

Castellammare di Stabia, Campania, Italy

Perched at the foot of Mount Fauto on the Gulf of Naples, Castellammare di Stabia hides Roman villas buried by Vesuvius, mineral springs prized since antiquity, and a waterfront that launches ferries straight to Capri and the Amalfi Coast.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Docked at Stabia Main Port; pier is a short walk or taxi ride from the town center

Best For: Roman archaeology, thermal baths, day trips to Pompeii, Capri ferry

Walk to Center: ~15 min walk to Lungomare and Piazza Fontana Grande

Don't Miss: Free Roman villas at Scavi di Stabia — Villa Arianna and Villa San Marco

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Scavi di Stabia — Free Roman Villas** — Villa Arianna and Villa San Marco are lavishly frescoed Roman resort villas buried by Vesuvius in 79 AD.
- **Mount Fauto by Cable Car** — The funivia (cable car) climbs from the town center to the forested summit of Monte Fauto at 1,100 m, rewarding you...
- **Pompeii Day Trip** — Castellammare di Stabia is one stop from Pompeii on the Circumvesuviana train — a 15-minute ride puts you at the UNESCO...
- **Terme Stabiane Thermal Baths** — Castellammare's mineral springs have been bottled since Roman times.
- **Capri Ferry Day Trip** — Fast ferries to Capri depart year-round from the port, making it one of the closer embarkation points for the island.

BEST WALKS

- **Lungomare & Historic Center Stroll** 2 km · 45 min · Easy · Flat — Walk north from the port along the Lungomare waterfront to Villa Comunale (public gardens with the 1900 Cassa Armonica bandstand)...
- **Cable Car to Monte Fauto Summit** Funivia ride · 2-3 hrs round trip · Easy (cable car) · Best Apr–Oct — From the funivia station near Piazza Vittorio Veneto, the cable car lifts you to Monte Fauto's forest plateau in about 15 minutes.

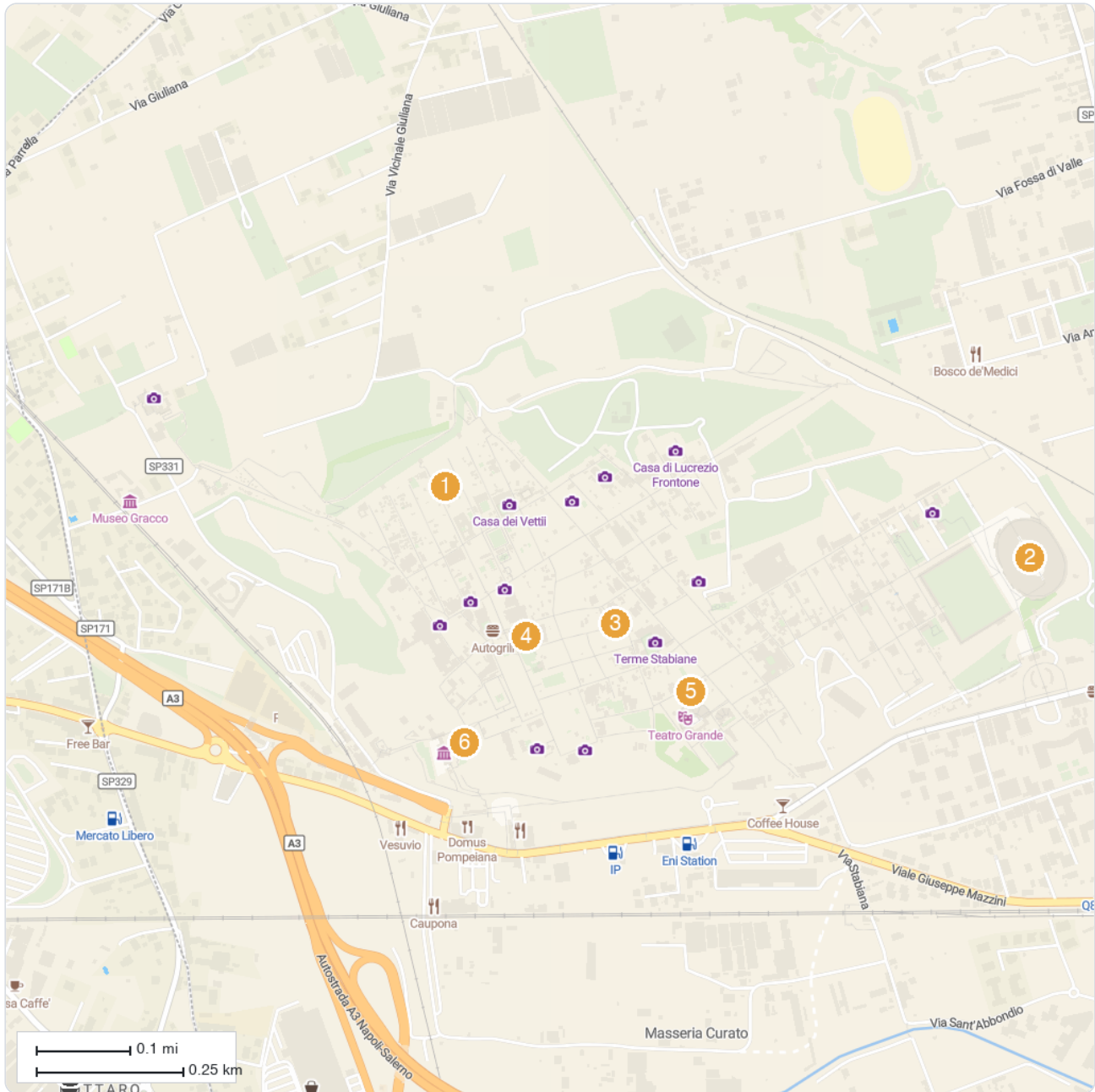
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Scavi di Stabia is free. Villa Arianna and Villa San Marco charge no admission — rare for a site this impressive. Go early; there's no crowd control as at Pompeii.
- Use the Circumvesuviana Pompeii Scavi station is one stop away. Buy a round-trip ticket (a few euros) at the station near the
