GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Tien Sa Port, Son Tra Peninsula — ~10-15 km from city center

Best For: Hoi An Ancient Town, My Son Sanctuary, Marble Mountains, Ba Na Hills

Walk to center: Not walkable — taxi or Grab required (~20 min, ~\$5-8 USD)

Don't Miss: Hoi An's lantern-lit old town — allow at least 3-4 hours

TOP THINGS TO DO

- Hoi An Ancient Town** — The jewel of Central Vietnam: a beautifully preserved UNESCO trading port with lantern-hung streets, the Japanese...
 - My Son Sanctuary** — Haunting ruins of the ancient Champa Kingdom, set in a jungle valley — Vietnam's own Angkor on a smaller scale.
- Marble Mountains (Ngu Hanh Son)** — Five limestone karst hills honeycombed with caves, ancient pagodas, and sweeping views over Da Nang's coastline.
 - Ba Na Hills & Golden Bridge** — Cable car up to a French-colonial hilltop resort at 1,400 m elevation.
 - Lady Buddha & Son Tra Peninsula** — The 67-metre Lady Buddha statue at Linh Ung Pagoda is visible from ships entering the harbour.

BEST WALKS

- Han River Waterfront Walk** 2-3 km | Flat | Best in late afternoon — A pleasant riverside stroll along Bach Dang Street from the Dragon Bridge north past the Han River Bridge — Vietnam's only swing...
- Hoi An Ancient Town Self-Guided Walk** 2 km | Flat | Allow 3-4 hrs — The old town is compact and extremely walkable.

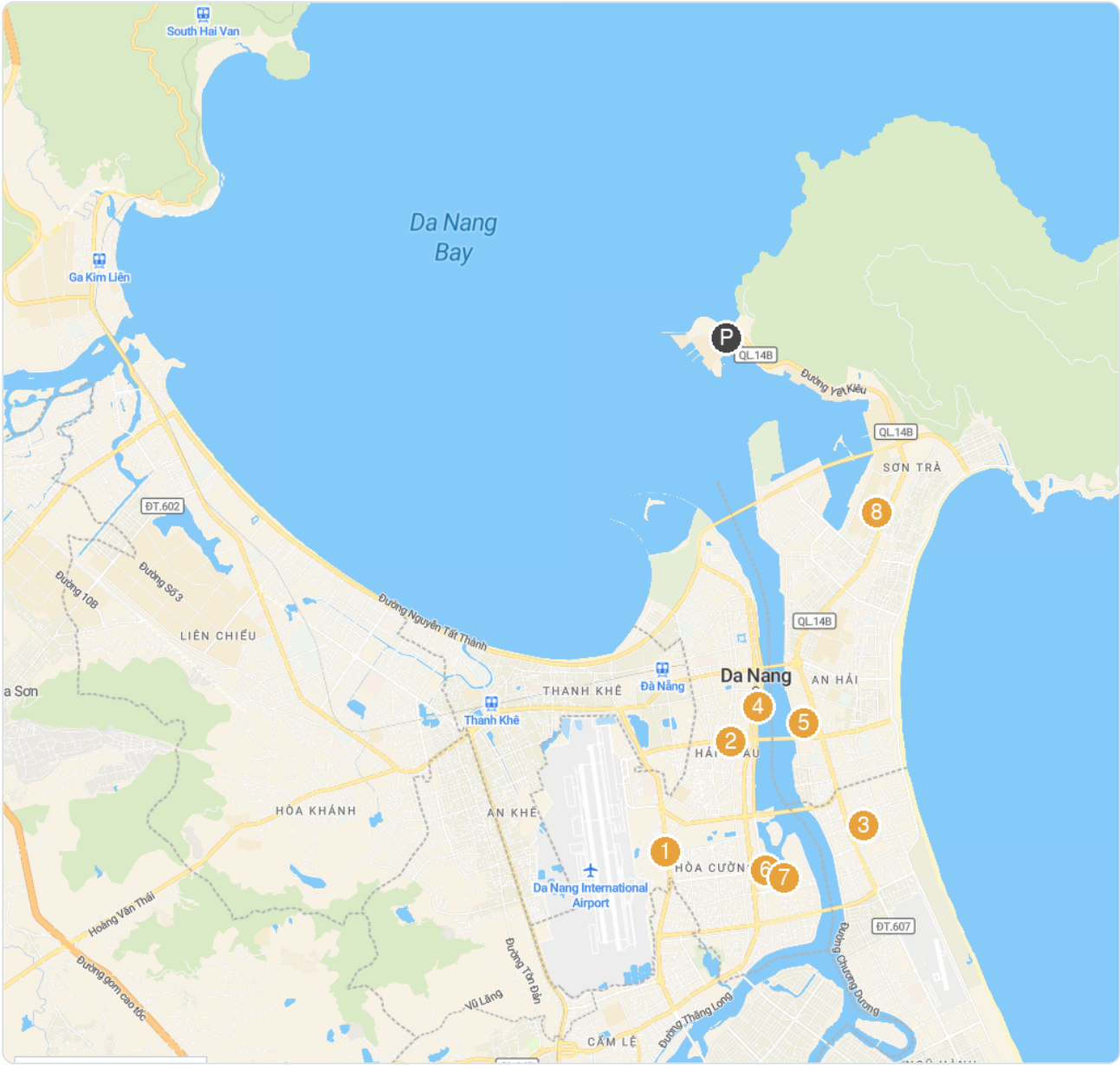
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Use Vietnamese Dong. USD is accepted some places but you'll get better value with VND. ATMs are plentiful downtown; withdraw before heading to Hoi An where ATM queues can be long.
- Book Hoi An transport in advance. Grab works well in Da Nang city, but rideshare availability to/from Hoi An is patchier — pre-book
