GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Alongside berth at Port of Dar es Salaam — no tendering. Industrial cargo port; port shuttle required to gate.

Best For: Culture, history, Zanzibar day trip, wildlife safari excursions, Swahili cuisine

Walk to centre: Not walkable from port gates — take a tuk-tuk (bajaji), Uber/Bolt, or tour vehicle. National Museum is ~15 min by taxi.

Don't Miss: Kivukoni Fish Market at dawn, Tingatinga Arts Cooperative, or the fast ferry to Zanzibar

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Dar City Highlights & National Museum** — Hit the National Museum & House of Culture (home to Olduvai Gorge fossils and slave-trade exhibits), the Azania Front...
- **Fast Ferry to Zanzibar Stone Town** — Board the Azam Marine high-speed ferry (1 hr 45 min) to Zanzibar and spend a few hours exploring Stone Town's labyrinth...
- **Bongoyo Island Marine Reserve** — A 30-minute boat from The Slipway puts you on a pristine white-sand island in the Dar es Salaam Marine Reserve.
- **Mikumi or Nyerere Day Safari** — Dar is the gateway to Tanzania's southern wildlife circuit.
- **Kivukoni Fish Market & Street Food Walk** — Start at dawn as fishermen auction the catch — sailfish, red snapper, octopus — then wander to nearby stalls for chips...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront Heritage Loop** 1.5 km · 30 min · Flat — From the Kivukoni Ferry Terminal, walk south past the Azania Front Lutheran Church (1898), St.
- **Msasani Slipway & Oyster Bay** By taxi · Coco Beach & waterfront — Take a tuk-tuk or Uber to The Slipway — a waterfront complex with craft markets, boutiques, and seafood restaurants.

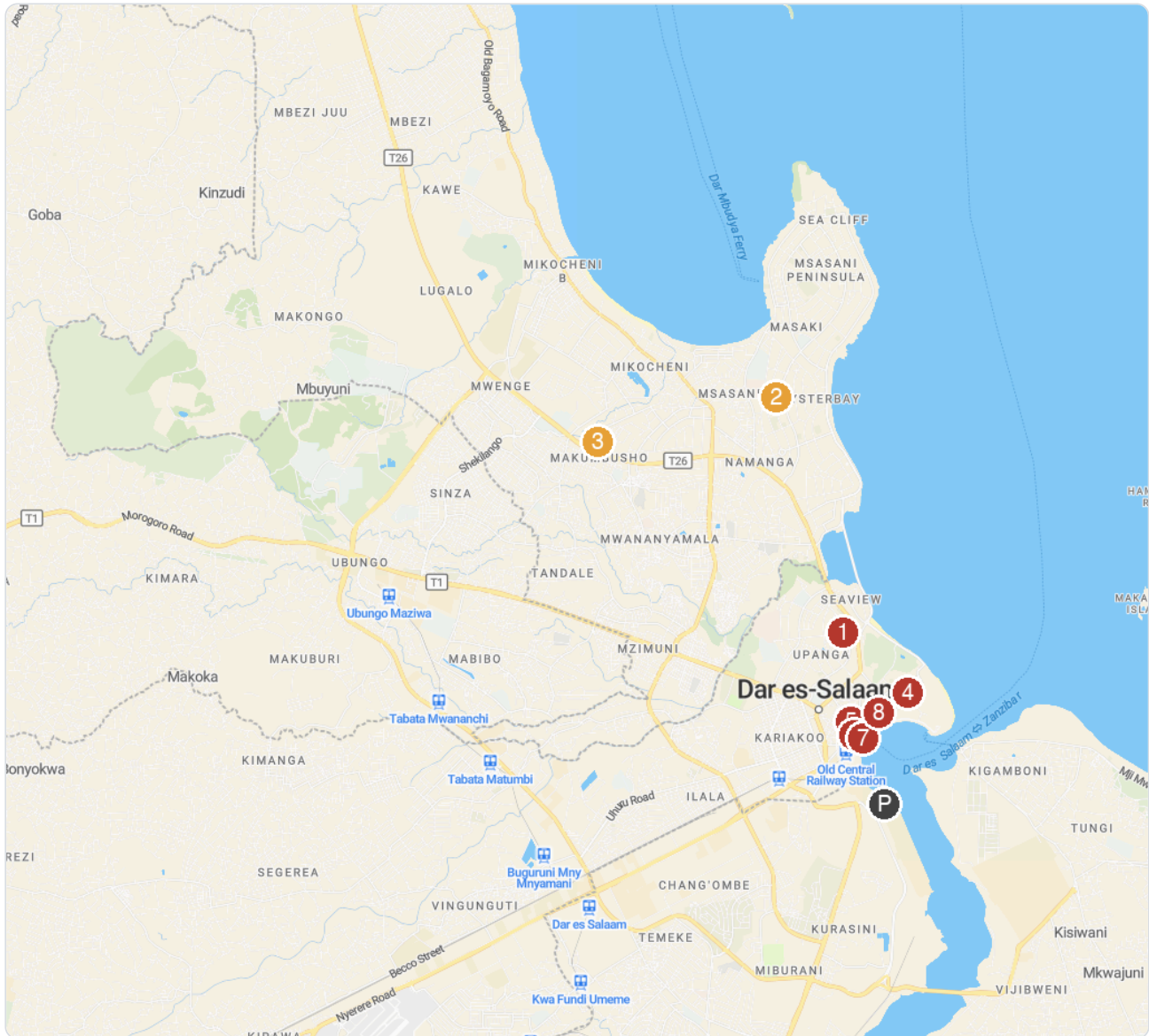
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
