GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cruise ships berth at the Cienfuegos wharf; the historic center is about a 10-12 min walk

Best For: Colonial architecture, Cuban culture, day trip to Trinidad (UNESCO)

Walk to center: ~10-12 min on foot to Parque José Martí and the UNESCO historic core

Don't Miss: Teatro Tomás Terry, Palacio de Valle rooftop, and a horse-taxi ride along Paseo del Prado

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **UNESCO Historic Center Walk** — Parque José Martí is the heart of it — Cathedral de la Purísima Concepción, Teatro Tomás Terry, and the Provincial...
- **Castillo de Jagua** — This 18th-century Spanish fortress guards the entrance to Cienfuegos Bay.
- **Trinidad Day Trip** — Cuba's most photogenic colonial city is just 80 km away.
- **El Nicho Waterfalls & Pools** — In the Escambray mountains, El Nicho is a series of turquoise pools and cascades with jungle hiking trails.
- **Jardín Botánico de Cienfuegos** — One of Cuba's finest botanical gardens, with over 2,000 tropical plant species including 400+ orchid varieties.

BEST WALKS

- **Paseo del Prado & Parque José Martí Loop** 2-3 hrs | Easy | 2-3 km — Start at the pier and follow the waterfront to Parque José Martí.
- **Malecón to Punta Gorda** 1-1.5 hrs | Easy | 2 km — Walk the Malecón south from the city center to the Punta Gorda peninsula.

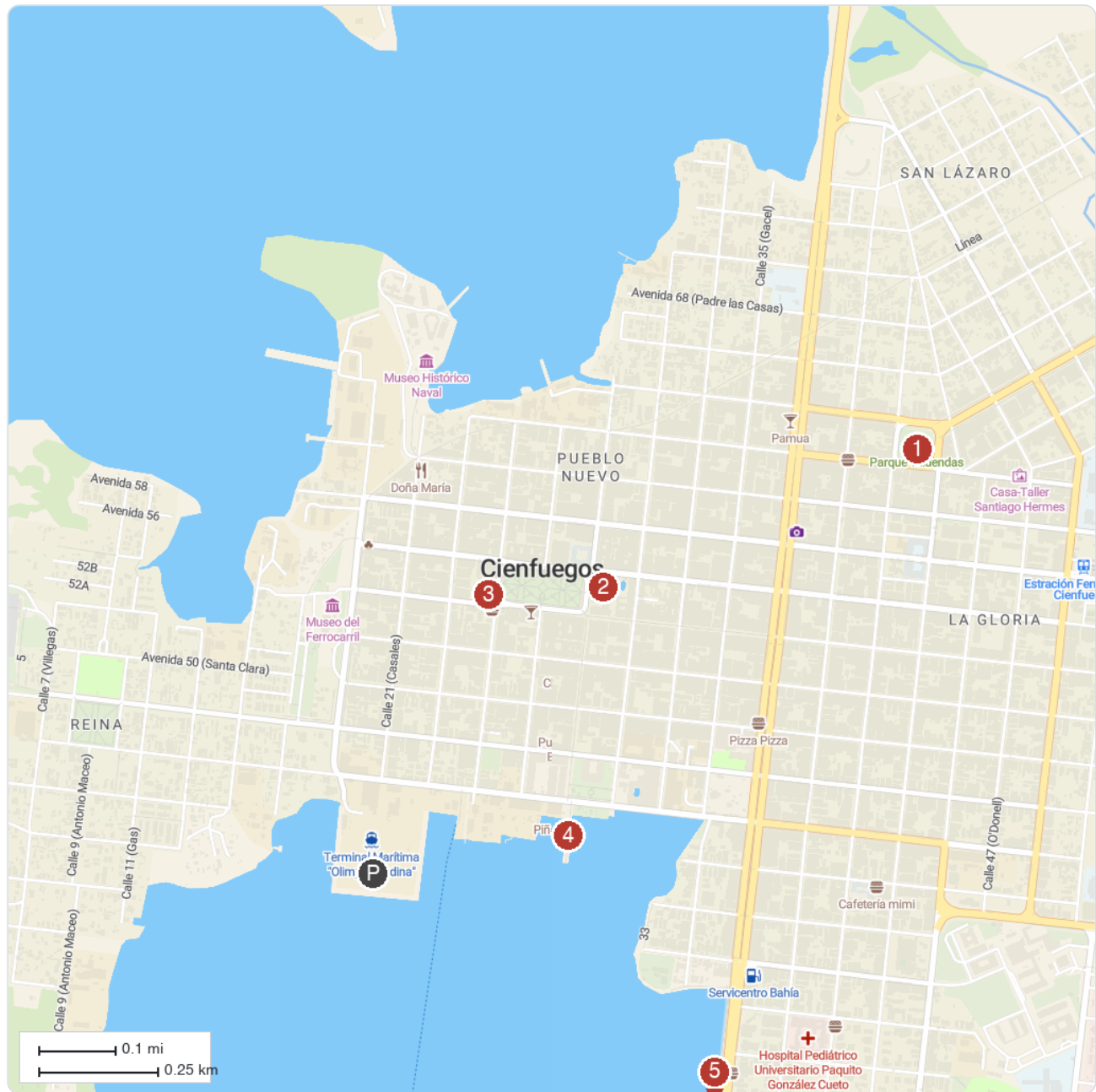
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Currency: Cuba now primarily uses the Cuban Peso (CUP). Bring Euros or Canadian dollars for exchange — US dollars face an extra tax. ATMs are unreliable; bring cash.
- Negotiate taxis upfront: Classic car taxis are iconic and fun, but agree on the price before you get in. For the botanical garden, expect ~\$10-15 CUC equivalent per car.
