

Cayman Brac, Cayman Islands

The wilder sister of Grand Cayman, Cayman Brac trades duty-free malls for dramatic limestone bluffs, cathedral-clear dive sites, and caves once used by pirates. Cruise ships tender into Scott's Dock, and from there the whole island is yours to explore.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Scott's Dock, West End (south shore)

Walk to Center: Stake Bay ~4 miles east — taxi or rental car recommended

Best For: Divers, hikers, cave explorers, nature lovers

Don't Miss: MV Captain Keith Tibbetts wreck dive & the Bluff Lighthouse trail

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **MV Captain Keith Tibbetts Wreck Dive** — A deliberately scuttled Soviet-era frigate lying in roughly 50-85 ft of crystalline water — one of the Caribbean's top...
- **Bluff Lighthouse Hike** — Walk the 2.5-mile Lighthouse Footpath along the dramatic limestone edge of The Bluff to the island's highest point.
- **Limestone Cave Exploration** — Cayman Brac is riddled with caves — Peter's Cave, Rebecca's Cave (linked to the 1932 hurricane), Bat Cave, and the...
- **Brac Parrot Reserve** — A roughly 280-acre reserve protecting the rare, endemic Cayman Brac Parrot.
- **Snorkel & Beach at Public Beach** — Public Beach on the south coast offers calm, gin-clear water and healthy shallow reef.

BEST WALKS

- **West End Coastal Stroll** 1-2 miles · easy · from dock — From Scott's Dock head along the south-shore road through the quiet West End settlement.
- **Stake Bay Town Walk** ~1 mile · easy · town centre — Short taxi or drive east brings you to Stake Bay, the island's main settlement.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender timing is critical. Get your tender ticket early and note the last-tender time from the ship's daily programme — it's typically 60-90 minutes before All Aboard.
- Rent a car for freedom. Stake Bay is 4 miles from the dock; the caves and lighthouse are further east. A car unlocks the whole island. Drive on the left.
- USD accepted everywhere. Cayman Islands Dollars are the local currency but US dollars are universally accepted. Change will be returned in CI\$ — worth slightly more than USD.
