GETTING ASHORE

Docking: 100% tender — ships anchor in Ensenada Honda; tenders land at Dewey town dock

Best For: World-class beach days, snorkeling with sea turtles, unspoiled island escape

Walk to center: You arrive in Dewey town center; Flamenco Beach is 2.5 mi (need transport)

Don't Miss: Flamenco Beach's Navy tanks — graffiti-covered WWII-era Sherman tanks right on the sand

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Flamenco Beach Day** — Consistently ranked among the world's top beaches — a horseshoe of blinding white sand with calm turquoise water.
- **Sea Turtle Snorkeling** — The Luis Peña Channel Marine Reserve around Tamarindo Beach is one of the Caribbean's best spots to snorkel with wild...
- **Culebrita Island Day Trip** — Water taxis from Dewey dock ferry you to this tiny uninhabited island.
- **Golf Cart Island Exploration** — Rent a golf cart or Jeep and roam Culebra on your own schedule — Flamenco Beach, Zoni Beach's turtle nesting grounds...
- **Dewey Lunch & Local Flavor** — Wander Dewey's colorful streets and eat like a local.

BEST WALKS

- **Dewey Village Stroll** 15 min · Flat · Free — From the tender dock, wander Dewey's handful of streets past colorful Caribbean buildings, the small drawbridge over the canal, and...
- **Dock to Melones Beach** 15 min walk · Easy · Free snorkeling — Head west along the waterfront from the dock to reach Melones Beach — rocky but with excellent snorkeling right off the shore.

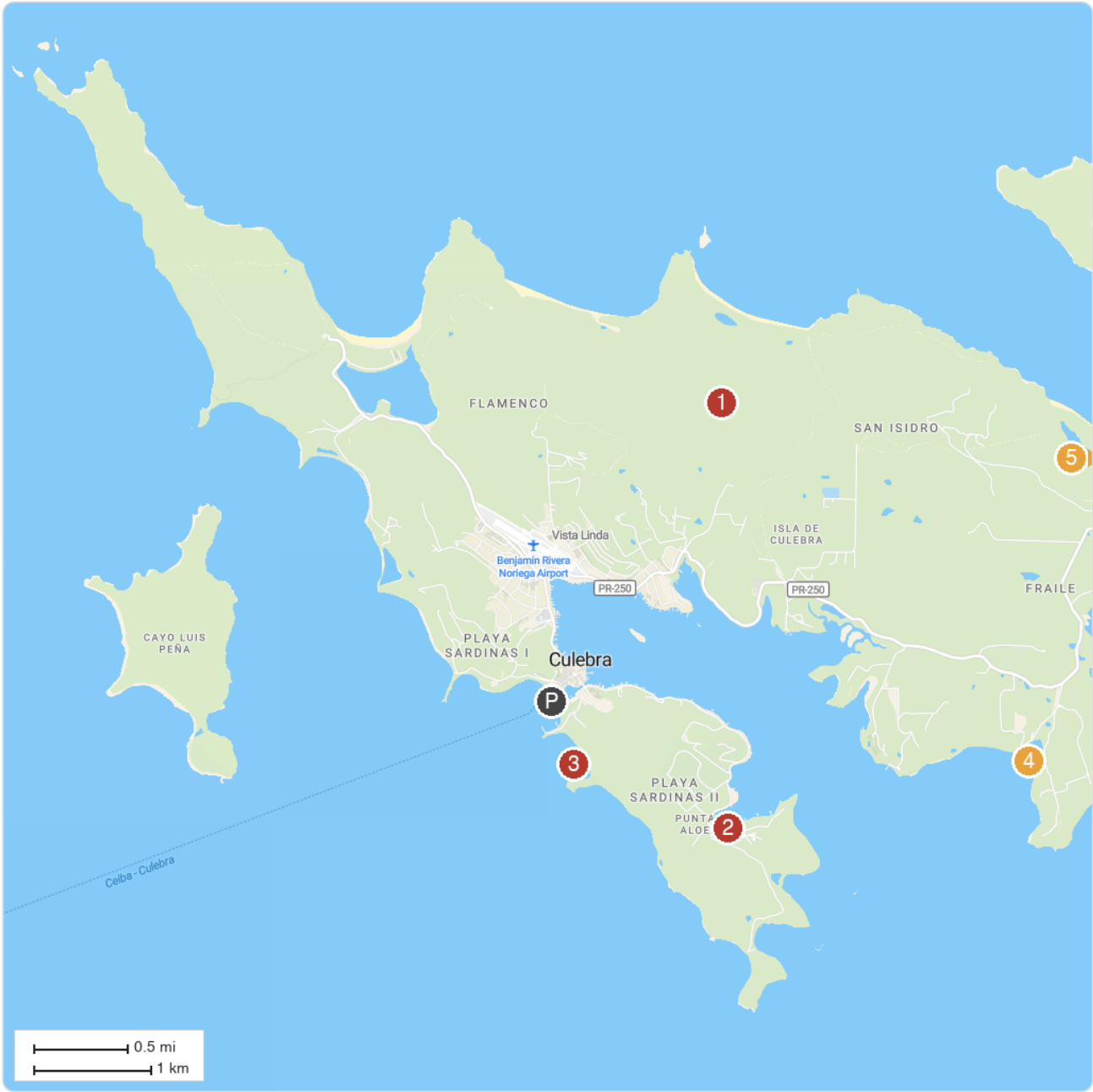
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Grab a públicos immediately: Shared shuttle vans at the dock charge ~\$5–7 per person each way to Flamenco Beach. They fill fast — don't dawdle after tendering.
- Cash is king: ATM in Dewey but bring small bills. Públicos, beach chair rentals, and kiosk food are cash-only. Credit cards work at restaurants in town.
