GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships berth directly at Pier 2 (commercial cargo port; no cruise terminal building)

Best For: Waterfalls, Hindu temples, coffee highlands, Lovina's black-sand beaches

Walk to Center: Nothing walkable from the pier — private driver or tour bus required

Don't Miss: Ulun Danu Beratan Temple on Lake Beratan and Sekumpul Waterfall

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  ~IDR 450,000 (\$28–\$30 USD) one-way

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Ulun Danu Beratan Temple** — Bali's most photographed water temple floats on misty Lake Beratan in the central highlands, its multi-tiered shrines...
- **Sekumpul & Munduk Waterfalls** — Sekumpul — widely considered Bali's most spectacular waterfall — plunges through jungle canyon in multiple cascades.
- **Lovina Beach & Dolphin Watching** — Just 30 minutes from the port, Lovina's quiet black-sand beaches offer a calm alternative to Bali's crowded south coast.
- **Munduk Coffee Plantation Tour** — Bali's highland Munduk region grows arabica and robusta coffee in cool volcanic soil.
- **Singaraja Colonial Town** — Bali's former Dutch colonial capital retains crumbling European facades, Chinese shophouses, and a working port...

BEST WALKS

- **Lovina Beach Stroll** Easy • ~1 km • Flat — From the main Lovina beachfront, walk the black-sand shore past outrigger jukung fishing boats toward the dolphin statue landmark.
- **Singaraja Harbour & Old Town Walk** Easy • ~1.5 km • Flat — Start at the Buleleng Harbour esplanade and walk inland along Jalan Ahmad Yani to the old Dutch-era shophouse district.
