GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Man-O-War Bay jetty — no cruise pier

- **Pirate's Bay Snorkel & Swim** — A short boat ride (or 165-step descent on foot) reveals Pirate's Bay — calm, crystal-clear water with healthy coral and...
- **Argyle Waterfall Hike** — Tobago's tallest waterfall cascades 175 feet in three tiers through lush rainforest.
- **Main Ridge Forest Reserve Walk** — The oldest legally protected rainforest in the Western Hemisphere (est.
- **Lover's Bay Boat Tour** — Accessible only by boat from the Man-O-War Bay jetty, Lover's Bay is a secluded pink-sand cove with crystal water ideal...
- **Scuba Diving — NE Tobago Reefs** — Northeastern Tobago is home to over 50 established dive sites, and nearby Speyside boasts the largest brain coral in...

BEST WALKS

- **Man-O-War Bay Beachfront Stroll** 1 km · 20 min · Easy · Flat — Walk the golden-sand beach from the village jetty westward along Man-O-War Bay.
- **Flagstaff Hill Viewpoint** 2 km round trip · 45 min · Moderate · Uphill — A signposted track rises steeply from the village to Flagstaff Hill, rewarding the effort with panoramic views across Man-O-War Bay...

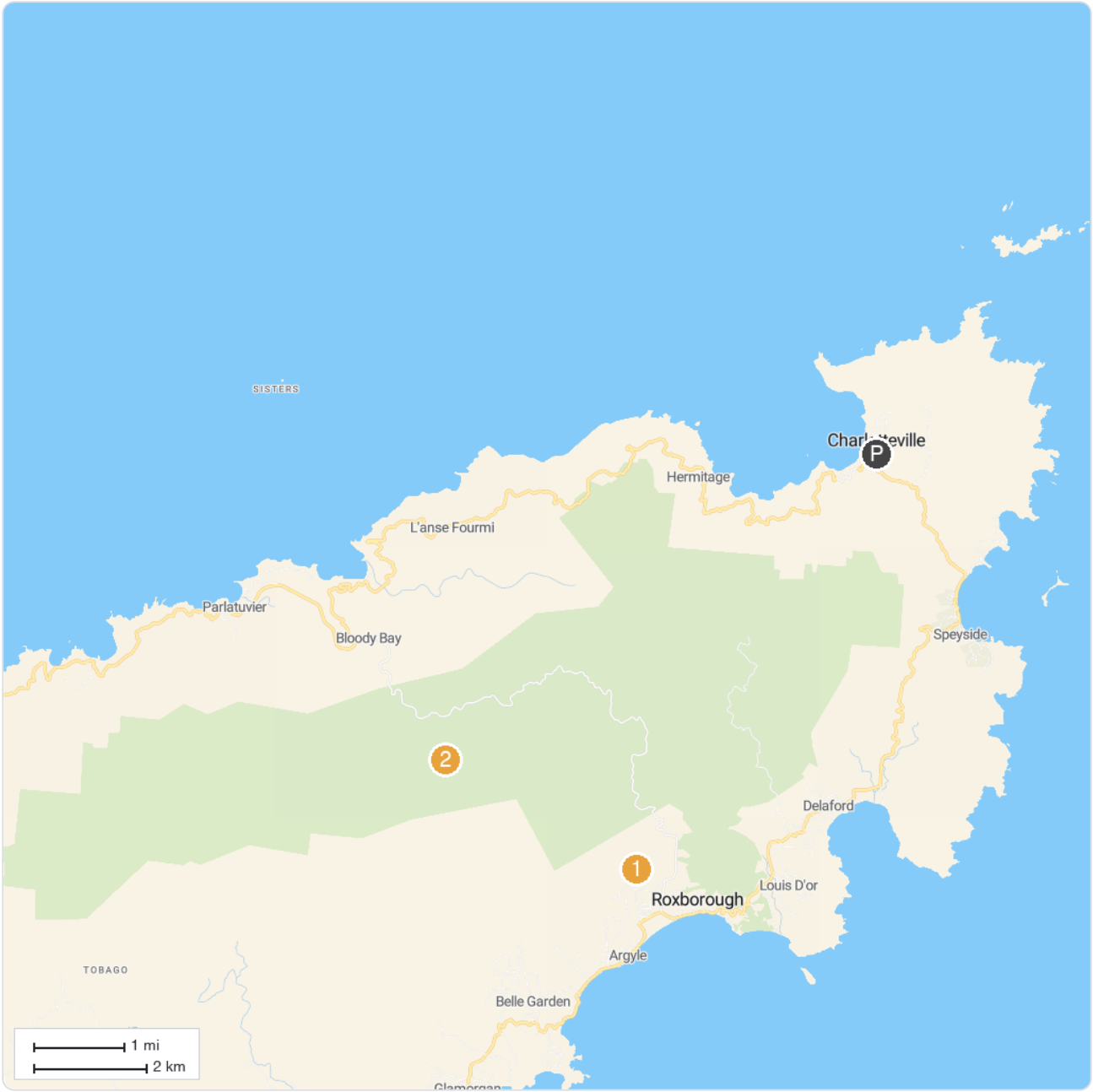
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender timing: Lines for the last tender can be long. Aim to re-board at least 45 minutes before all-aboard time — the anchorage is short but delays happen.
- Cash is king: Charlotteville has very limited ATM access and machines are often empty. Bring TTD or small USD bills for taxis, boat tours, and food.
