 - **Davenport Skybridge** — A 575-foot pedestrian bridge suspended 50 feet over River Drive (Highway 67), offering

 - **German American Heritage Center** — Housed in an 1860s immigrant hotel right by the bridge, this museum chronicles the German settlers who founded...
 - **Riverfront & LeClaire Park Walk** — Davenport's open, floodwall-free riverfront is unique on the Mississippi — stroll paved paths past the historic...

BEST WALKS

- **Riverfront to Downtown Core** 1.2 mi / ~25 min / Flat — Walk north from the dock along the paved Mississippi River Trail past LeClaire Park, the Skybridge, and the Freight House into the...
- **East Davenport Village Stroll** Historic brick streets / Short drive or shuttle — The Village of East Davenport is a preserved 1850s logging district with brick streets, boutique shops, pubs, and Lagomarcino's...

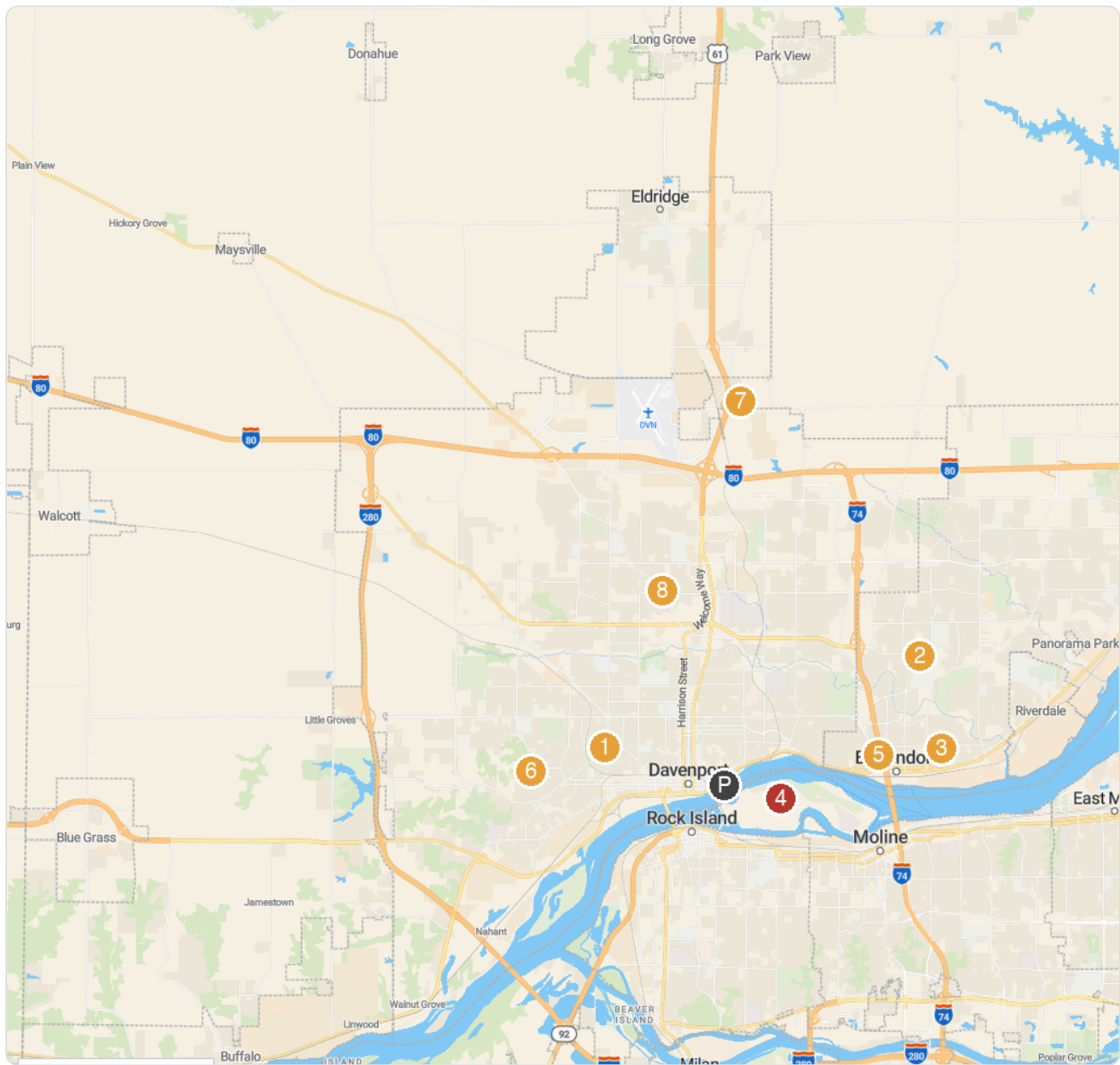
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
