GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender to Cooktown Wharf (Endeavour River)

Best For: History, Indigenous culture, scenic lookouts, river wildlife

Walk to centre: 2–5 min flat walk from the wharf to Charlotte St

Don't Miss: The original HMS Endeavour anchor at the Cooktown Museum

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Cooktown Museum (James Cook Museum)** — The must-do.
- **Grassy Hill Lookout** — Climb to the same hilltop where Cook stood in 1770 to chart a way through the reef.
- **Endeavour River Crocodile Cruise** — Local operators run 1–2 hour river cruises departing near the wharf.
- **Milbi Wall & Charlotte Street Historic Walk** — The Milbi Wall near the wharf is a vivid Indigenous mosaic telling the Guugu Yimithirr story of Cook's arrival.
- **Cooktown Botanic Gardens & Nature's Powerhouse** — Established in 1878 — among Queensland's oldest — these tropical gardens sit within the 62-hectare Gallop Botanic...

BEST WALKS

- **Wharf to Charlotte Street Foreshore Loop** 1.5 km · 20–30 min · Flat · Free — Walk from the tender wharf along the Endeavour River esplanade past the Milbi Wall and Reconciliation Rocks, then up Charlotte Street...
- **Botanic Gardens & Nature's Powerhouse** 2 km from wharf · 45 min walk · Mostly flat — Follow Botanic Gardens Road from Charlotte Street into the gardens.

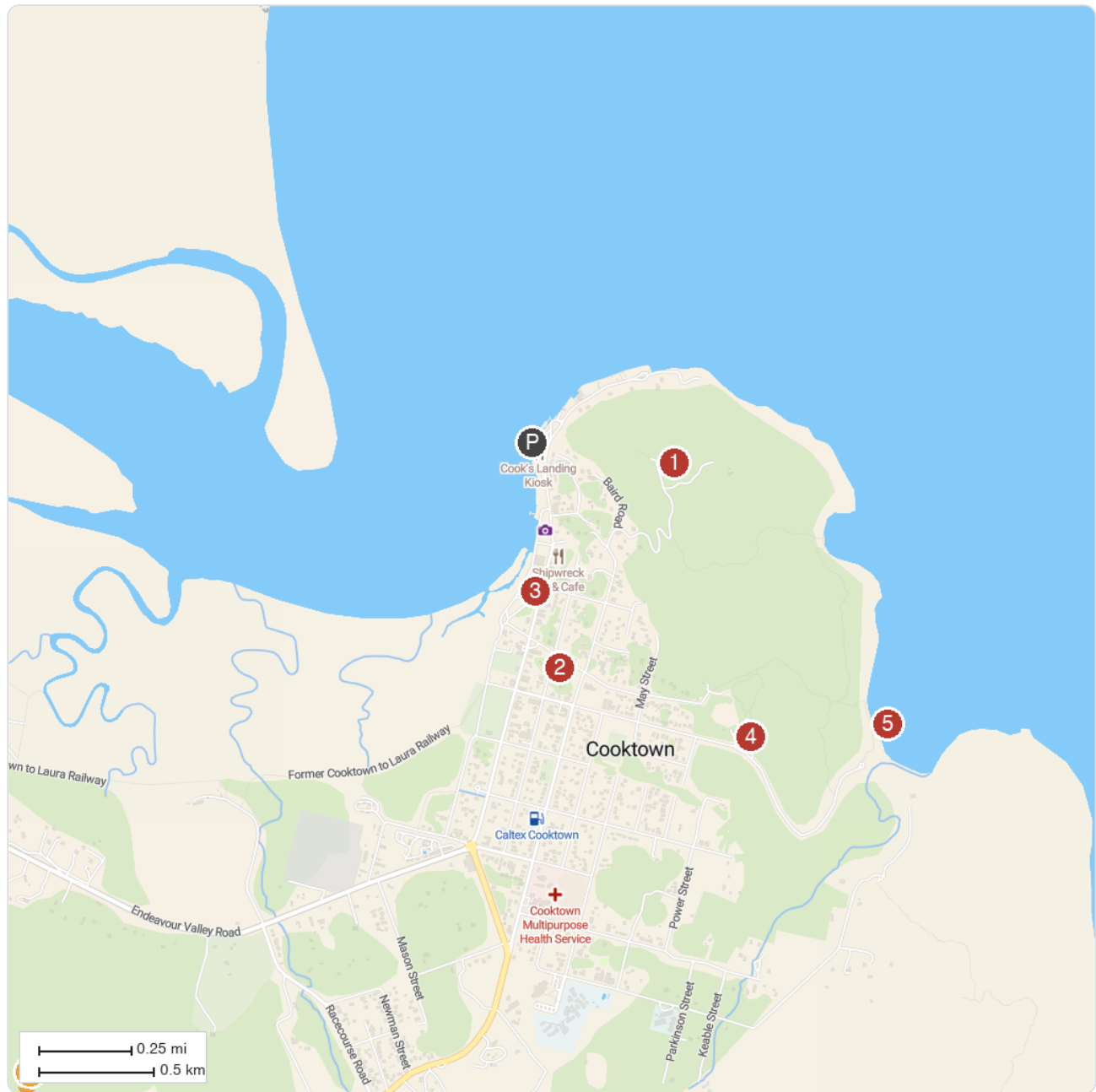
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- No swimming — anywhere. Saltwater crocodiles inhabit the Endeavour River, the beaches, and nearby waterways. Warning signs are posted. Heed them.
- Sun and heat are brutal. Cooktown sits in the wet tropics. Wear a hat, apply high-SPF sunscreen before you leave the ship, and carry water — you'll need it.
- Insect repellent is essential near the river and botanic gardens. Sandflies and mosquitoes are active. Bring DEET-based repellent.
