- Hassan II Mosque — Interior Tour** — One of the world's largest mosques, with a 210-metre minaret visible from the sea and sections of the prayer hall built...
- Art Deco & Mohammed V Square** — Casablanca's French colonial architects blended Art Deco with Moorish arches in the 1930s to create a distinctive...
- Habous Quarter (New Medina)** — Built by the French in the 1930s to relieve overcrowding, the Habous Quarter is a planned medina — orderly lanes of...
- Rabat Day Trip** — Morocco's elegant capital is ~1 hr by train (Casa-Port → Rabat-Agdal) and a world away from Casablanca's bustle.
- Corniche Ain Diab & Coast** — The Atlantic seafront west of the Hassan II Mosque — a long promenade of cafés, the El Hank lighthouse, and crashing...

BEST WALKS

- Mohammed V Square to Habous Quarter** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — Start at Mohammed V Square to take in the Art Deco civic buildings, then walk south through the new town's broad avenues to the...
- Hassan II Mosque to Corniche** ~1.5 km · 45 min · easy — After the mosque tour, walk north-west along the Corniche (Boulevard de la Corniche / Boulevard Sidi Mohammed Ben Abdallah) past the...
- Old Medina wander** ~1 km · 45 min · moderate — Casablanca's walled old medina is small by Moroccan standards but atmospheric — crumbling Portuguese-era ramparts, spice vendors...

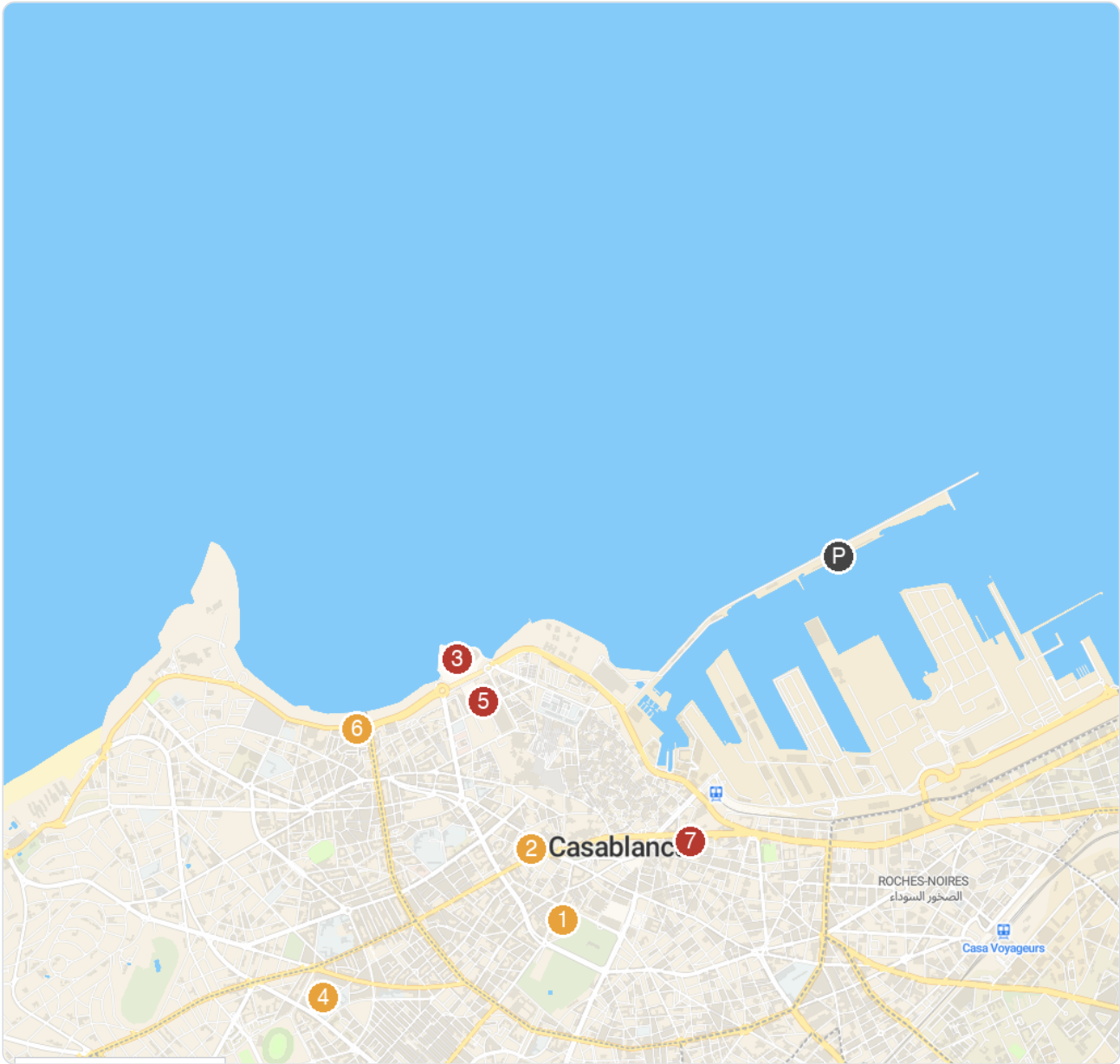
