GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Rhine cruise ships dock at Breisach, Germany (~45 min by coach) or Strasbourg (~1 hr). CroisiEurope canal barges dock on the Colmar Canal.

Best For: Medieval architecture, Alsatian wine tastings, canal boat rides, and the Isenheim Altarpiece at Unterlinden Museum.

Walk to Centre: Old Town is compact and fully pedestrianised — ~15-20 min walk (about 1 km) from the Port de Colmar barge marina; ~5 min from coach drop-off near Place Rapp.

Don't Miss: A flat-bottomed boat tour through Petite Venise and the Quai de la Poissonnerie — unique canal-level views of the half-timbered houses.

 Getting around:  Taxi  €4–6 (station to center) ·  Rideshare  Uber, Bolt ·  Hop-on hop-off  Kut'zig

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Little Venice Canal Boat Ride** — Board a traditional flat-bottomed punt for a 25-minute guided glide through the Petite Venise district — past the Quai...
- Unterlinden Museum & Isenheim Altarpiece** — Housed in a 13th-century Dominican convent, the Unterlinden Museum contains the stunning Isenheim Altarpiece by...
- Old Town Walking Tour** — Follow Colmar's golden-triangle tourist trail through its perfectly preserved medieval centre: the Gothic St.
- Alsatian Wine Route Villages** — Drive or coach through the vineyard-draped hills to fairy-tale villages Riquewihr and Ribeauvillé — walled medieval...
- Bartholdi Museum** — A compact but fascinating museum in the birthplace of Frédéric Auguste Bartholdi, the sculptor who designed the Statue...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town & Little Venice Loop** 2 km · 2 hrs · Easy · All pavement — Start at Place d'Unterlinden and the Unterlinden Museum, then head south through Rue des Marchands past the Pfister House and Koïfhus.
- Golden Triangle Tourist Trail** 1.5 km · 1.5 hrs · Easy · Self-guided — Follow the golden triangle markers embedded in the pavement — a self-guided circuit linking Colmar's greatest hits: St.

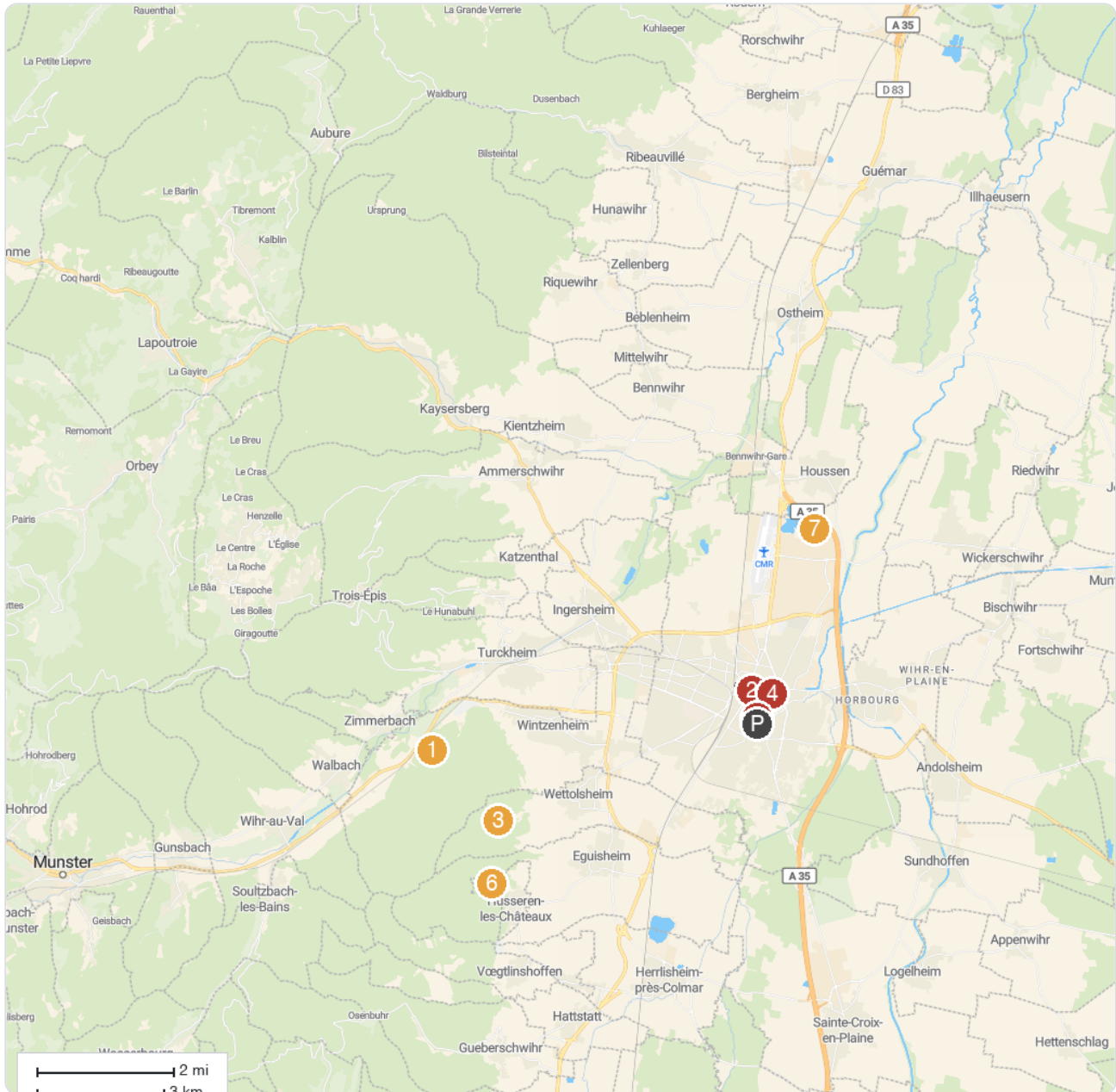
