

Castine, Maine, USA

One of the oldest continuously settled towns in North America, Castine sits at the tip of a peninsula on Penobscot Bay — four centuries of French, British, Dutch, and American history wrapped in a compact, elm-shaded village that's entirely walkable from the Town Dock.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Fort George & Historic Markers Walk** — Fort George (1779) is the site of the Penobscot Expedition — America's worst naval defeat before Pearl Harbor.
- Sea Kayaking on Penobscot Bay** — Castine Kayak Adventures runs guided half-day paddles around the peninsula — seals, porpoises, osprey, and dramatic...
- Witherle Woods Preserve Hike** — 193 acres of coastal forest with 4+ miles of trails maintained by Maine Coast Heritage Trust.
- Tapley Cove Oyster Tasting Trip** — Castine Cruises runs boat trips to a working sustainable oyster farm at Tapley Cove where you can learn the harvest...
- Golf Cart Historic Tour** — The Castine Touring Company offers 60–90 min narrated tours of the town's highlights in a six-passenger golf cart, led...

BEST WALKS

- Town Dock to Fort George Loop** 1.5 miles · 45–60 min · Easy — From the dock, walk up Main Street to the elm-lined Common, then up Battle Avenue to the Fort George earthworks for harbor views.
- Witherle Woods Preserve Loop** 2–3 miles · 1-2 hrs · Easy–moderate — Head west from town to the Maine Coast Heritage Trust trailhead.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender timing:** Collect your tender ticket as soon as boarding opens — queues form fast on small ships. The harbor can be choppy; tender rides take about 10 minutes.
- Entirely walkable:** You don't need a tour or taxi. The historic district, Fort George, and most restaurants are within 15 minutes' walk
