- **National Underground Railroad Freedom Center** — One of America's most moving museums, sitting right on the riverfront where freedom seekers once crossed the Ohio River.
- **Over-the-Rhine Historic District** — The largest intact urban historic district in the US, OTR is packed with 19th-century Italianate buildings now housing...
- **Cincinnati Museum Center at Union Terminal** — A spectacular 1933 Art Deco rail terminal housing the Cincinnati History Museum, Museum of Natural History & Science...
- **Findlay Market & OTR Brewery Scene** — Ohio's oldest continuously operated public market (est.
- **Ohio River Sightseeing Cruise (BB Riverboats)** — See the skyline from the water on a narrated sightseeing or lunch/dinner cruise with BB Riverboats.

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront & Roebling Bridge Loop** 1.5 miles · Easy · 30-45 min — Walk west from the Public Landing along the Ohio River Trail through Smale Riverfront Park — don't miss the giant swings and Carol...
- **Over-the-Rhine Stroll** 0.8 miles in OTR · Easy · 1-2 hrs browsing — Hop the free Connector streetcar to the Findlay Market stop and explore the market, then walk south down Vine Street past breweries...

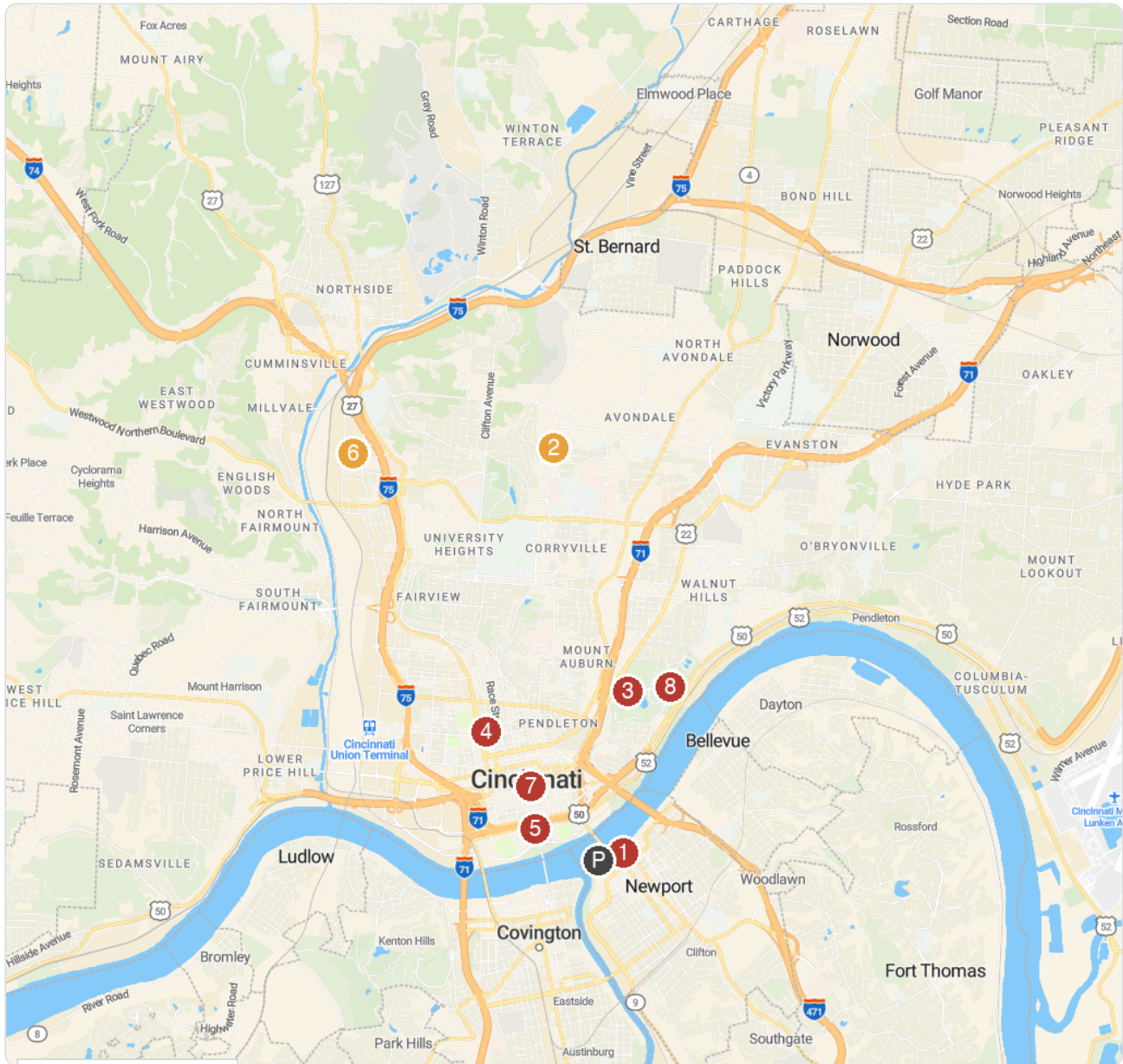
