GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Pier — upgraded berth handles most cruise ships directly; very large vessels may tender

Best For: Heritage seekers, foodies, sand-dune adventurers

Walk to town: ~3 km to Currimao poblacion (taxi/tricycle strongly recommended in the heat)

Don't Miss: Paoay Church (UNESCO), Ilocos Empanada, Paoay Sand Dunes 4x4 ride

 Getting around:  **Taxi**  PHP 210–250 to Batac (~11 km); PHP 430–550 to Laoag (~29 km)

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Paoay Church & Malacañang of the North** — Paoay's Saint Augustine Church (1710) is the definitive example of Earthquake Baroque, with massive flying buttresses...
- **Paoay Sand Dunes 4x4 Ride** — A desert beside the sea — kilometre-wide dunes rolling down to the Ilocos coast.
- **Vigan Heritage City Walk** — Calle Crisologo's cobblestone streets and centuries-old Spanish colonial mansions are unlike anywhere in Southeast Asia.
- **Pangil Coral Rock Formations** — Massive fossilized coral formations sculpted by tidal erosion over millennia — dark, dramatic, and very photogenic...
- **Ilocano Food Trail** — Ilocano cuisine is one of the Philippines' most distinct — bagnet (double-fried crispy pork belly), Ilocos empanada...

BEST WALKS

- **Pangil Coastal Walk** 1–2 km · Easy · 45–60 min — Tricycle to the Pangil rock formations, then pick your way along the fossilized coral coastline.
- **Currimao Town Stroll** 1.5 km · Easy · 30 min — Walk or tricycle to the poblacion, take a look at the Spanish-era Tabacalera tobacco warehouse ruins, and browse the small local...

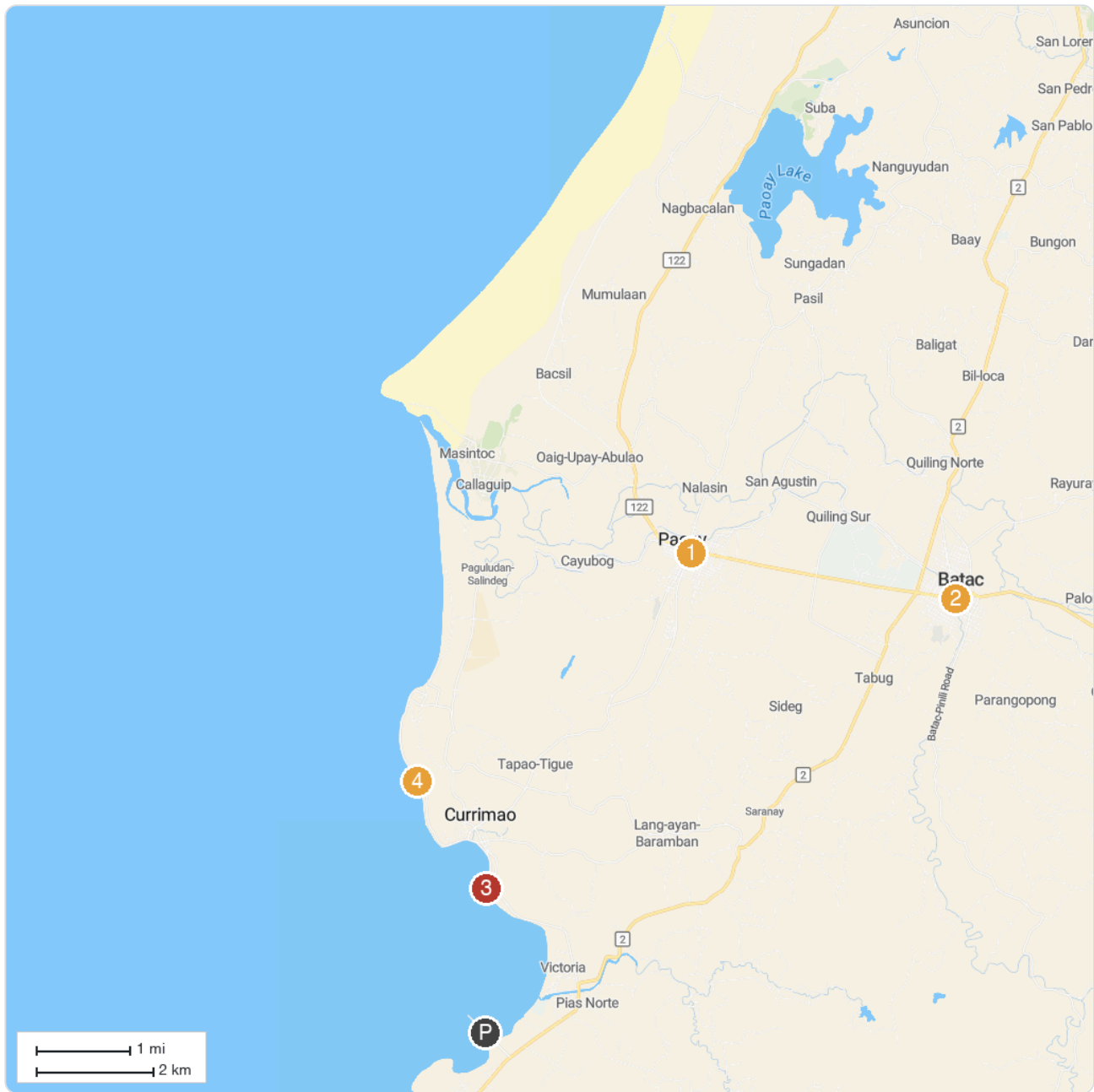
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
