TOP THINGS TO DO

- Upper Canada Village** — One of Canada's largest living-history museums, 30 min west in Morrisburg.
- Historic SDG Jail Tour** — Built in 1833 and active until 2002, this is one of Canada's oldest surviving prisons.
- Lost Villages Museum** — Ten historic buildings relocated before ten villages were deliberately flooded in 1958 for the St.
- Waterfront Trail Bike Ride** — Rent a bike at Marina 200 and follow the paved Waterfront Trail along the St.
- Cornwall-Style Pizza & Local Food** — Cornwall has its own distinct pizza style: thick crust, spiced sweet sauce, and toppings buried under a blanket of...

BEST WALKS

- Waterfront & Lamoureux Park Loop** 1.5 km · 20–30 min · Flat, paved — From the pier, walk through Lamoureux Park past the Clock Tower and Rotary Eco-Gardens with views of the St.
- Waterfront to Downtown Cornwall** 1 km · 12–15 min · Flat — Walk north from the waterfront up to Pitt Street, the main downtown strip.

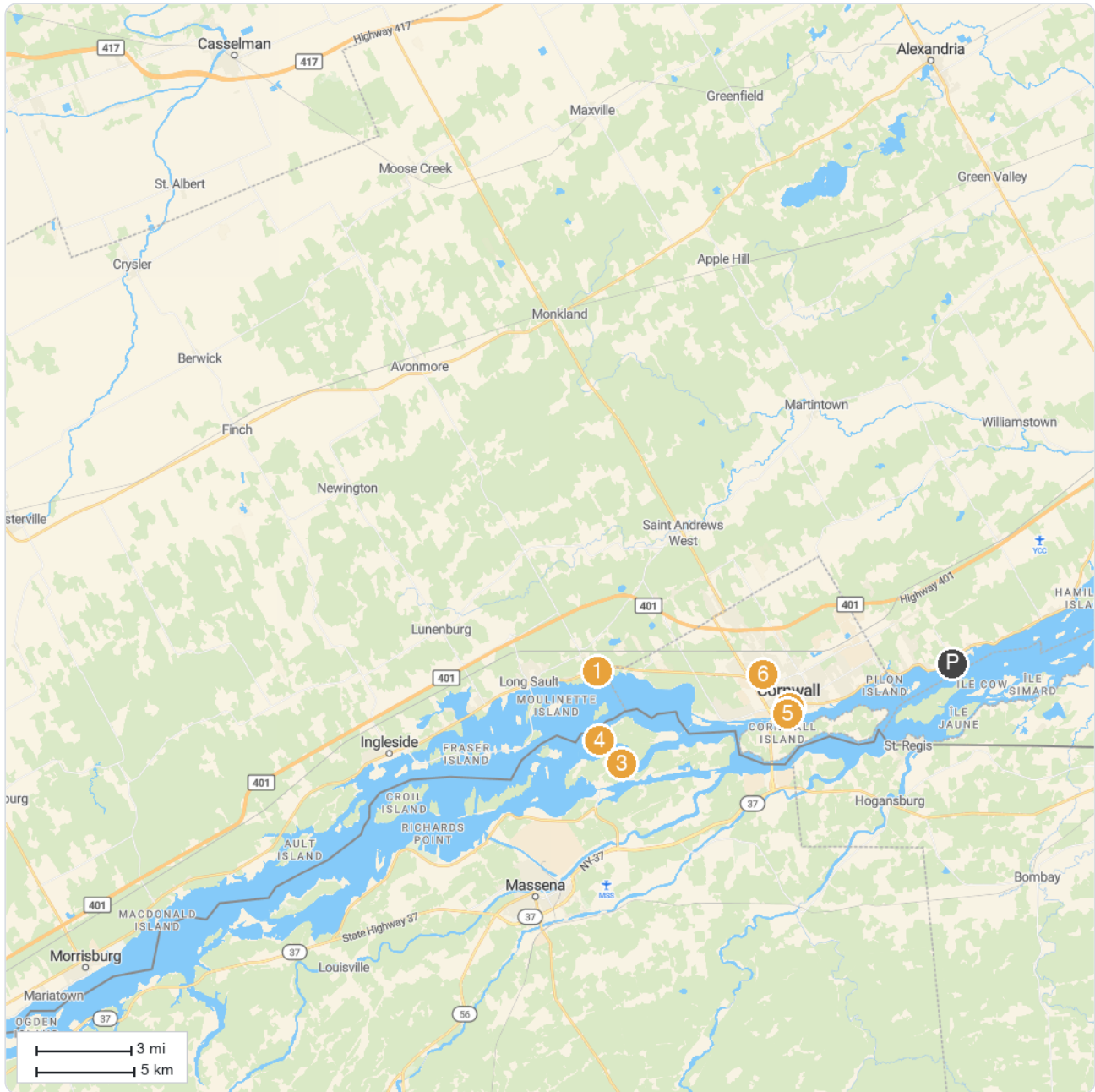
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- CAD is standard — but many downtown shops near the US border accept USD. You'll get change in Canadian coins, so it's better to get a bit of CAD or just use a card.
- No rideshare in Cornwall — Uber and Lyft don't operate here. Local taxis (Choice Taxi, Veterans Blue Line) are reliable and usually wait near the harbour. Agree on price or...
