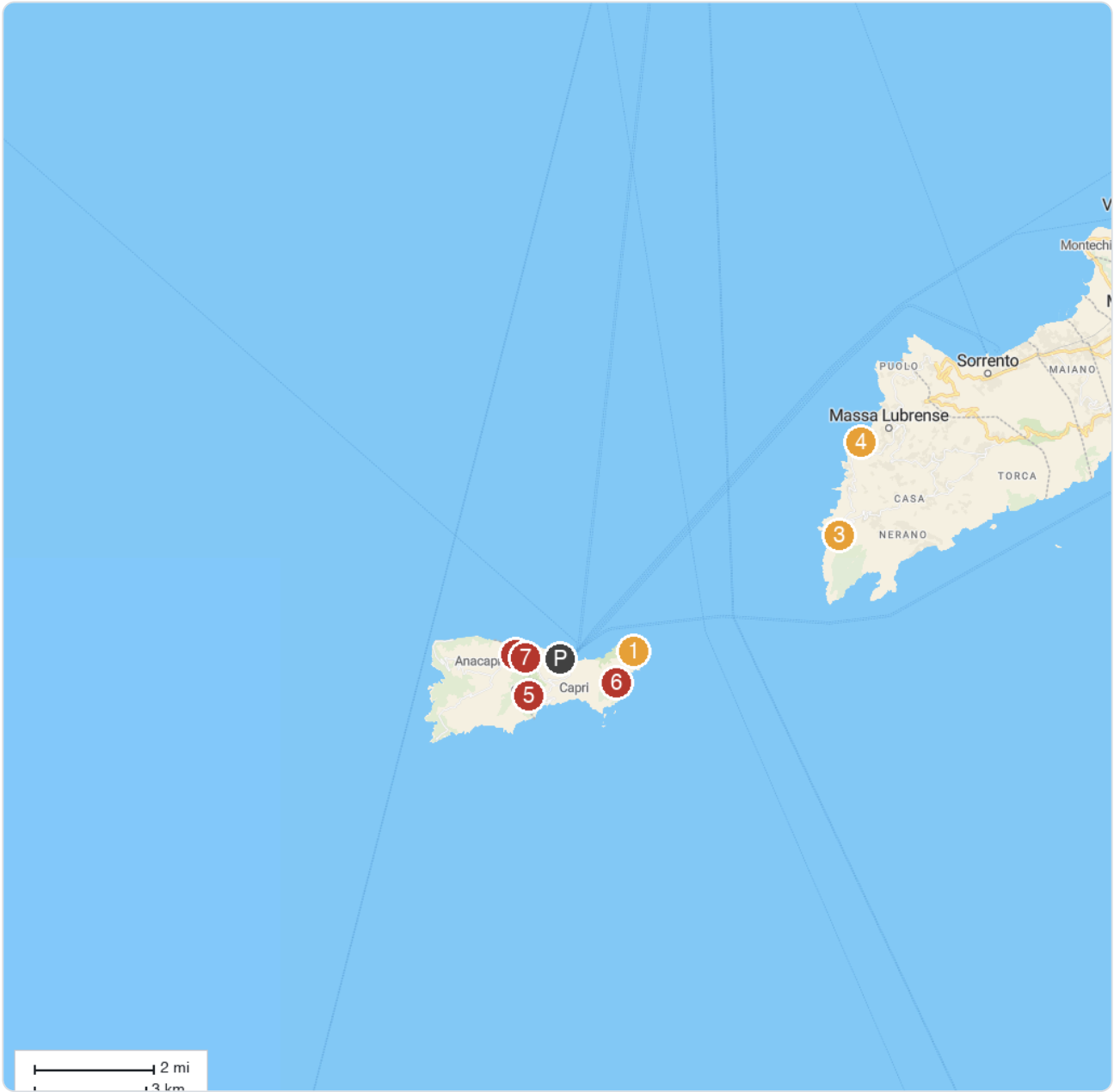
