

Champion Islet, Floreana, Galapagos, Ecuador

A tiny volcanic islet off Floreana, Champion is famous for some of the clearest snorkeling in the Galapagos — sea lions, hammerheads, and green turtles all in one swim. No landings allowed; the magic is entirely in and around the water.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: No pier or landing — zodiac/panga access only from expedition cruise ship

Best For: Snorkeling, sea lion encounters, rare birdwatching (Floreana Mockingbird)

Location: Off the north coast of Floreana Island, southern Galapagos Archipelago

Don't Miss: The coral wall snorkel and a panga ride to spot the critically endangered Floreana Mockingbird

Getting around: Rideshare not available

- Champion Islet Snorkel** — Swim the crystal-clear waters around the islet to encounter playful Galapagos sea lions, green sea turtles, hammerhead...
- Panga Wildlife Cruise** — Zodiac rides around the islet's rugged shoreline offer close-up views of Galapagos penguins, blue-footed and Nazca...
- Floreana Island Combination Day** — Many itineraries pair Champion Islet with nearby Floreana Island, adding a visit to the Post Office Bay barrel (a...
- Scuba Diving — Champion Wall** — The submerged coral wall at Champion is a renowned drift dive site covered in black and yellow corals, with frequent...

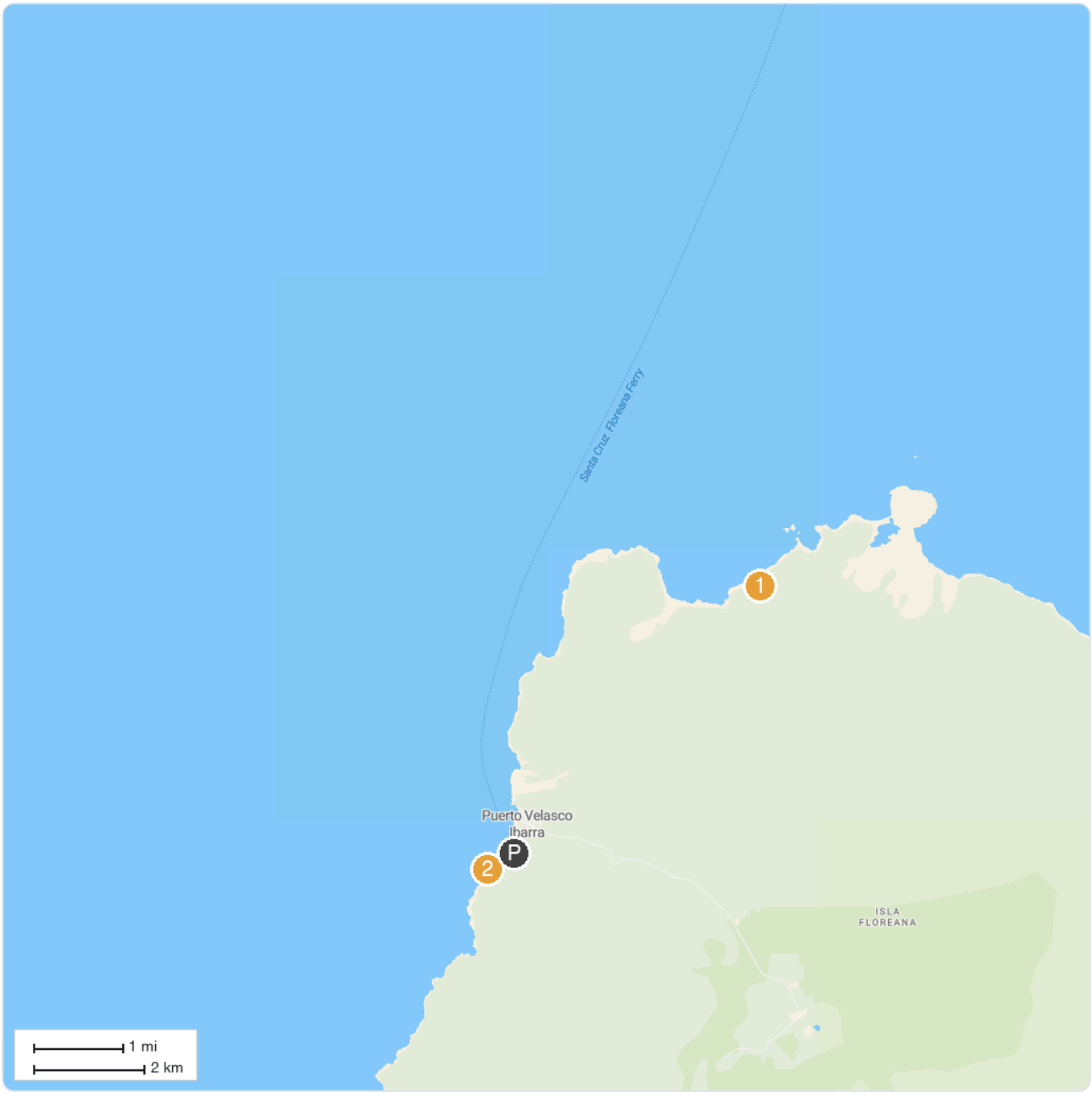
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring your own snorkel gear if possible. Rental gear is available on most expedition ships, but a well-fitting mask makes a big difference in these strong currents.
- Currents can be strong. Champion Islet experiences moderate to strong currents — stay close to your guide and don't fight the water.
- Watch quietly for the Floreana Mockingbird. With fewer than 40 individuals on the islet, sightings are special — keep noise low and follow your naturalist guide's cues.
