GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River barge/small ship docks at Port de Plaisance, central Compiègne

Best For: History buffs, palace fans, forest walks, day-trippers to Pierrefonds

Walk to centre: ~5 min to Hôtel de Ville; ~10 min to Château de Compiègne

Don't Miss: Clairière de l'Armistice — the forest clearing where WWI ended

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Château de Compiègne** — One of France's three great royal palaces (with Versailles and Fontainebleau), Compiègne was the country retreat of...
- **Clairière de l'Armistice** — Deep in the Compiègne Forest, this clearing is where Marshal Foch signed the armistice ending World War I on 11...
- **Château de Pierrefonds** — A medieval fortress spectacularly restored by Viollet-le-Duc for Napoleon III, Pierrefonds looks lifted from a storybook.
- **Historic Town Centre Walk** — Compiègne's pedestrian core rewards wandering.
- **Forêt de Compiègne** — The 14,400-hectare royal hunting forest surrounds the town and offers well-marked trails for walking and cycling.

BEST WALKS

- **Marina to Château de Compiègne** 1.2 km · ~15 min · Flat — A straight riverside and town-centre stroll from the Port de Plaisance to the grand palace forecourt.
- **Historic Centre Loop** 2 km · ~30 min · Flat — From the Château, loop through the pedestrian streets past Église Saint-Jacques, along Rue Solférino, and back via the Oise riverside...

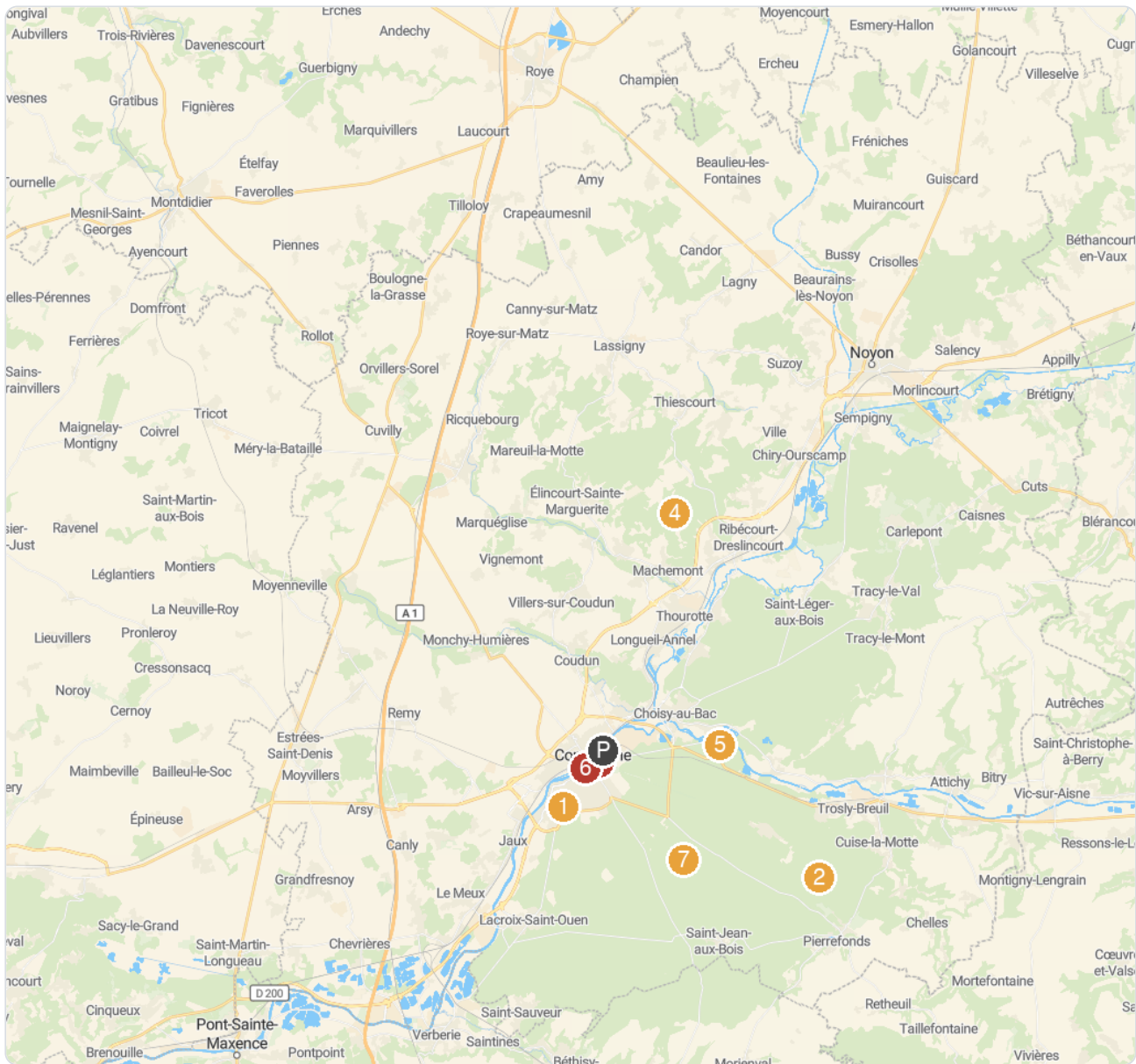
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
