GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Deepwater Quay, town center — most ships dock here; mega-ships may use Ringaskiddy (~30 km by road, shuttle bus to Cork City provided)

Best For: History lovers, Titanic fans, day-trippers to Cork & Blarney

Walk to center: 2 min to Cobh Heritage Centre; 5 min to main street

Don't Miss: Titanic Experience, Spike Island ferry, kissing the Blarney Stone

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Titanic Experience Cobh** — The original White Star Line booking office tells the story of the 123 Cobh passengers who boarded the Titanic on its...
 - **Spike Island — Ireland's Alcatraz** — A 10-min ferry from Kennedy Pier takes you to this 104-acre island with 1,300 years of history as a monastery...
- **Blarney Castle & the Stone** — Kiss the Blarney Stone for the legendary 'gift of the gab' at this 600-year-old tower castle set in beautiful gardens.
 - **Cork City Day Trip** — Ireland's second city is a 25-min train ride from the cruise berth.
 - **Fota Wildlife Park** — Animals roam in open natural enclosures across this 100-acre park on Fota Island, one train stop before Cork City.

BEST WALKS

- **Cobh Waterfront to Cathedral Walk** 1.5 km | ~45 min | Easy–moderate (uphill) — Start at the cruise pier and stroll past the Cobh Heritage Centre to the town promenade.
- **Titanic Trail — Cobh Historic Core** 2 km | ~1 hr | Easy — Follow the Titanic trail markers from Kennedy Pier (where tenders once departed) past the original White Star Line office (now the...

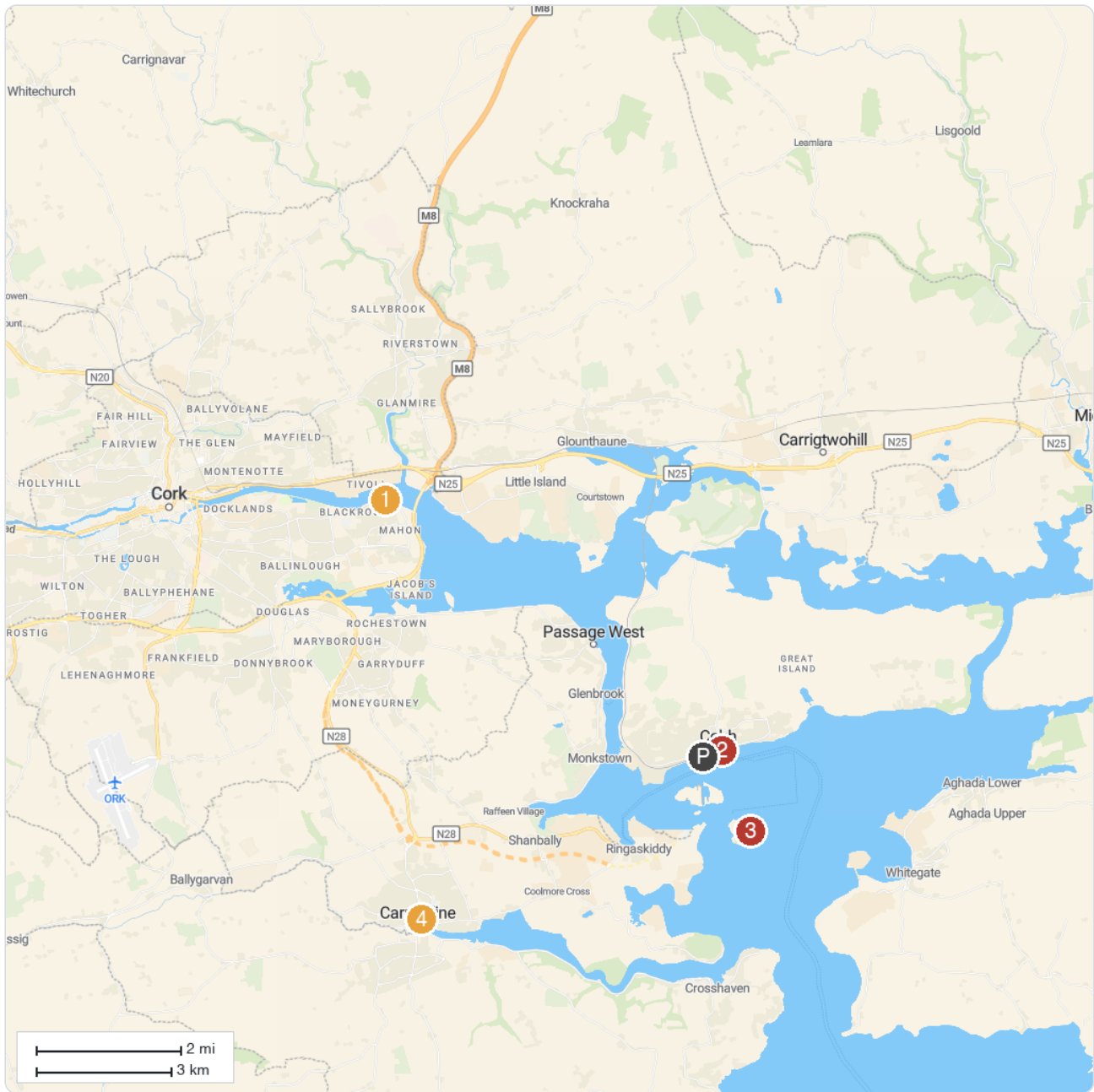
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
