TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Crocosaurus Cove — Cage of Death** — Right in the Darwin CBD, Crocosaurus Cove lets you descend into a perspex cage surrounded by massive saltwater...
- **WWII Oil Storage Tunnels & Military History** — Darwin was bombed more times than Pearl Harbor.
- **Museum & Art Gallery of the NT** — Darwin's excellent free museum houses the preserved wreck of Sweetheart (a famous 5-metre problem croc), the haunting...
- **Litchfield National Park Day Trip** — About 100 km south of Darwin, Litchfield delivers spectacular spring-fed waterfalls (Wangi, Florence, Tolmer), magnetic...
- **Jumping Crocodile Cruise** — A cruise up the Adelaide River (about 60 km east of Darwin) where wild saltwater crocodiles launch out of the water for...

BEST WALKS

- **Waterfront to CBD Loop** ~3 km · 1.5 hrs · easy (flat) — From the Waterfront Precinct wave lagoon, stroll along the boardwalk to Darwin's compact CBD, past Bicentennial Park's clifftop views...
- **WWII Tunnels & Waterfront Walk** ~2 km · 1 hr · easy — A short walk from the wharf area to the WWII Oil Storage Tunnels, then back along the waterfront esplanade with views of Darwin...

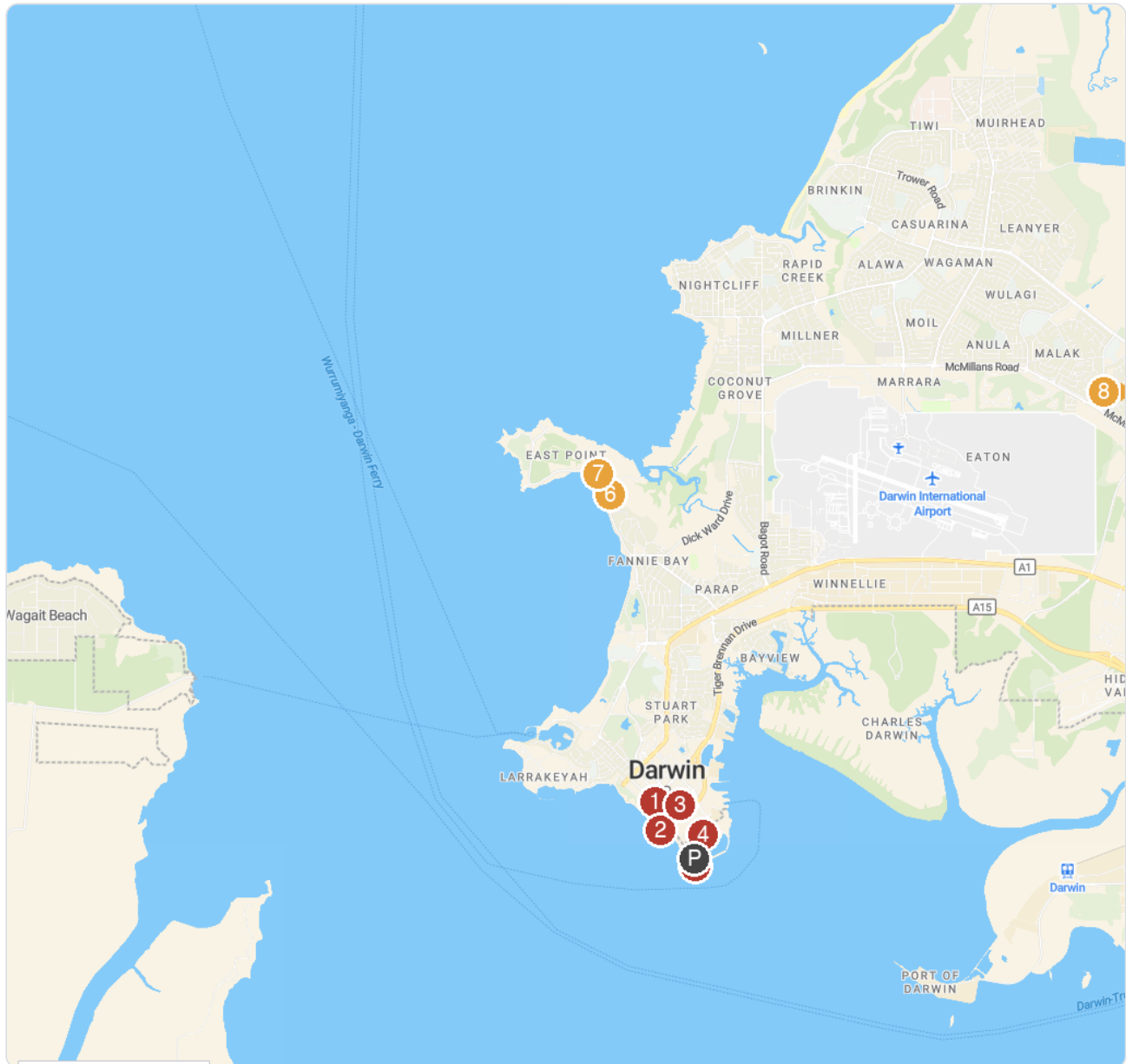
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- It is always hot. Darwin sits 12° south of the equator. Expect 30–35 °C with high humidity during cruise season. Carry water, wear a hat, and pace yourself.
- Do not swim in the harbour or unknown water. Saltwater crocodiles are present in Darwin Harbour and surrounding waterways. Stick to designated swimming areas like the Waterfront...
- Check the Mindil Beach Market dates. The famous Thursday/Sunday evening market runs April–October only. If your port day falls

- 1** **Crococaurus Cove** City wildlife park with crocodiles, reptiles, and aquatic life.
- 3** **Mason Gallery** Gallery showcasing contemporary and traditional Indigenous Australian art.
- 5** **Fort Hill Wharf** Main cruise ship terminal and port area.
- 7** **Mangrove Boardwalk** Scenic boardwalk through a unique mangrove ecosystem.
- P** **Cruise port / terminal**

- 2** **Darwin Cenotaph War Memorial** Memorial commemorating Darwin's war service and sacrifice.
- 4** **Darwin Waterfront Precinct** Vibrant precinct with swimming lagoon, restaurants, and shops.
- 6** **Lake Alexander** Man-made saltwater lake for swimming and recreation.
- 8** **Holmes Jungle Nature Park** Natural park with walking trails and diverse wildlife.
