GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Cannes & Villefranche: tender. Monaco: pier at Port Hercule. Nice (Port Lympia): small ships only (<190m by berth length)

Best For: Glamour, beaches, hilltop villages, casino culture, world-class food and art

Walk to center: Instant at Cannes & Villefranche tender docks. Monaco: 10 min flat + elevator to Monaco-Ville. Nice: 15–20 min or 5 min by tram

Don't Miss: Monaco's Formula 1 circuit, Cannes' Île Sainte-Marguerite, Villefranche's Rue Obscure, Nice's socca at Chez Pipo

 Getting around:  Taxi  €10–€35 depending on port ·  Rideshare  Uber, Bolt ·  Hop-on hop-off  Hop-on hop-off

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Monaco Full Day: Formula 1, Casino & the Rock** — Walk the actual F1 Grand Prix circuit around Port Hercule, then take the elevator or bus up to Monaco-Ville's medieval...
- **Èze Village & Perfume Factories** — Perched 1,400ft above the sea, this eagle's-nest medieval village is one of the most dramatic sights on the Riviera.
- **Îles de Lérins from Cannes** — A 15-minute ferry from Cannes' Vieux Port drops you on Île Sainte-Marguerite, the wooded island where the 'Man in the...
- **Vieux Nice: Food Market, Old Town & Castle Hill** — Dive into Cours Saleya's morning flower-and-produce market, wander the Italian-influenced maze of Vieux Nice, then take...
- **Beach Day at Plage des Marinières, Villefranche** — A 10-minute flat walk from the Villefranche tender dock leads to one of the best free beaches on the Riviera — a long...

BEST WALKS

- **Villefranche Old Town & Cocteau Chapel Loop** 1.5 miles · 45–60 min · easy (flat old town, gentle slopes) — From the tender dock, walk along Quai de l'Amiral Courbet past waterfront restaurants to the tiny Chapelle Saint-Pierre (Cocteau...
- **Cannes: La Croisette to Le Suquet** 2 miles · 1–1.5 hrs · easy (one moderate hill to Le Suquet) — Step off the tender directly onto the Vieux Port and walk east along La Croisette, the palm-lined promenade flanked by grand hotels...
- **Monaco: Harbor Walk to Monaco-Ville** 1.5 miles · 1–1.5 hrs · moderate (vertical — use public elevators) — From Port Hercule, walk the F1 start/finish line painted on the quay, then head around the harbor to Casino Square to admire the Belle...
