A tiny fishing village on the Sulina Channel, Crișan is the beating heart of the UNESCO-listed Danube Delta — where pelicans outnumber cars and every canal hides a new world.

GETTING ASHORE

Docking: River quay on the Sulina Channel — ships tie up directly at the village

Getting around: **Taxi** ~80 RON/person · **Rideshare** not available

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Pelican Colony & Canal Boat Tour** — The star attraction of the Danube Delta.
- Mila 23 Village Visit** — A short boat ride from Crișan, Mila 23 is an even more remote fishermen's village — no roads in or out, only water.
- Caraorman Forest & Sand Dunes** — An unexpected highlight — ancient sand dunes and a protected oak forest rising from the flatlands of the Delta.
- Traditional Delta Fish Lunch** — Sit down at one of Crișan's riverside guesthouses for a proper Delta meal: borș de pește (fish soup with garlic sauce), baked carp with polenta, and...
- Kayak & Canoe in the Reed Beds** — Paddle silently through the narrow channels that motorboats can't reach — the best way to sneak up on wildlife.

BEST WALKS

- Crișan Village Embankment Stroll** 1.5 km one-way | Flat | 20 min — Walk the main path along the Sulina Channel from the quay northward through the village.

KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Mosquito protection is not optional. The Delta is notorious for mosquitoes, especially in warmer months. Bring high-DEET repellent and wear long sleeves — you will regret skipping this.
- Cash only in Crișan. There are no ATMs. Bring Romanian Leu (RON) from the ship or Tulcea for local boats, small shops, and restaurants. Major guesthouses may take cards.
- Pack binoculars. The Danube Delta hosts over 300 bird species — Europe's greatest concentration. Without binoculars you'll see shapes; with them, you'll see faces.
- Sun exposure on open boats is intense. Excursion boats offer little shade. Wide-brimmed hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen are essential — the water amplifies UV.
- Keep quiet on the canals. Noise scares wildlife. The best sightings come to passengers who sit still and whisper. Ask your boat driver to cut the engine when approaching colonies.
- Book your boat early. Ship-organized excursions are easiest, but independent hire from local operators is cheaper. Agree on the price and route before you leave the quay.
