GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to the main harbor quay, directly opposite the Ville Close gate

Best For: Medieval history, fishing culture, Breton food, coastal walks

Walk to center: 1-2 min from tender dock to Ville Close entrance

Don't Miss: Walking the Ville Close ramparts and the Musée de la Pêche trawler

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Ville Close — The Walled Island** — Cross the footbridge onto this granite island fortress and walk cobblestone lanes lined with artisan shops, crêperies...
- Musée de la Pêche** — Inside the Ville Close, this fishing museum explores Concarneau's identity as one of France's top tuna ports.
- Glénan Islands Boat Trip** — The Glénan Archipelago, 15 km offshore, has turquoise water and white sand beaches that look Caribbean.
- Day Trip to Pont-Aven** — Paul Gauguin painted here, and the village has barely changed — riverside mills, galleries, and the Musée de Pont-Aven...
- Day Trip to Quimper** — The Finistère capital has a soaring Gothic cathedral (Saint-Corentin), medieval pedestrian streets, and renowned...

BEST WALKS

- Ville Close Ramparts Loop** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy — From the tender quay, cross the footbridge into the Ville Close.
- Coastal Path to Plage des Sables Blancs** 2 km · 25-30 min each way · Easy — Head north from the harbor along the Sentier Côtier (GR34) past the Marinarium and around the headland to Plage des Sables Blancs.

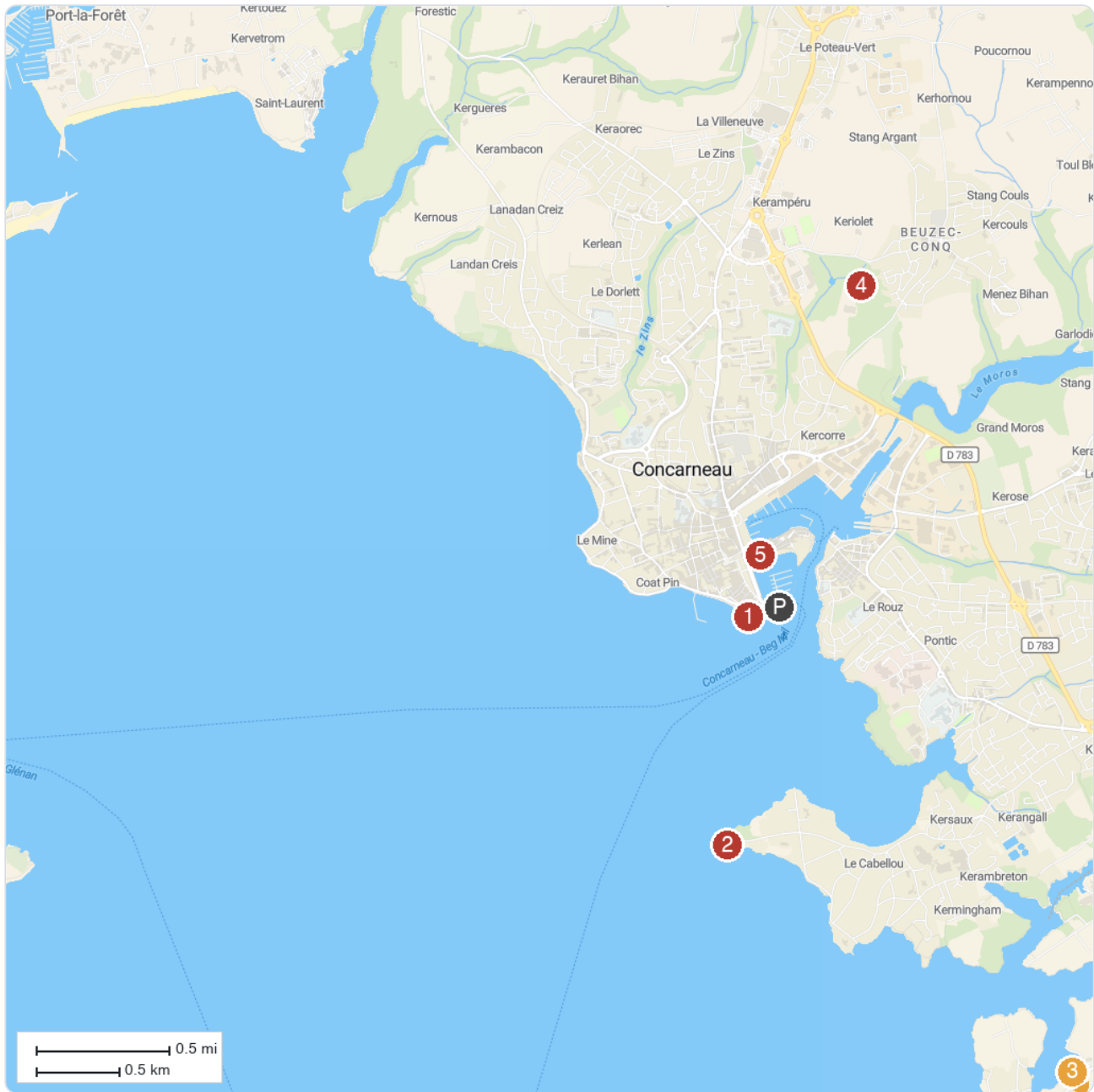
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Tender lines can be long at peak times — go early or wait out the rush after the first wave.
- Cash useful inside the Ville Close — some small shops and crêperies prefer cash, though most take cards.
- Bring a layer — Breton weather is changeable even in summer; the harbor is exposed and can be breezy.
