GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cruise ships dock at Corfu New Port (Néo Limáni), a 15-20 min walk or short taxi ride from Old Town.

Best For: History, culture, beaches, and easy independent exploration.

Walk to centre: ~15-20 min on foot along the seafront from the pier gates to the edge of Corfu Old Town.

Don't Miss: The UNESCO Old Town warren of Venetian lanes and the Achilleion Palace with its panoramic gardens.

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Corfu UNESCO Old Town Walk** — Wander the Venetian laneways (Kantounia), the grand Liston arcade, the Spianada Esplanade, and the Church of Saint...
 - **Achilleion Palace & Gardens** — The hilltop neoclassical palace built for Empress Elisabeth of Austria (Sisi) is Corfu's most iconic landmark.
- **Paleokastritsa & Monastery** — Corfu's most celebrated natural bay — turquoise coves beneath dramatic limestone cliffs topped by a working Byzantine...
 - **Glyfada Beach** — One of Corfu's longest sandy beaches on the west coast, backed by pine hills.
 - **Sea Kayaking the Ionian Coast** — Paddle sea caves, sea arches, and hidden coves along Corfu's dramatic coastline.

BEST WALKS

- **Old Town & Fortresses Loop** ~3 km | 60-90 min | Easy — Start at the Spianada (Esplanade), the largest public square in Greece and the Balkans.
- **Liston & Market Stroll** ~1.5 km | 30-45 min | Easy — A relaxed loop along the elegant Liston arcade (modelled on Paris's Rue de Rivoli), through the covered market alley, and past the...

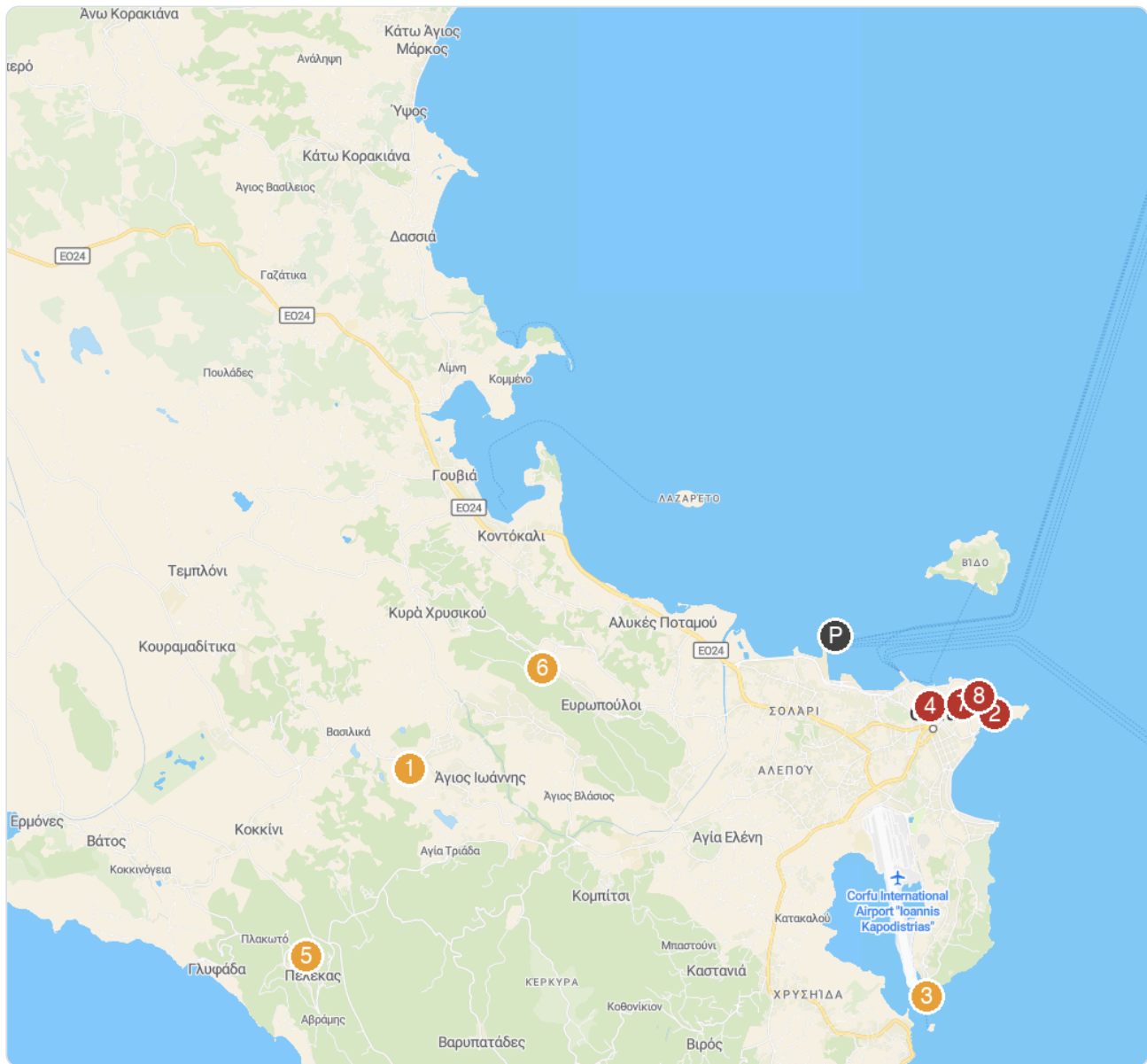
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Corfu is one of Greece's greenest islands — humidity can be high in summer. Wear light, breathable clothes and bring sunscreen.

1 Aqualand Large water park with slides, pools, and family fun.

3 Holy Monastery of Panagia Vlacherna Picturesque white monastery on a tiny islet, iconic Corfu landmark.

5 Kaiser William II Observatory Historic viewpoint built by Kaiser Wilhelm II, stunning vistas.

7 Banknote Museum of the Ionian Bank Unique museum displaying Greek banknotes, coins, and banking history.

2 Old Fortress Historic Venetian fortress offering panoramic views of Corfu Town.

4 New Fortress Another Venetian fortress, offering great views and historical insights.

6 Capodistrias Museum - Centre for Capodistrian Studies Museum dedicated to Ioannis Capodistrias, Greece's first governor.

8 Municipal Gallery of Corfu Art gallery showcasing Greek artists, especially from the Ionian School.
