TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Groningen City Day Trip** — Board the train at Delfzijl Station and reach Groningen's lively city center in 37 minutes.
- **MuzeeAquarium Delfzijl** — This compact triple-threat museum covers maritime history, Wadden Sea archaeology (fossils and finds), and a live...
- **Appingedam Hanging Kitchens** — Just 4 km away, Appingedam is a medieval gem where kitchens were built suspended over the Damsterdiep canal due to...
- **Wadden Sea Dike Walk** — Climb the massive sea dikes protecting Delfzijl and walk the Eemsboulevard.
- **Inspector Maigret Walk** — Detective fiction history was made in Delfzijl.

BEST WALKS

- **Harbor & Town Loop** 2 km · 30 min · flat — Walk from the Handelskade quay across the lock gates to Landstraat, past the Vestinggracht moat park, to the Maigret statue near the...
- **Dike & City Beach Walk** 2.5 km · 35 min · breezy — Head north along the Eemsboulevard dike for panoramic views over the Ems estuary toward Germany.

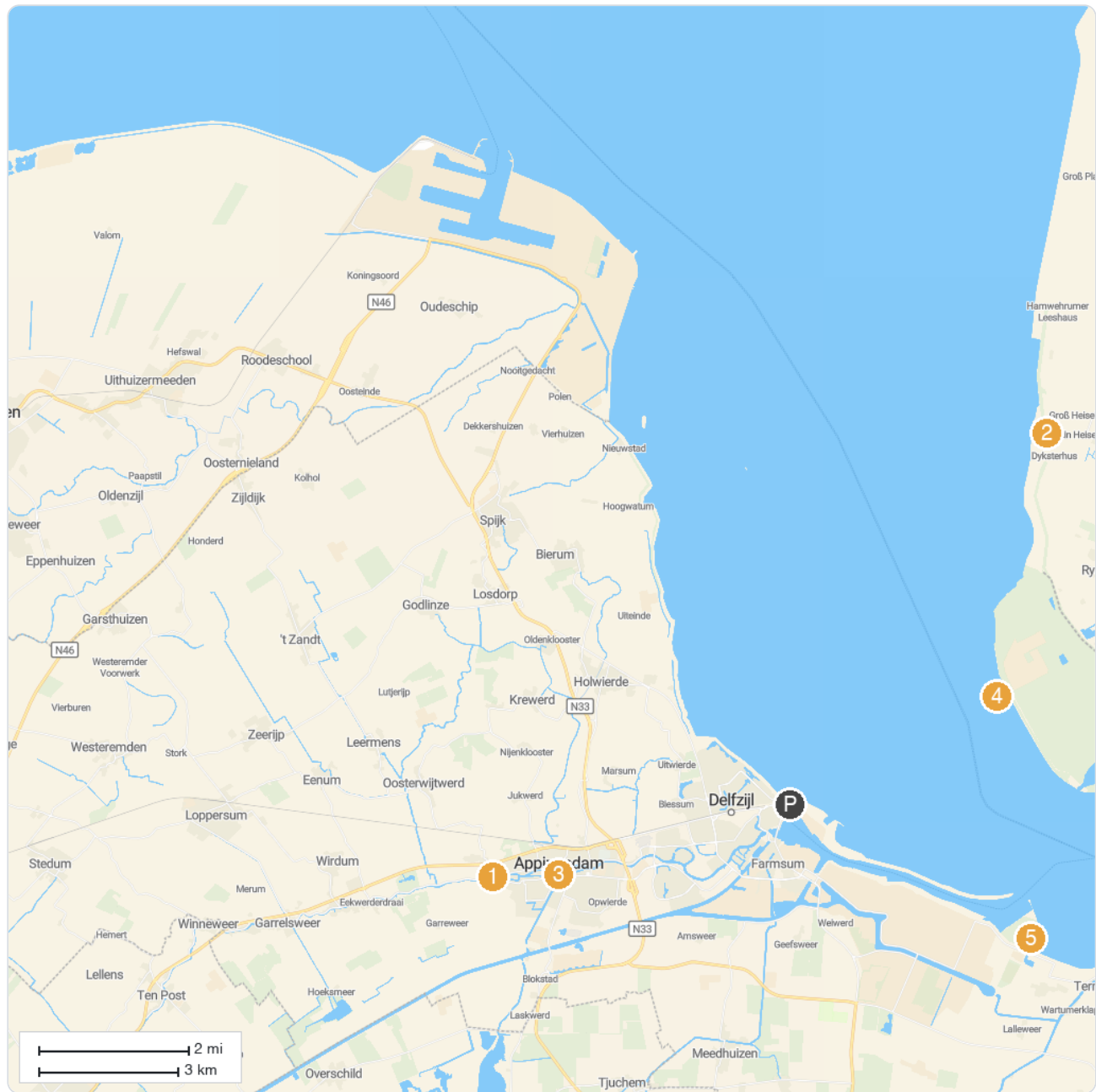
KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- Don't miss Groningen City. The train from Delfzijl Station takes just 37 minutes and runs twice per hour — easily the best use of a full call day here.
- Dress for wind. Delfzijl sits on the open Ems estuary and can be very breezy. Bring a windbreaker even if the forecast looks sunny.
- Try kibbeling. Deep-fried battered fish served with garlic sauce is a Dutch street-food staple — look for it at harbor-side stalls or market days.
