- Flamenco Beach** — Consistently ranked one of the world's top beaches, Flamenco is a horseshoe of white sand and calm turquoise water.
 - Snorkel with Sea Turtles at Tamarindo Beach** — The Luis Peña Marine Reserve off Tamarindo and Melones beaches is home to green sea turtles, spotted eagle rays, and...
 - Day Trip to Isla Culebrita** — Water taxi to this uninhabited sister island reveals 'The Jacuzzi' natural tidal pool, Playa Tortuga (nesting sea...
- Kayak the Luis Peña Marine Reserve** — Paddle through mangrove channels and into the protected reserve for a chance to spot turtles, rays, and tropical fish.
 - Golf Cart Island Exploration** — Rent a golf cart in Dewey and drive the entire island at your own pace — Flamenco Beach, Zoni Beach (with views to St.

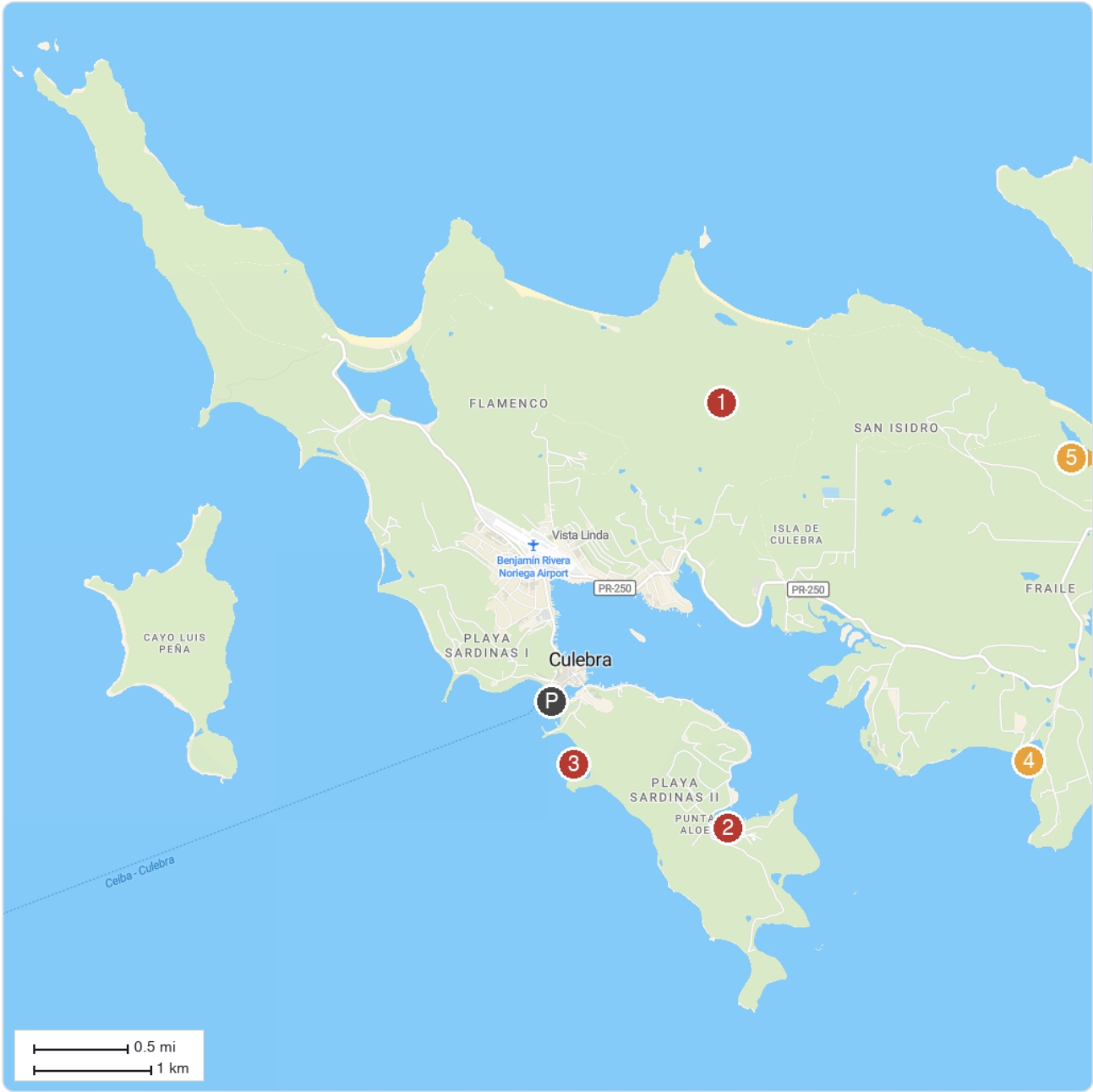
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Bring cash. Públicos vans, beach kiosks, water taxis, and many small eateries are cash-only. ATMs in Dewey exist but can run out on busy port days.
- Book golf carts early. Jerry's and Carlos's rentals often sell out by 8 AM. Reserve online before your sailing date or you'll be relying on shared vans.
- Reef-safe sunscreen only. The Luis Peña Marine Reserve is legally protected — chemical sunscreens are banned. Bring mineral
