GETTING ASHORE

Docking: Ships dock at Deggendorf quay on the left bank of the Danube, ~10 min walk to Stadtplatz

Walk to center: ~10–12 min on foot from quay to Market Square

Best For: Authentic Bavarian culture, river cycling, Metten Abbey day trip

Don't Miss: The Basilika St. Peter und Paul's Baroque tower and a Weißwurst breakfast before noon

TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Benedictine Monastery of Metten** — Just 5 km west, Kloster Metten houses one of the finest Baroque libraries in Germany — over 45,000 volumes surrounded...
- **Passau: City of Three Rivers** — An hour by train or coach, Passau sits where the Inn, Ilz, and Danube converge.
- **Bavarian Forest National Park** — Germany's oldest national park begins a short drive east of Deggendorf.
- **Danube Cycle Path (Donauradweg)** — Rent a bike at the center and pedal the flat, paved Donauradweg.
- **Regensburg UNESCO Old Town** — About 80 km upstream, Regensburg's well-preserved medieval center is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

BEST WALKS

- **Quay to Stadtplatz Town Walk** 1.5–2 hrs · Easy · Flat — Walk from the riverside quay along the Danube promenade to the Stadtplatz.
- **Riverside & Kapuzinerstadl Loop** 45 min · Easy · Flat — A short loop from the quay north along the river, then inland to the Kapuzinerstadl cultural center (a converted Capuchin monastery...

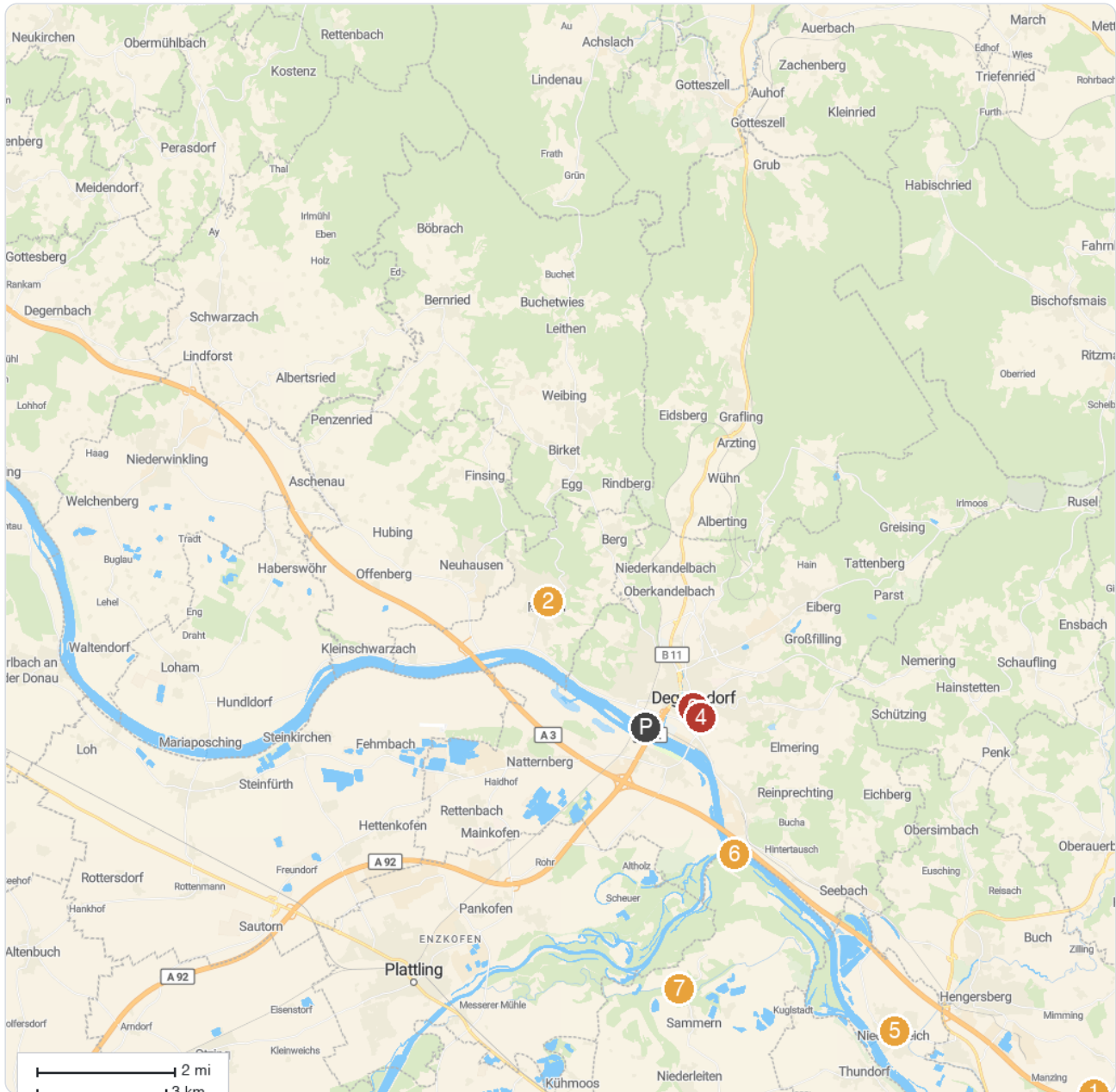
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO
