- Thomas Cole National Historic Site** — Visit the restored home and studio of Thomas Cole, the founder of the Hudson River School of painting.
 - Olana State Historic Site** — Cross the Rip Van Winkle Bridge to Frederic Church's ornate Persian-inspired hilltop estate with sweeping Hudson Valley...
 - Kaaterskill Falls Hike** — The Catskills' most famous waterfall — a two-tiered, 260-foot drop that inspired
- generations of Hudson River School...

 - Main Street Walk & Galleries** — Catskill's revived Main Street is lined with art galleries, the Magpie Bookshop, antique stores, and cafés like Citiot.
 - Rail Explorers: Catskills Division** — Pedal a four-wheeled rail bike along the historic Ulster & Delaware Railroad through mountain scenery — a fun...

BEST WALKS

- Dutchman's Landing to Main Street** 0.6 mi · 15 min · Flat — Follow the riverfront path west from the pier into town.
- Main Street to Thomas Cole House** 0.4 mi · 10 min · Easy — From Main Street, head south on Spring Street to reach the Thomas Cole National Historic Site on Cedar Grove.

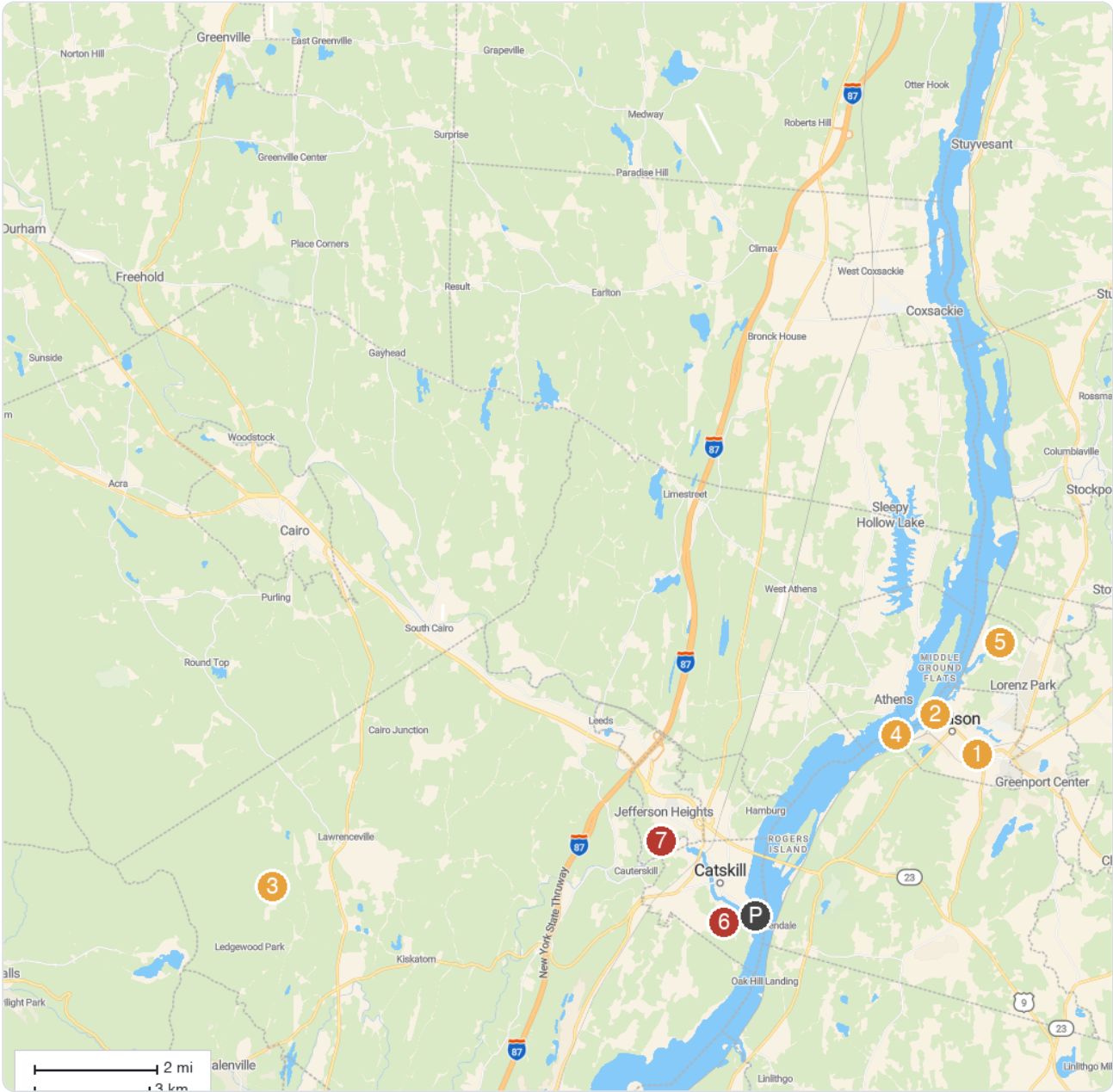
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Pack layers. Catskill sits at the foot of the mountains — weather can be cool and changeable even in summer. Bring a light jacket.
- Rent a car for mountains. Kaaterskill Falls, Olana, Hunter Mountain, and North-South Lake are all 20–45 minutes away — not walkable from the pier.
