GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier (Riva quay / Molo Foraneo) — 5–15 min walk to centre

Walk to centre: ~800 m to Piazza Pitagora (10–15 min)

Don't Miss: Castle of Charles V, Capo Colonna ruins, 'Nduja & Cirò wine

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Capo Colonna — Temple of Hera Lacinia** — One solitary Doric column stands on a headland 10 km from port — the last remnant of a vast Greek sanctuary.
- **Le Castella Aragonese Castle** — A dramatic 15th-century fortress built on a tiny island connected to the Calabrian shore by a stone causeway, framed by...
- **Santa Severina — Medieval Hilltop Village** — One of Italy's 'Most Beautiful Villages', this Norman-castle town sits above the Neto river valley with a rare...
- **National Archaeological Museum of Crotone** — Downtown museum holding the 'Treasure of Hera' and artefacts from Kroton, once one of the most powerful cities of...
- **City Beach & Lido Day** — Crotone's sandy Ionian beach begins steps from the port.

BEST WALKS

- **Port to Piazza Pitagora & the Castle** ~1 km · 15 min · Easy — Walk the Lungomare promenade from the pier to the main square, then climb a few steps to the imposing Castle of Charles V for...
- **Historic Centre Loop** ~1.5 km · 25 min · Easy — From the castle, dive into the labyrinthine centro storico — narrow medieval alleys, the Cathedral of Santa Maria Assunta, and hidden...

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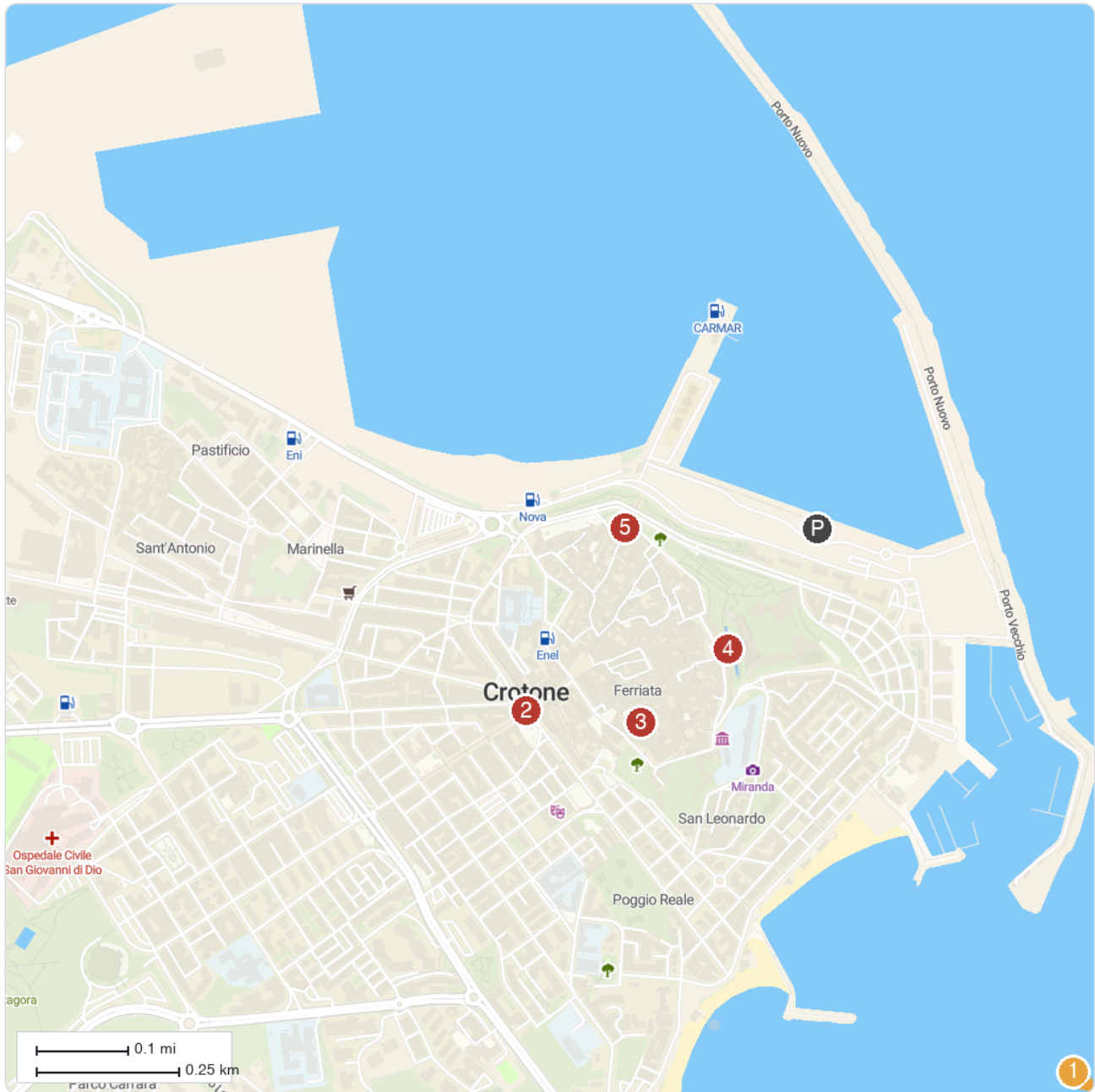
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
