Docking: Ships anchor in the River Dart; ship's tenders run to the Town Jetty in the heart of Dartmouth

Best For: Castles, maritime history, riverside walks, Agatha Christie's Greenway

Walk to Centre: Tender lands you on the waterfront — the town centre is right at the jetty

Don't Miss: Dartmouth Castle, guarding the narrow estuary mouth for over 600 years

- Dartmouth Castle by River Ferry** — Dartmouth Castle has guarded the narrow mouth of the Dart Estuary for over 600 years.
 - Britannia Royal Naval College Tour** — Perched on the hill above town, the BRNC (built 1905) is where all Royal Navy officers are trained — and where Princess...
 - Greenway — Agatha Christie's Holiday Home** — The Queen of Crime's beloved Georgian holiday house sits in
- romantic woodland gardens sweeping down to the Dart.

 - Dartmouth Steam Railway & River Cruise** — The 'Round Robin' combines a nostalgic steam train along the South Devon coast (Kingswear-Paignton), a river cruise on...
 - Dartmouth Waterfront & Seafood** — Dartmouth's narrow streets and South Embankment brim with pubs, cafes, and acclaimed seafood.

BEST WALKS

- Historic Town & Bayard's Cove** 1.5 km · 30-45 min · Easy · Some cobbles — From the Boat Float, wander the South Embankment to cobbled Bayard's Cove — where the Pilgrim Fathers reputedly stopped for repairs on...
- Riverside to Dartmouth Castle** 3 km · 60-75 min · Moderate · Some climbs — Follow the South Embankment and Castle Road along the estuary, with views across to Kingswear, out to Dartmouth Castle and St Petroc's...

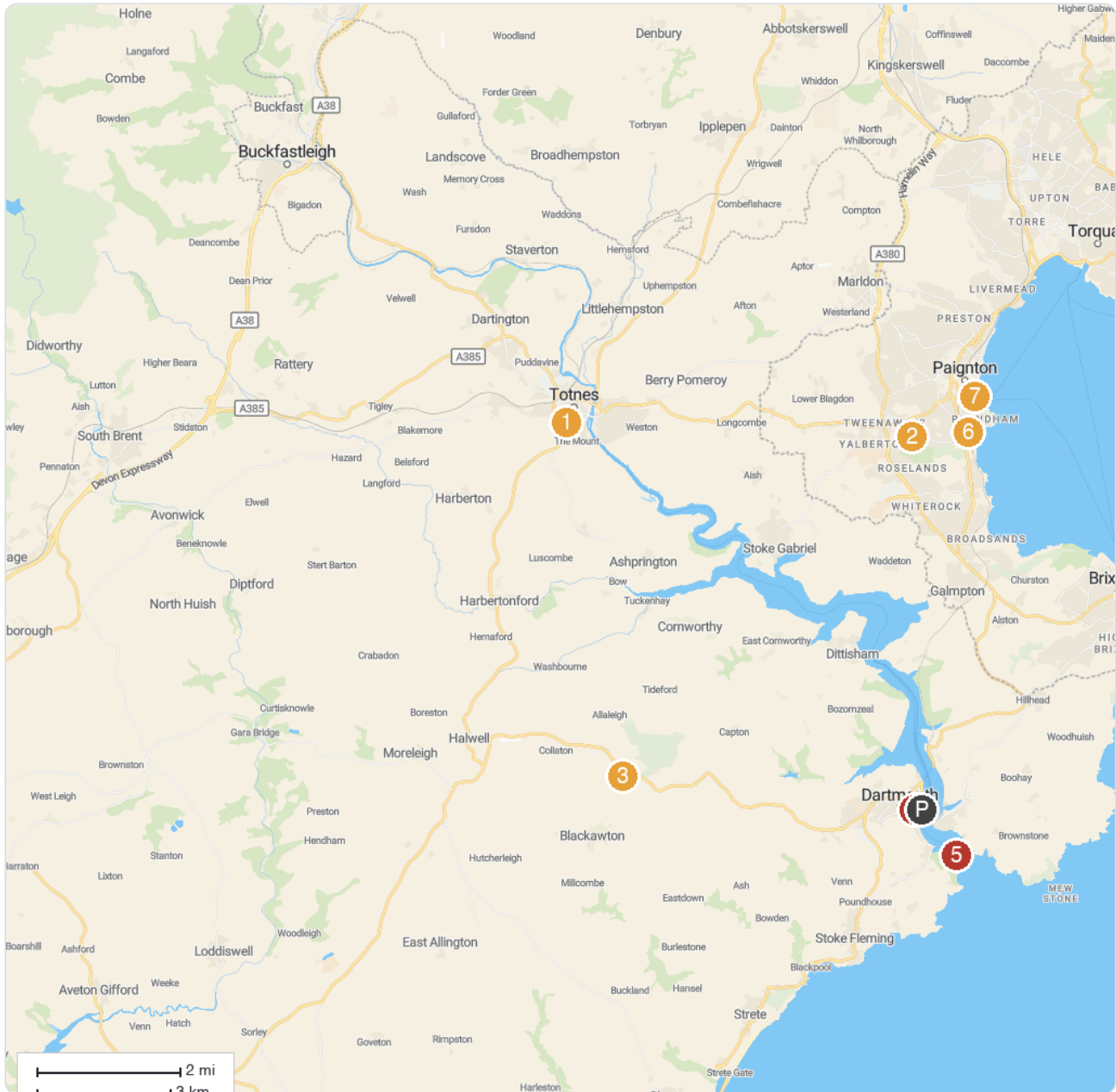
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
