TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Fast Ferry to Bellagio** — The hydrofoil from Como's Navigazione Laghi terminal reaches Bellagio in about 45 minutes.
- **Como–Brunate Funicular** — A 7-minute funicular ride from the lower station at Piazza De Gasperi delivers you to Brunate village (~700 m), with...
- **Como Cathedral & Tempio Voltiano** — The Gothic-Renaissance Duomo di Como (Cattedrale di S.
- **Villa Balbianello by Boat** — One of Italy's most celebrated garden villas, Villa del Balbianello in Lenno juts dramatically into the lake on a...
- **Lungolago Promenade & Piazza Cavour** — Como's lakefront promenade is perfect for a leisurely walk: palms, Belle Époque buildings, gelaterie, and the ornate...

BEST WALKS

- **Lakefront & Historic Core** 1.5 km · ~30 min · Easy — A gentle loop taking in Como's best street-level highlights.
- **Funicular Upper Town Walk** 0.8 km · ~20 min · Easy (uphill only by funicular) — Ride the funicular from Piazza De Gasperi to Brunate, then wander the quiet village lanes past the church of Sant'Andrea for lake...

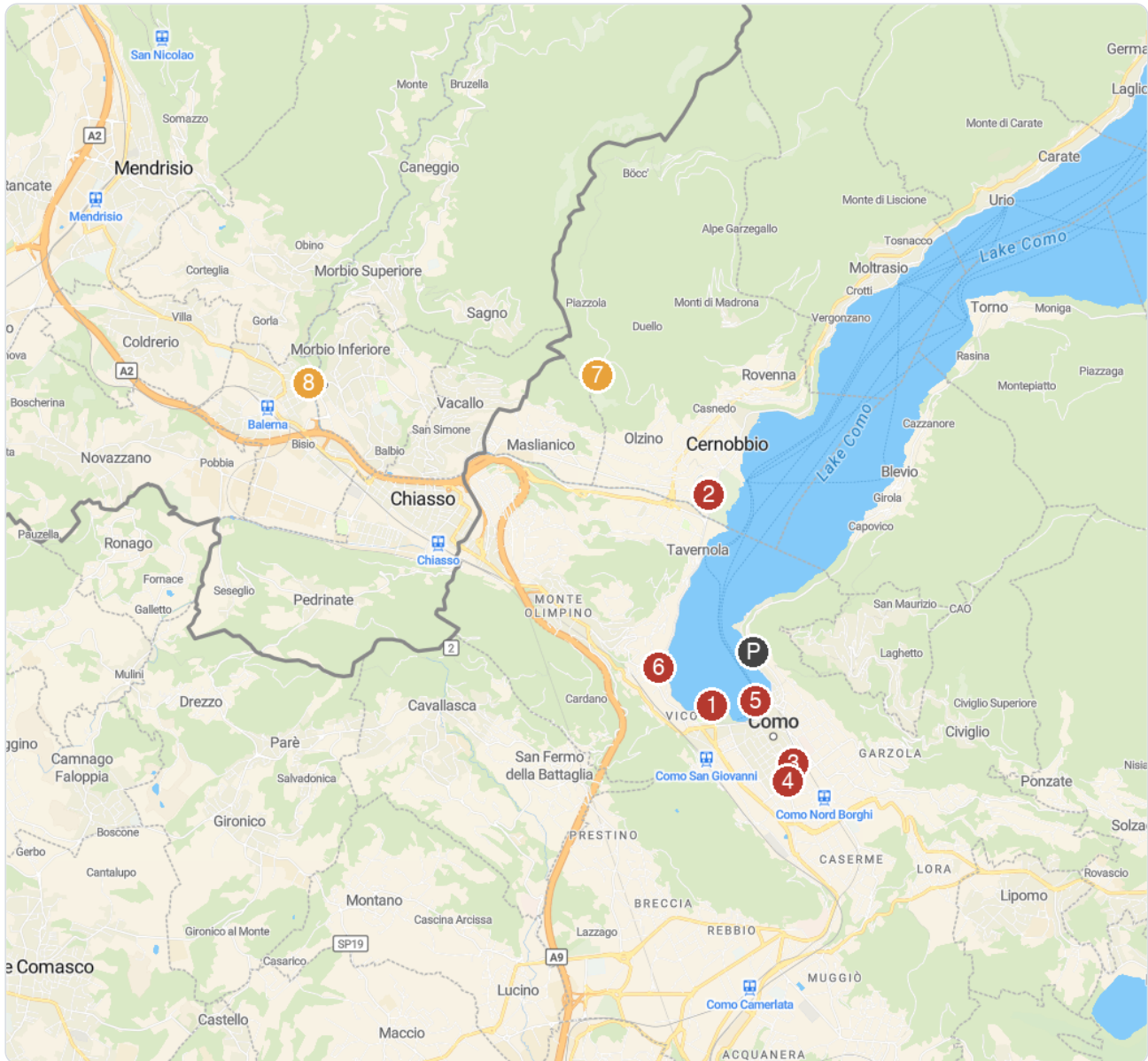
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
