TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Château Royal de Collioure** — The castle's walls plunge straight into the sea.
 - **Fauvism Art Trail** — Matisse and Derain spent the summer of 1905 here inventing Fauvism.
 - **Anchovy & Local Wine Tasting** — Collioure anchovies (salted, not canned in oil) carry a PGI (Protected
- Geographical Indication) — the only fish in...

 - **Plage Saint-Vincent & Plage Boramar** — Two small pebble beaches flank the church in the harbor — sheltered, clear water, easy to reach from the tender quay.
 - **Hike to Fort Saint-Elme** — A steep 1-hour climb above the vineyards rewards with sweeping views of Collioure, the Côte Vermeille, and on clear...

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Harbor Loop** 1.5 km · 30–45 min · Easy — From the tender quay, stroll past Plage Boramar to the Château Royal entrance, then thread through the lanes of Le Mouré (the old...
- **Vineyard & Coastal Path to Port-Vendres** 4 km one-way · 1.5–2 hrs · Moderate — Head south from the harbor along the Sentier du Littoral (coastal path, yellow blazes) through terraced Collioure AOC vineyards to the...

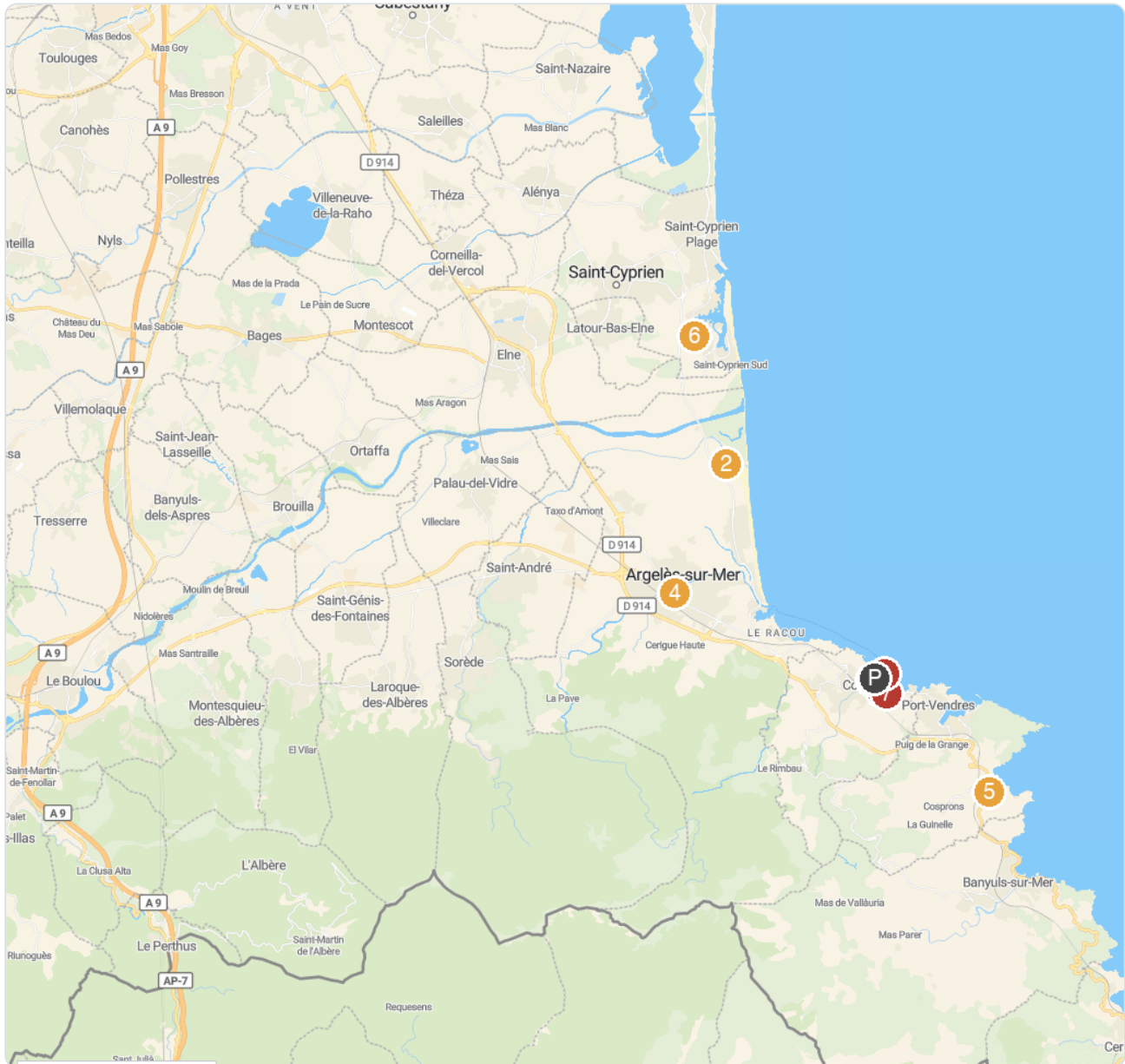
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender tickets: Collect yours early — Collioure is a one-ship-at-a-time anchorage but tenders can queue in peak season (July–August).
- Anchovies as souvenirs: Vacuum-packed salted anchovies from Roque or Desclaux travel well and are genuinely unique to this coast. Buy at the source, not the souvenir shops.
