

Coimbra, Centro, Portugal

Portugal's most scholarly city perches on a hilltop above the Mondego River, its Baroque library and Romanesque cathedral drawing cruise visitors who arrive overland by coach from Porto-Leixões or the nearby coast.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Coimbra is inland and not a cruise berth. River-cruise itineraries visit it as a coach excursion from Porto-Leixões; the occasional small ocean ship docks at Figueira da Foz and transfers ~44 km by bus.

Best For: History lovers, UNESCO fans, architecture, Fado music, and Portuguese academic culture.

Walk to centre: Coaches drop near Largo da Portagem in the lower town (Baixa). Hilly — the upper town (Alta) requires a stiff climb or the market elevator.

Don't Miss: The Joanina Library — one of the world's most beautiful Baroque libraries; book timed tickets in advance.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **University of Coimbra & Joanina Library** — Explore the UNESCO-listed university complex founded in 1290.
- **Coimbra Fado Experience** — Coimbra's Fado is distinct from Lisbon's — performed by black-caped male students, it carries a poetic, academic...
- **Sé Velha (Old Cathedral) & Arco de Almedina** — Coimbra's 12th-century Romanesque cathedral is one of Portugal's best-preserved medieval churches.
- **Santa Cruz Monastery** — Coimbra's oldest monastery (1131) is the burial site of Portugal's first two kings, Afonso Henriques and Sancho I.
- **Machado de Castro National Museum** — Built above a Roman cryptoporticus (underground gallery), this museum holds a superb collection of medieval sculpture...

BEST WALKS

- **Baixa to Alta — The Classic Climb** 2.5–3 km | 2–3 hrs | Moderate (steep ascent) — Start at the riverfront Largo da Portagem, walk up Rua Ferreira Borges to Praça 8 de Maio and Santa Cruz Monastery, then climb through...
- **Santa Clara & the Other Bank** 2 km | 1–1.5 hrs | Easy — Cross the Ponte de Santa Clara from Largo da Portagem to explore the quieter left bank.

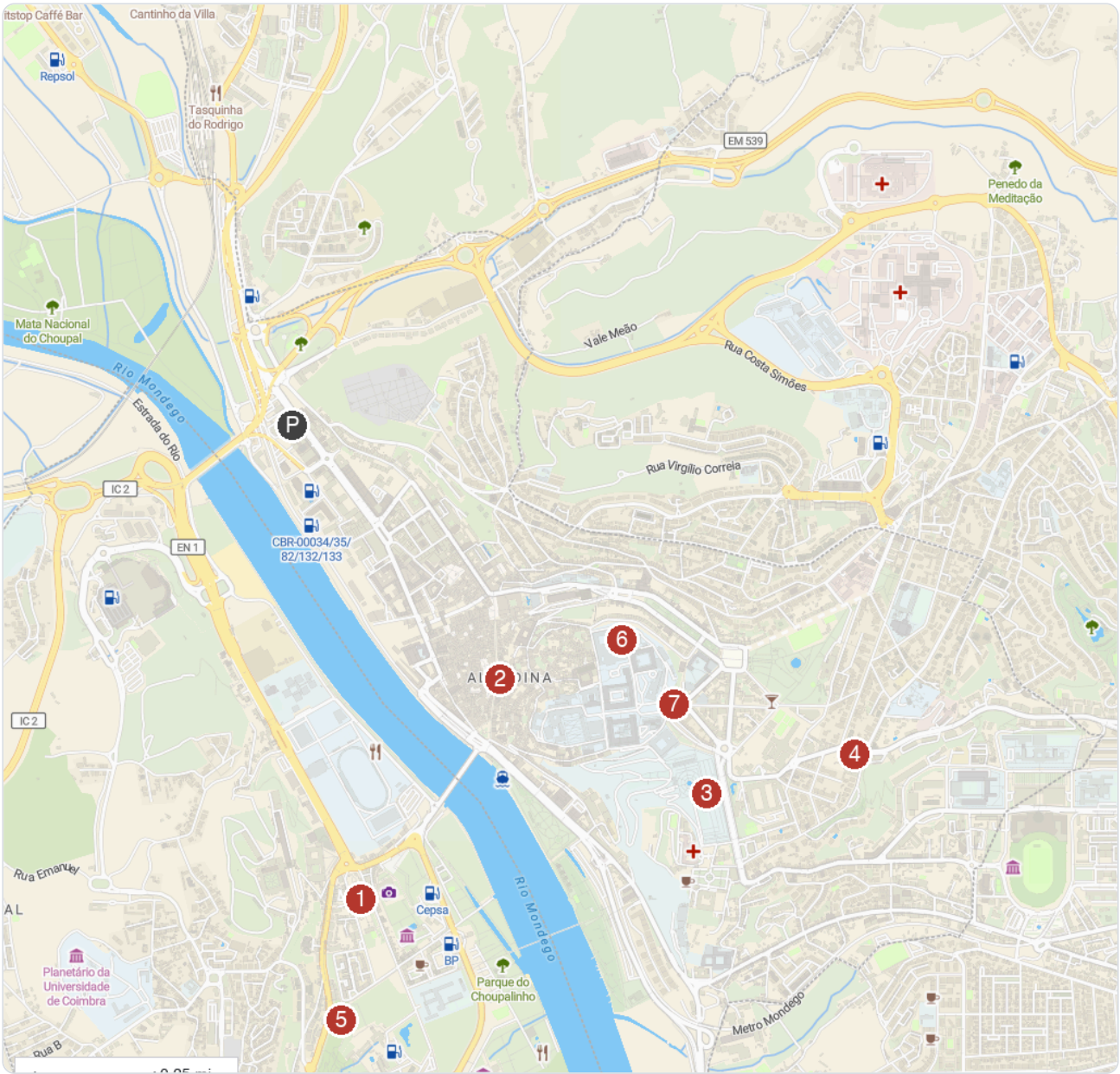
