GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender only — ships anchor offshore; tenders land at San Pedro de Coche

Walk to center: 5 min from tender dock to San Pedro de Coche village

Best For: Kitesurfing, windsurfing, deserted beaches, snorkeling

Don't Miss: La Punta beach — 3 km of white sand, world-class kite flats

 Getting around:  Taxi  \$5–10 USD ·  Rideshare  not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Kitesurfing at La Punta** — La Punta beach has hosted national and international championships.
- **La Punta Beach Day** — Three kilometres of white sand and calm turquoise water.
- **Snorkeling the Offshore Reefs** — Catamaran day trips from the island often stop at shallow offshore reefs with clear water and good fish life.
- **Windsurfing & Water Sports** — Beyond kitesurfing, Coche's steady winds support windsurfing, kayaking, and jet-skiing.
- **San Pedro de Coche Village Walk** — The small fishing village near the tender dock gives a glimpse of everyday island life.

BEST WALKS

- **San Pedro de Coche Waterfront Stroll** Easy · ~1 km · 20 min — From the tender dock, walk along the San Pedro de Coche waterfront past fishing boats and local houses to the village square.

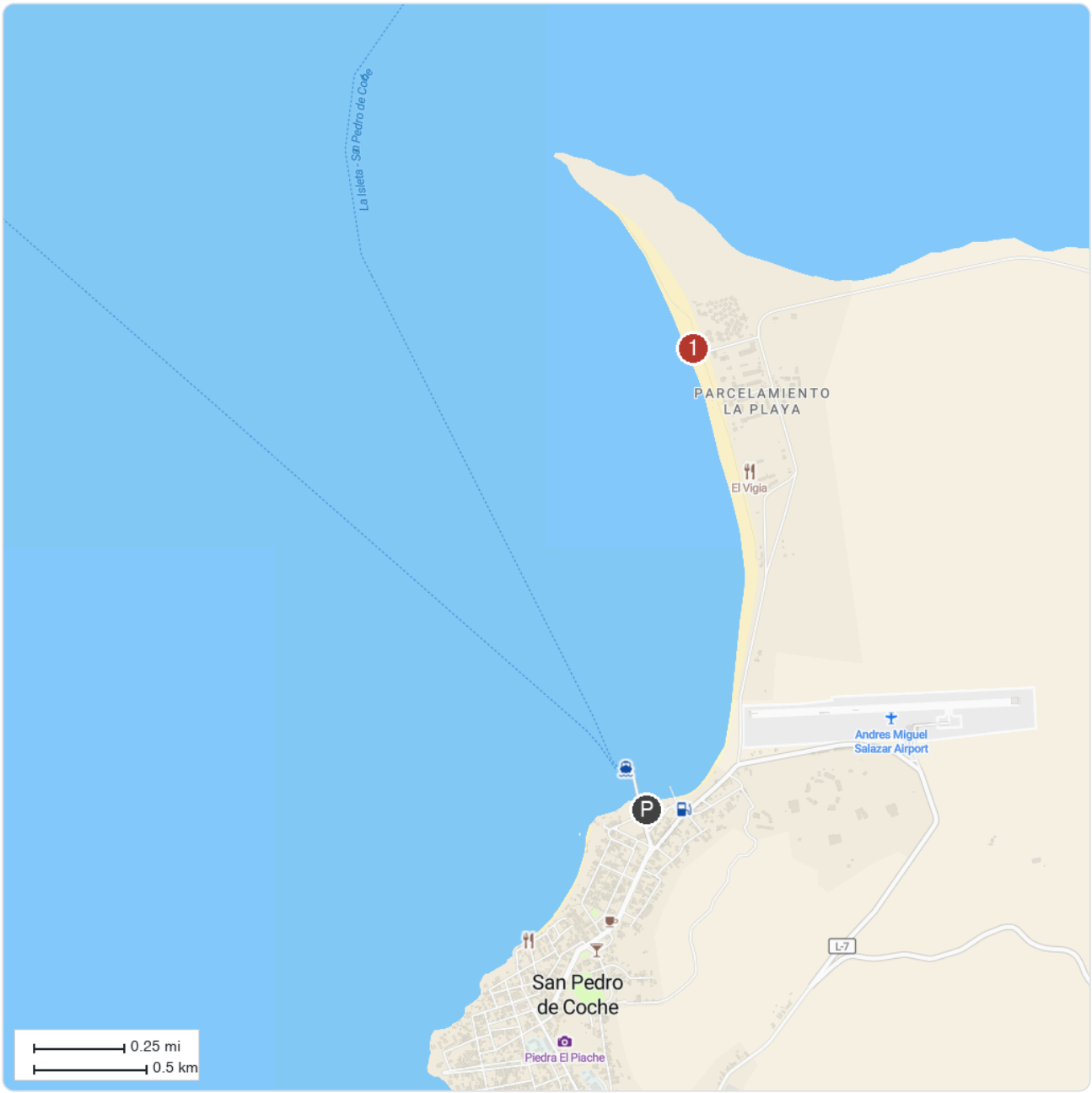
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender times matter: Ships may limit tender runs in swells. Return early — last tender waits for no one.
- Wind is the point: Trade winds blow strongest from midday. If you're watching kitesurfers, early morning is calmer; afternoon is the spectacle.
- Cash is king: Bring USD. The local Bolívar has been extremely volatile; many vendors prefer hard currency. Card payment is rarely available.
