GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth at Puerto de Castellón (El Grao), ~4 km from the city centre; free shuttle bus provided

Best For: History lovers, beach days, foodies, day trips to Peñíscola or Valencia

Walk to centre: Not walkable from port — free shuttle or taxi to Plaza Mayor (~10 min ride)

Don't Miss: Climbing El Fadri bell tower for panoramic rooftop views over the city

TOP THINGS TO DO

- El Fadri Tower & Cathedral** — The 16th-century octagonal bell tower stands 60 m tall beside the Concatedral de Santa María.
- Day Trip to Peñíscola** — Drive about 50 minutes north to the 'Papal City,' where Papa Luna Castle — a 13th-century Templar fortress that later...
- Coves de Sant Josep** — Float through Europe's longest navigable underground river in these stunning limestone caves at La Vall d'Uixó, about...
- Valencia City Day Trip** — Spain's third city is under an hour away and delivers the City of Arts and Sciences, La Lonja market (UNESCO), and the...
- Columbres Islands Boat Trip** — These remote volcanic islands about 30 nautical miles (~50 km) offshore are a protected marine reserve — superb...

BEST WALKS

- Historic Centre Loop** 2–3 km · 1.5–2 hrs · Easy — A stroll taking in all the main monuments within a few blocks of Plaza Mayor.
- El Grao Seafront Stroll** 2 km · 45 min · Easy — Walk the maritime promenade in the port district, past the fishing harbour and seafood restaurants, ending at Playa del Pinar.

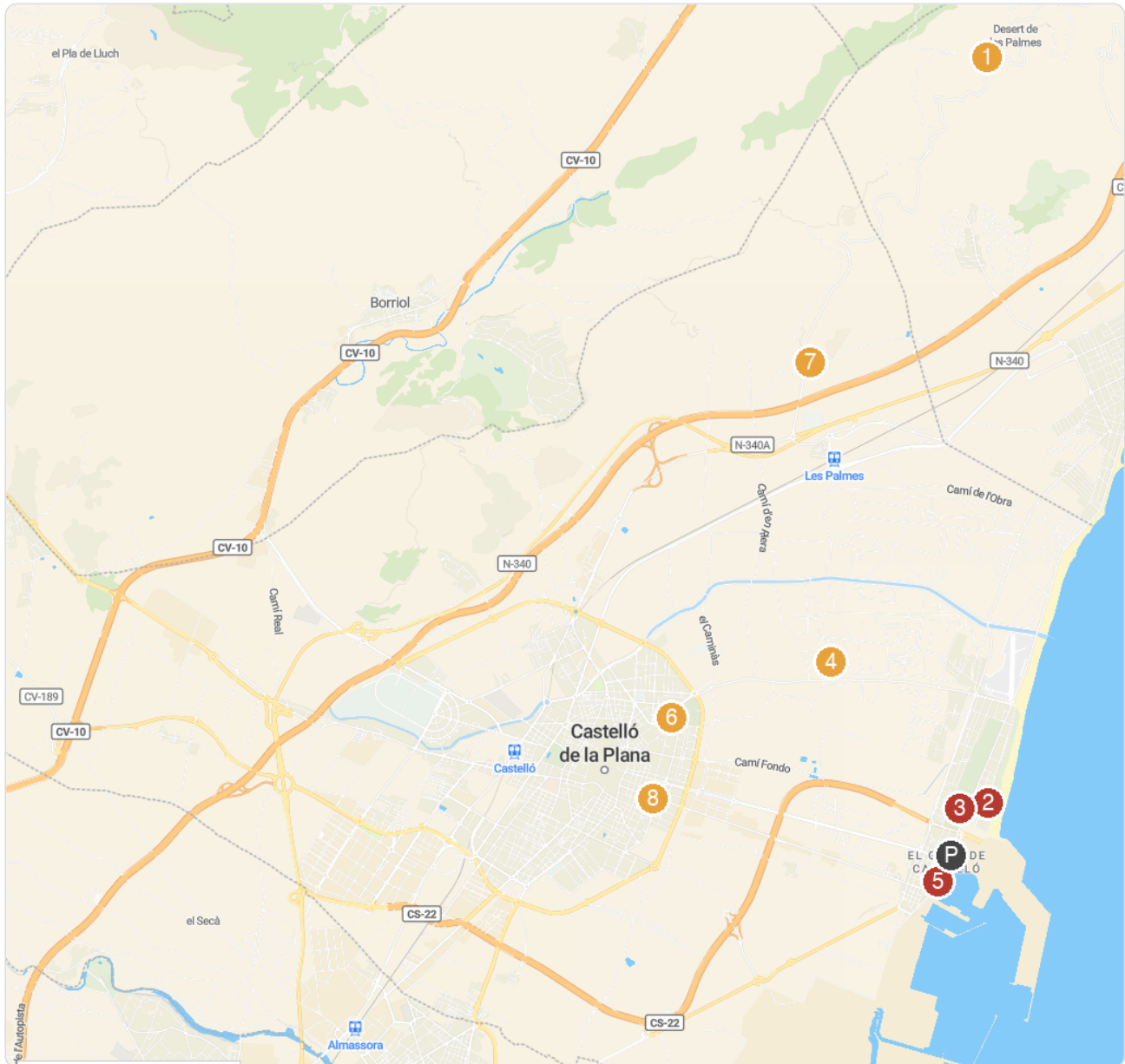
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Take the free shuttle. The port is too far to walk to the city centre — the complimentary bus saves you ~€10 in taxi fares each way.
- Peñíscola needs a full half-day. Allow at least 4 hours for the drive, castle visit, and old town — don't try to squeeze it in with Valencia on the same call.
