- **Canal Boat Tour** — See the city from its waterways — gliding past the Opera House, Christianshavn, the Black Diamond library, and the...
- **Tivoli Gardens** — The historic pleasure garden that opened in 1843 and inspired Walt Disney — vintage rides, manicured gardens, live...
- **Kronborg or Frederiksborg Castle** — Day trip to a Danish royal castle: Kronborg ('Hamlet's Castle') guards the Øresund strait as a UNESCO site, or visit...
- **Freetown Christiania** — A self-governing 'free town' carved from former military barracks in 1971 — car-free laneways, self-built homes...

- **Little Mermaid to Nyhavn** ~3 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — From the Little Mermaid statue past the Gefion Fountain, Amalienborg Palace (noon guard change), and the waterfront promenade to...
- **Strøget & the Old Center** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — Europe's longest pedestrian street, threading from Kongens Nytorv through the Latin Quarter past the Round Tower and Gammeltorv to...
- **Christianshavn & the Harbour Bus** ~2.5 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — Cross to canal-laced Christianshavn, with the twisted spiral spire of the Church of Our Saviour, the Black Diamond library on the...

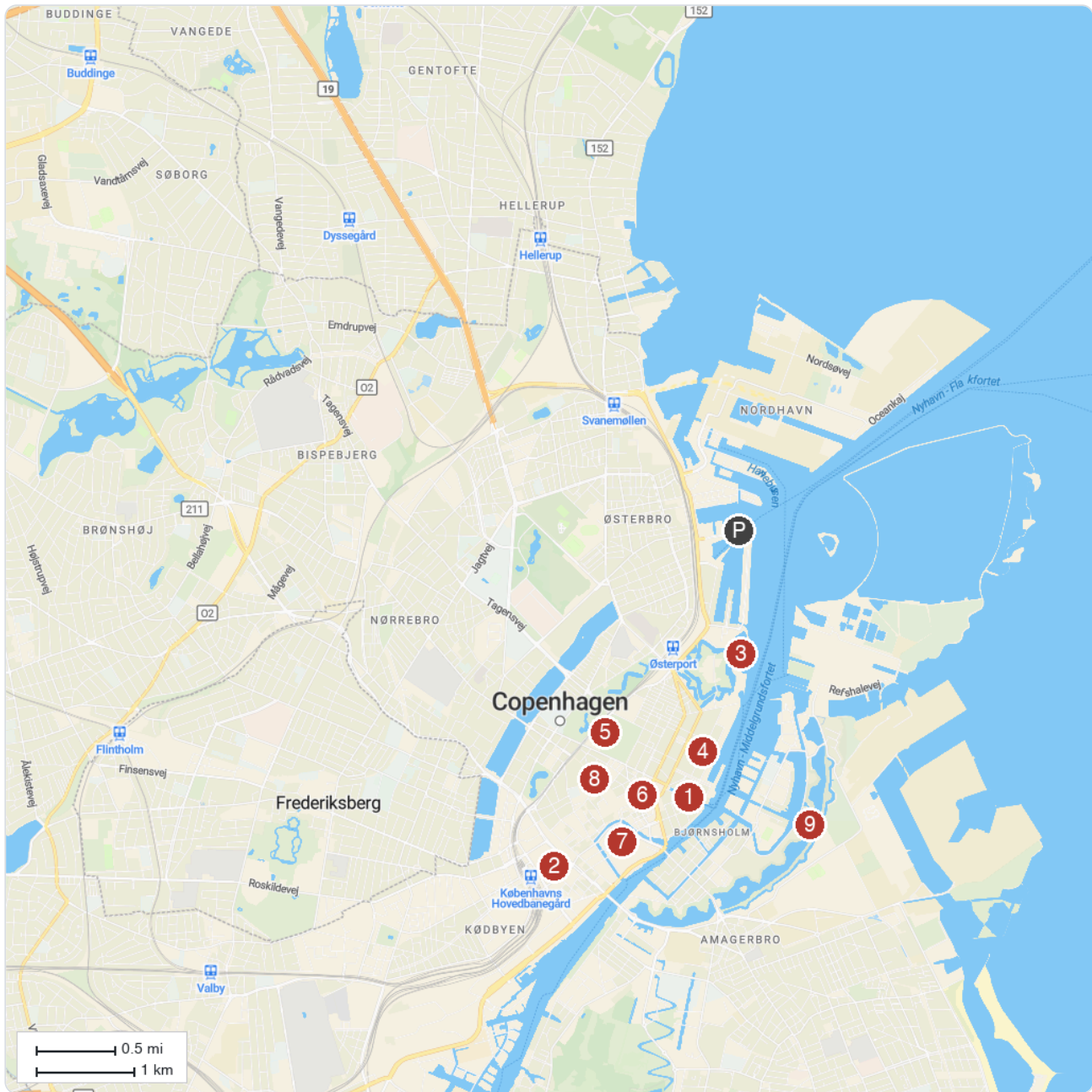
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
