TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Gorée Island** — The UNESCO-listed island offshore — the House of Slaves and its 'Door of No Return,' pastel colonial houses, and a...
- **African Renaissance Monument** — The colossal 49 m bronze statue on a hilltop — taller than the Statue of Liberty — with sweeping views over Dakar and...
- **City & Sandaga Market** — Downtown Plateau, the Independence Square, the Grand Mosque, and the teeming Sandaga and Kermel markets — color...
- **Lake Retba (Pink Lake)** — The famous rose-colored salt lake northeast of the city, where salt collectors work the shallows — a striking...

BEST WALKS

- **Plateau & Independence Square** ~2 km · 1.5 hrs · easy — The downtown core — Place de l'Indépendance, the colonial-era Gouvernance and cathedral, and the lively streets toward the Kermel...
- **Kermel Market** ~1 km · 1 hr · easy — The atmospheric covered market in a restored colonial hall — flowers, crafts, spices, and Senegalese textiles near the port.
- **Corniche viewpoints** short taxi · 1 hr · easy — The coastal Corniche road with Atlantic views, the Mosque of the Divinity at Ouakam, and the African Renaissance Monument on its hill.

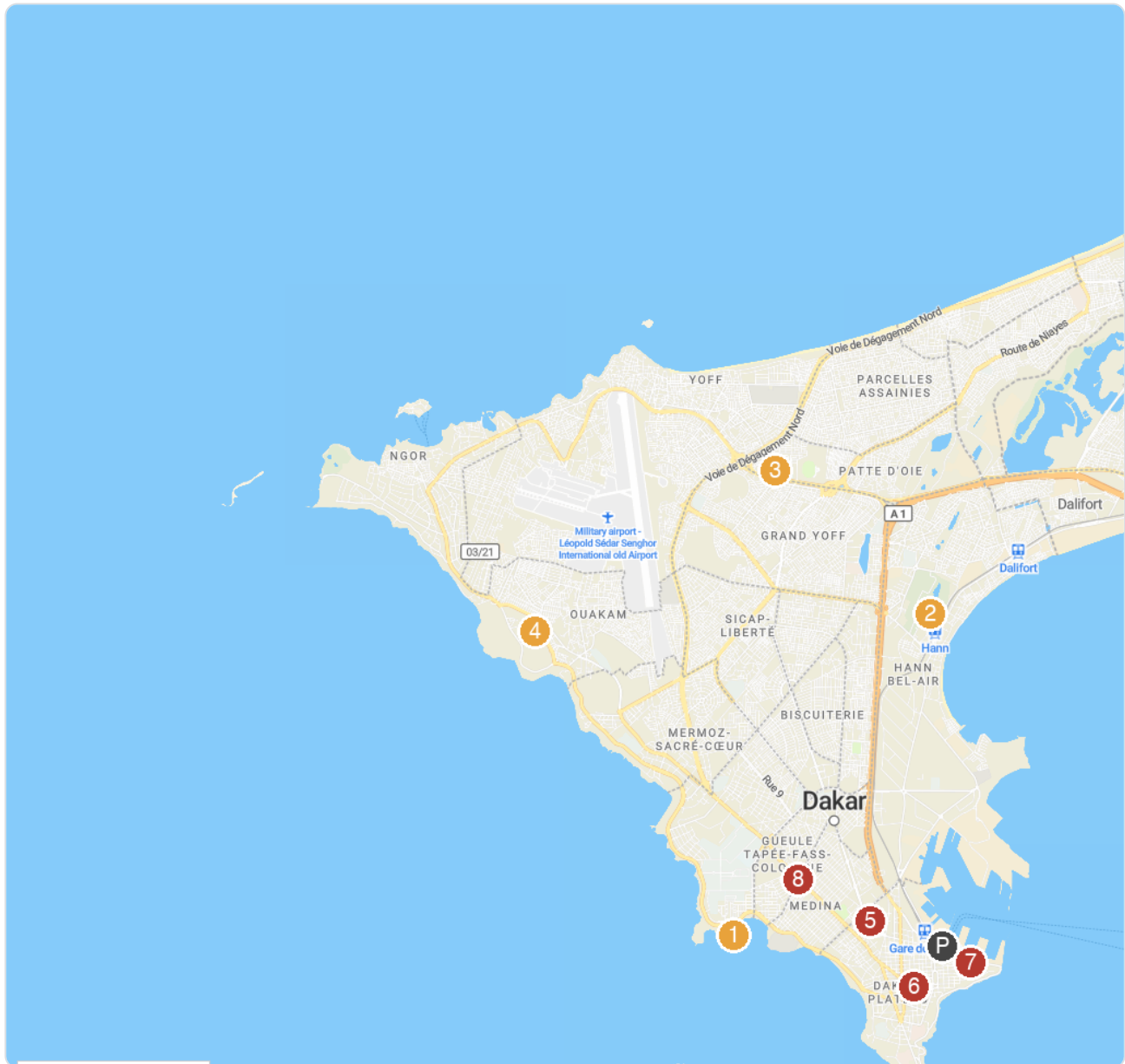
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
