GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tender — ships anchor in Loch Crinan; tenders land at canal sea-lock pontoon

Best For: History, nature walks, Atlantic rainforest, Scotland's finest seafood

Walk to centre: 0 min — village is the pontoon; end-to-end in 10 min on foot

Don't Miss: Kilmartin Glen prehistoric monuments & Dunadd Fort (needs transport)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Kilmartin Glen — Scotland's Prehistoric Heartland —** Over 800 ancient monuments — stone circles, burial cairns, and standing stones — pack a six-mile valley rated among the...
 - Dunadd Fort — Throne of the Gaelic Kings —** Climb this dramatic rocky crag rising from the Moine Mhòr wetlands to stand where early Scottish kings were crowned.
- Knapdale Beaver Trail —** Walk the trail around Barnluasgan Loch in Knapdale Forest — the site of Scotland's first licensed wild beaver...
 - Corryvreckan Whirlpool Boat Trip —** The world's third-largest whirlpool churns in the Gulf of Corryvreckan between Jura and Scarba.
 - Crinan Wood — Atlantic Rainforest Walk —** Follow the 1.5-mile loop trail through ancient oak woodland draped in moss and ferns directly behind the Crinan Hotel.

BEST WALKS

- Canal Basin & Towpath Stroll** 1–2 miles · Easy · 45 min — From the sea-lock pontoon, walk east along the canal towpath watching yachts work the hand-cranked locks.
- Crinan Wood Viewpoint Loop** 1.5 miles · Moderate · 1 hr — Take the signed trail uphill behind the Crinan Hotel through ancient oak and birch.
