GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — Constanța Passenger Terminal, inside the commercial port

Best For: History buffs, Art Nouveau fans, Black Sea beaches, Romanian cuisine

Walk to center: ~1.5 km (20 min); steep staircase to Old Town or take ship shuttle

Don't Miss: The Grand Mosque minaret view, Roman Mosaics complex, Casino clifftop

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Old Town & Roman Mosaics Walk** — Ovidiu Square, the 4th-century Roman mosaic complex, and the History & Archaeology Museum — three millennia of Black...
- Grand Mosque Minaret Climb** — Climb 140 steps inside the 1910 Carol I Mosque minaret for the best panoramic view of the port, city, and Black Sea...
- Mamaia Beach Resort** — Romania's famous 'Ibiza of the East' — a 5-mile sandy strip with beach clubs, restaurants, and a telegondola cable car...
- Danube Delta Excursion** — UNESCO biosphere reserve and Europe's best-preserved wetland — home to 300+ bird species.
- Constanța Casino & Faleză Promenade** — The Art Nouveau Casino — a 1910 clifftop landmark by architect Daniel Renard, fully restored and reopened in May 2025...

BEST WALKS

- Old Town Heritage Loop** 2.5 km · 1-1.5 hrs · Moderate (stairs at start) — From the port gate, climb the cliff staircase to Ovidiu Square, then circle past the Grand Mosque, the Casino clifftop, Genoese...
- Tomis Marina Seafood Lunch Walk** 1 km · 30 min · Easy (flat) — From Ovidiu Square, stroll down to Portul Tomis marina, lined with seafood restaurants and cafés overlooking the yachts — ideal for a...

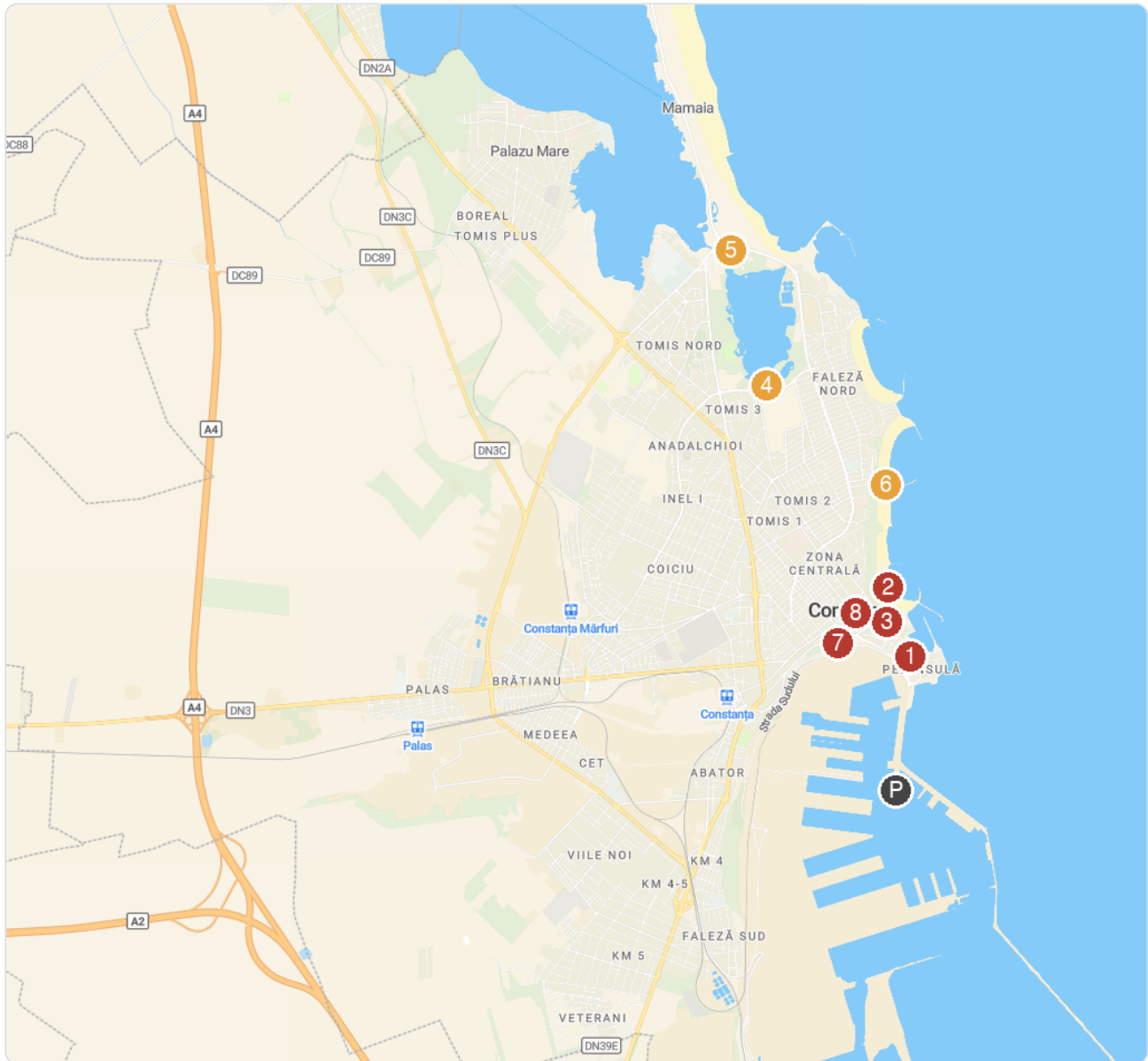
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
