 - Tetouan, Morocco Day Trip** — Cross the border into Morocco and explore Tetouan's UNESCO-listed medina — whitewashed streets, artisan souks, and a...
- Maritime Park of the Mediterranean** — Designed by César Manrique, this waterfront park features saltwater lakes, waterfalls, and botanical gardens.

BEST WALKS

- Port to Royal Walls & Old Town Loop** 2–2.5 km · 45–60 min · Easy — Walk from the cruise pier through Plaza de España to Plaza de África, then follow the fortification walls south to the Royal Walls and...
- Cathedral & House of the Dragons** 1 km · 20–30 min · Easy — A short stroll from the port to the Cathedral of Santa María de la Asunción and the nearby Casa de los Dragones — a whimsical building...

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Duty-free zone: Ceuta has no VAT. Tobacco, alcohol, perfume, and electronics are noticeably cheaper than on the mainland — a popular reason to visit.
- Morocco requires your passport: If you plan to cross into Morocco, carry it. Leave passports on the ship at your peril — border agents require them.
