GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Larger ships anchor in Cascais Bay and tender; smaller vessels berth at Cascais Marina. Town center is a 5–10 min walk from the marina

Best For: Beach days, Sintra day trips, seafood, scenic coastal walks

Walk to center: 5 min to Largo Luís de Camões; 20 min to Boca do Inferno

Don't Miss: Boca do Inferno sea arch, Museu Condes de Castro Guimarães, Praia da Rainha

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Sintra UNESCO Day Trip** — A 30–40 min bus or taxi ride brings you to Sintra's fairy-tale hilltop palaces.
 - **Boca do Inferno Walk** — A 20-minute clifftop walk west of the marina leads to Hell's Mouth, a dramatic sea arch eroded from the Atlantic-facing...
 - **Cascais Citadel & Museums** — The 17th-century Citadel of Cascais served as a royal summer residence and now
- houses a boutique art hotel and...

 - **Bike to Guincho Beach** — Rent an e-bike or standard bicycle in town and follow the 10 km coastal cycle path through Sintra-Cascais Natural Park...
 - **Lisbon by Train** — Hop the Linha de Cascais from Cascais station to Cais do Sodré in central Lisbon (40 min, ~€2.30).

BEST WALKS

- **Marina to Boca do Inferno** 4 km round trip · Easy · ~1 hr — From the marina gate, follow the coastal road (Avenida Rei Humberto II de Itália) west past Santa Marta Lighthouse and the Condes de...
- **Cascais to Estoril Promenade** 3 km one way · Easy · ~45 min — A flat, paved seafront promenade runs east from Cascais past beaches and gardens to Estoril.
- **Old Town Stroll** 1–2 km · Easy · ~1 hr — Wander from the marina into Largo Luís de Camões, the main square, then thread through pedestrian streets to the Museu Condes de...

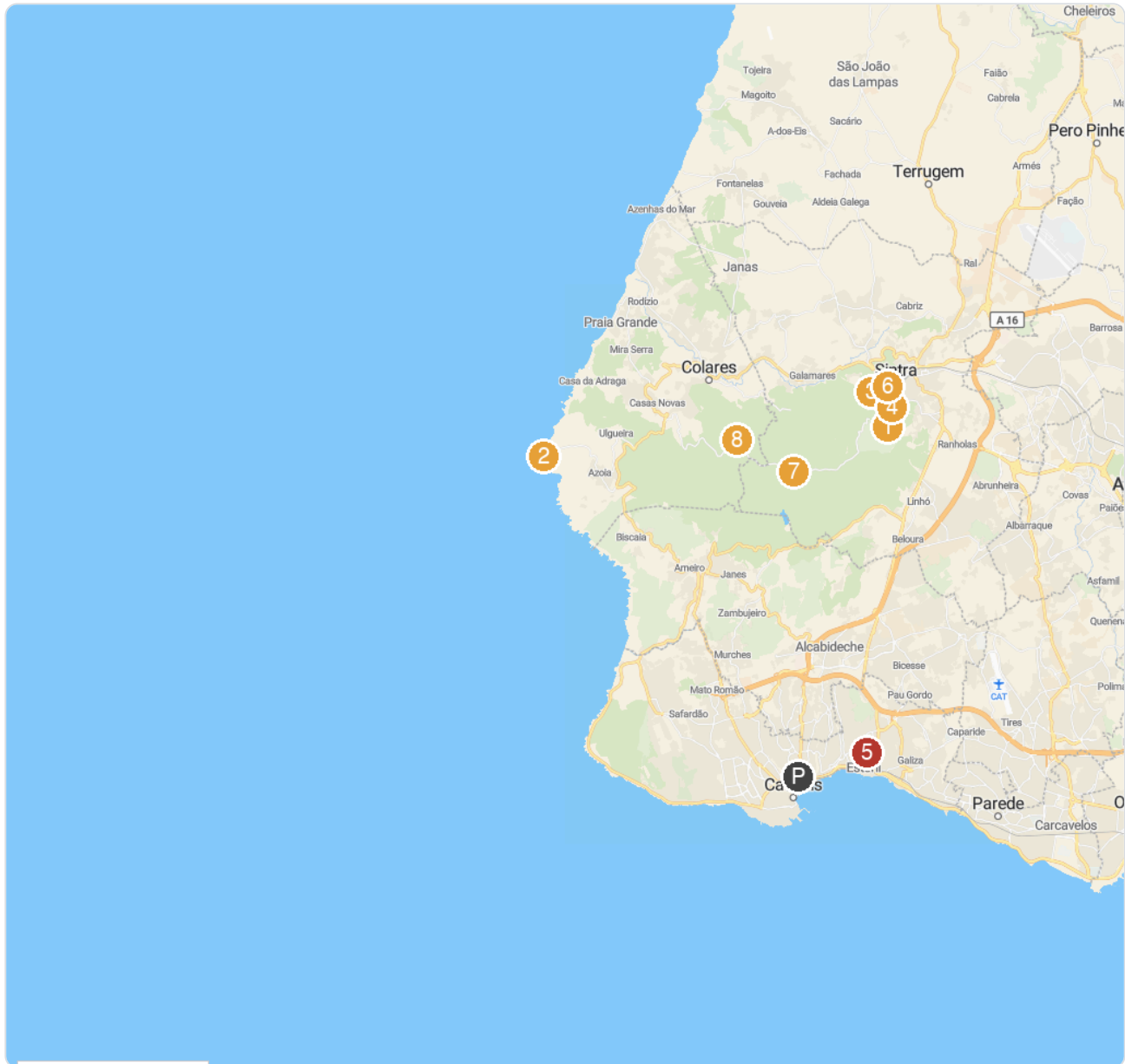

- 1 National Palace of Pena** A colorful Romanticist palace atop a Sintra hill.
- 3 Quinta da Regaleira** A mysterious estate with palace, gardens, and initiation well.
- 5 Casino Estoril** Historic, grand casino, one of Europe's largest.
- 7 Parque Natural de Sintra-Cascais** A protected natural park with diverse landscapes and coastline.
- P Cruise port / terminal**

- 2 Cape Roca** Europe's westernmost mainland point with stunning ocean views.
- 4 The Moorish Castle** Ancient ruins of a hilltop medieval castle with views.
- 6 National Palace of Sintra** Medieval royal palace known for its iconic twin chimneys.
- 8 Capuchos Convent** Rustic, cork-lined Franciscan convent built into nature.
