

Corner Brook, Newfoundland, Canada

Newfoundland's second city sits at the mouth of the Humber River, ringed by the ancient Long Range Mountains. Ships dock at the pier — step off and you're a short shuttle ride from wild trails, world-class ziplines, and some of the warmest hospitality in the Atlantic.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — ships dock at the Corner Brook Port Corporation Western Terminal; no tendering

Best For: Nature, hiking, ziplines, Newfoundland culture & cuisine

Walk to centre: ~1.5 km (1 mile) to West Street downtown; free shuttle usually provided

Don't Miss: Captain James Cook National Historic Site (Crow Hill) and Steady Brook Falls zipline

Getting around: **Taxi** CAD \$15–20 (city), CAD \$15–20 (Captain Cook Monument) · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Gros Morne National Park** — A UNESCO World Heritage Site 75–90 minutes north, famous for dramatic fjords and the Tablelands — a rare place where...
- Marble Zip Tours — Steady Brook Falls** — Zipline directly over the 60-metre (200 ft) Steady Brook Falls at Marble Mountain Resort, just 10 minutes from the port.
- Captain James Cook National Historic Site** — A monument to explorer James Cook, who charted these waters in 1767, perched atop Crow Hill (Cook's Lookout) high above...
- Bay of Islands & Fishing Village Drive** — Follow Captain Cook's Trail along the Bay of Islands to charming outport communities like Lark Harbour.
- A Flavor of Corner Brook — Food, Frolic & Fish** — Sample toutons with molasses, fresh cod tongues, and partridgeberry treats on a guided culinary walk through downtown.

BEST WALKS

- Corner Brook Stream Trail to Margaret Bowater Park** 2-3 km · Easy · 45-60 min · Free — From the Glynmill Inn, follow this well-maintained wooded trail along the stream to Margaret Bowater Park.
- Downtown West Street Stroll** 1-2 km · Easy · 30-45 min · Free — Hop off the shuttle at the Visitor Information Chalet and wander West Street for local shops, the Railway Society's vintage...
