GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Riverside berths on Konrad-Adenauer-Ufer; most ships dock ~500 m from the main train station and 15–20 min walk to the Cathedral

Best For: Gothic architecture, Roman history, craft beer culture, world-class museums

Walk to center: Old Town and Cathedral are 15–20 min on foot from the main dock; Rheinauhafen berths are slightly further south

Don't Miss: Climbing the Cologne Cathedral's south tower (533 steps) for a panoramic Rhine view

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cologne Cathedral (Kölner Dom)** — A UNESCO World Heritage Site and Germany's most-visited landmark, the Dom's twin Gothic spires soar 157 m above the...
- **Romano-Germanic Museum** — This museum traces Cologne's 2,000-year history from its founding as Colonia Claudia Ara Agrippinensium in 50 AD.
- **Kölsch Beer & Brauhaus Culture** — Kölsch is Cologne's own protected-designation beer — light, crisp, served in slender 200 ml glasses called Stangen.
- **Lindt Chocolate Museum** — Trace 5,000 years of chocolate history at this Rheinauhafen landmark, with a 3-metre chocolate fountain and hands-on...
- **Cologne Old Town (Altstadt) Guided Walk** — Explore the Alter Markt, the Fischmarkt by the river, the medieval Great St.

BEST WALKS

- **Cathedral to Old Town Circuit** 2.5 km · 45–60 min · flat — The classic Cologne walk: from the dock south along the Rhine embankment to the Cathedral square, then into the Altstadt for the Alter...
- **South to Rheinauhafen & Chocolate Museum** 3 km · 50–70 min · flat — Head south from the Cathedral along the Rhine to the converted Rheinauhafen crane-house district, a revitalized harbour with...

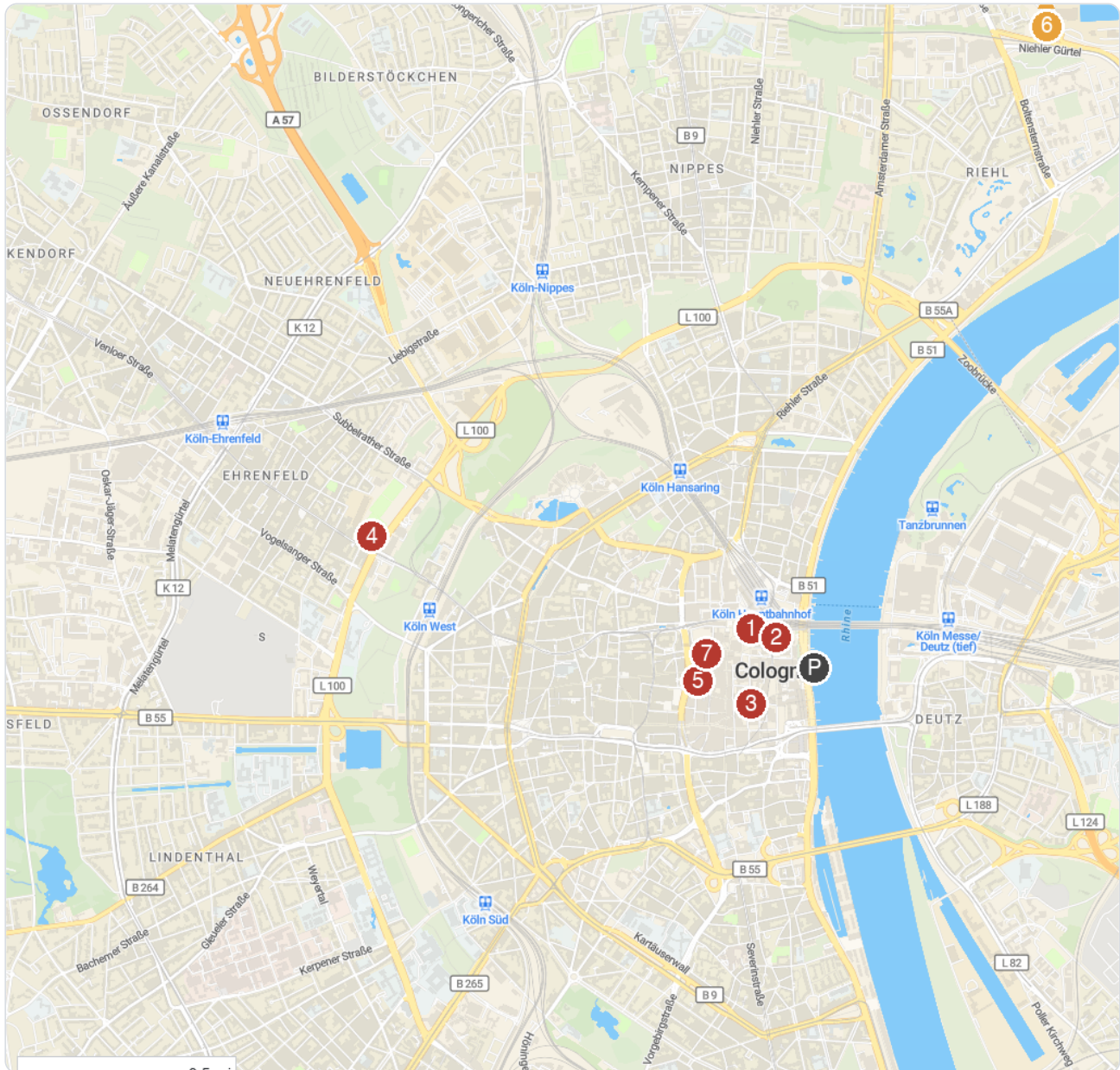
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
