Built entirely from glowing red iron-rich sandstone, Collonges-la-Rouge looks like a fairy-tale village carved in rust and slate. It founded the famous Les Plus Beaux Villages de France association and remains one of the most visited sites in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine region.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: No cruise pier — Collonges-la-Rouge is an inland village reached by coach excursion from an ocean cruise port (most often Bordeaux).

Best For: Medieval architecture, photography, easy walking, and authentic French village atmosphere.

Walk to center: The historic village is compact and entirely pedestrian — all sights within a 10-min walk of the main street.

Don't Miss: Saint-Pierre Church (11th–15th c.) and Maison de la Sirène with its carved vaulted porch.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Village Walking Tour** — Stroll the cobbled lanes past 15th- and 16th-century mansions, fortified towers, and the famous Maison de la Sirène...
 - Saint-Pierre Church** — Dating from the 11th, 12th, and 15th centuries, this Romanesque church was fortified during the French Wars of Religion...
- Sentier des Sources Hike** — A marked countryside trail looping through meadows, walnut groves, and farmland with views back to the red rooftops of...
 - Nearby Village Combo: Turenne** — About 10 km away, Turenne is another Les Plus Beaux Villages de France member, dominated by the ruins of a medieval...

BEST WALKS

- Red Village Loop** 1.5 km · Easy · ~1.5 hrs — Start at the Covered Market (Halle) in the centre of the village, walk past Maison de la Sirène and its carved porch, continue to...

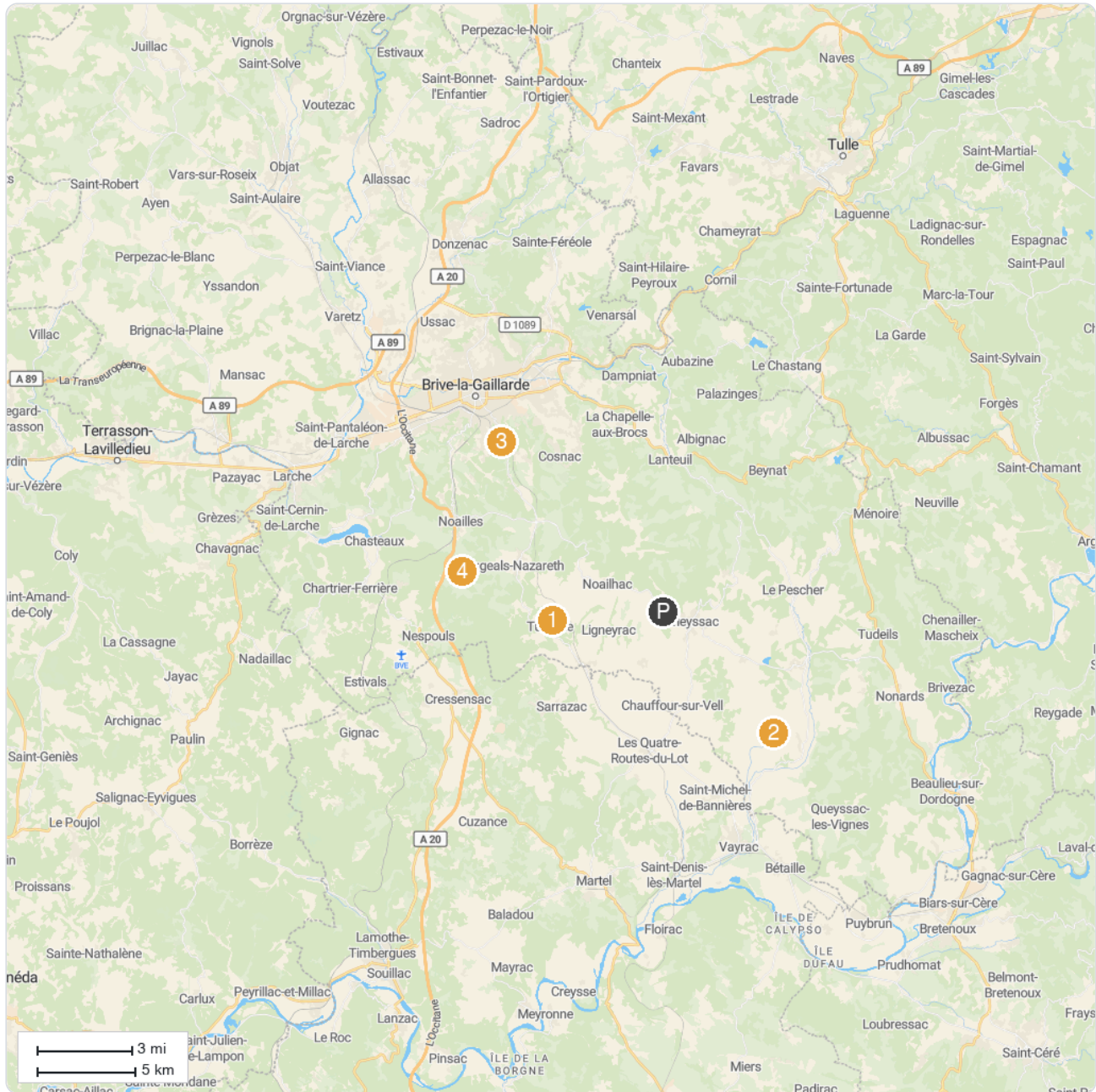
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Two hours is enough. The village is very compact — a leisurely loop covers everything. Budget extra time if you want to sit at a café or browse the few craft shops.
- Visit early or late in the day. Collonges-la-Rouge is one of France's most photographed villages — summer middays are very busy. The red stone glows best in morning or evening...
- More comfortable shoes. The streets are cobblestone throughout. The village is entirely pedestrian, so no traffic, but uneven
