TOP THINGS TO DO

- **Navy Museum & Submarine Tour** — Explore three centuries of Dutch naval history at the Marinemuseum in Willemsoord.
- **Texel Island Day Trip** — Catch the hourly TESO ferry (20 min crossing) to the largest Wadden island.
- **Fort Kijkduin & North Sea Aquarium** — Cycle 3 km to this Napoleonic fort (built 1811-13) in Huisduinen.
- **Huisduinen Beach & Dunes** — Ride 4 km to a wide, white-sand North Sea beach backed by rolling dunes.
- **National Lifeboat Museum** — Also at Willemsoord, this interactive museum tells the stories of Dutch sea rescuers with storm simulators and historic...

BEST WALKS

- **Willemsoord to City Center** 1.2 km · 15 min · Flat — Walk east from the pier through the historic Willemsoord naval yard, past the dry docks and 19th-century brick workshops, then along...
- **Dike Walk to TESO Ferry Terminal** 1.5 km · 20 min · Flat — Head north from Willemsoord along the sea dike for views of the Marsdiep and Texel.

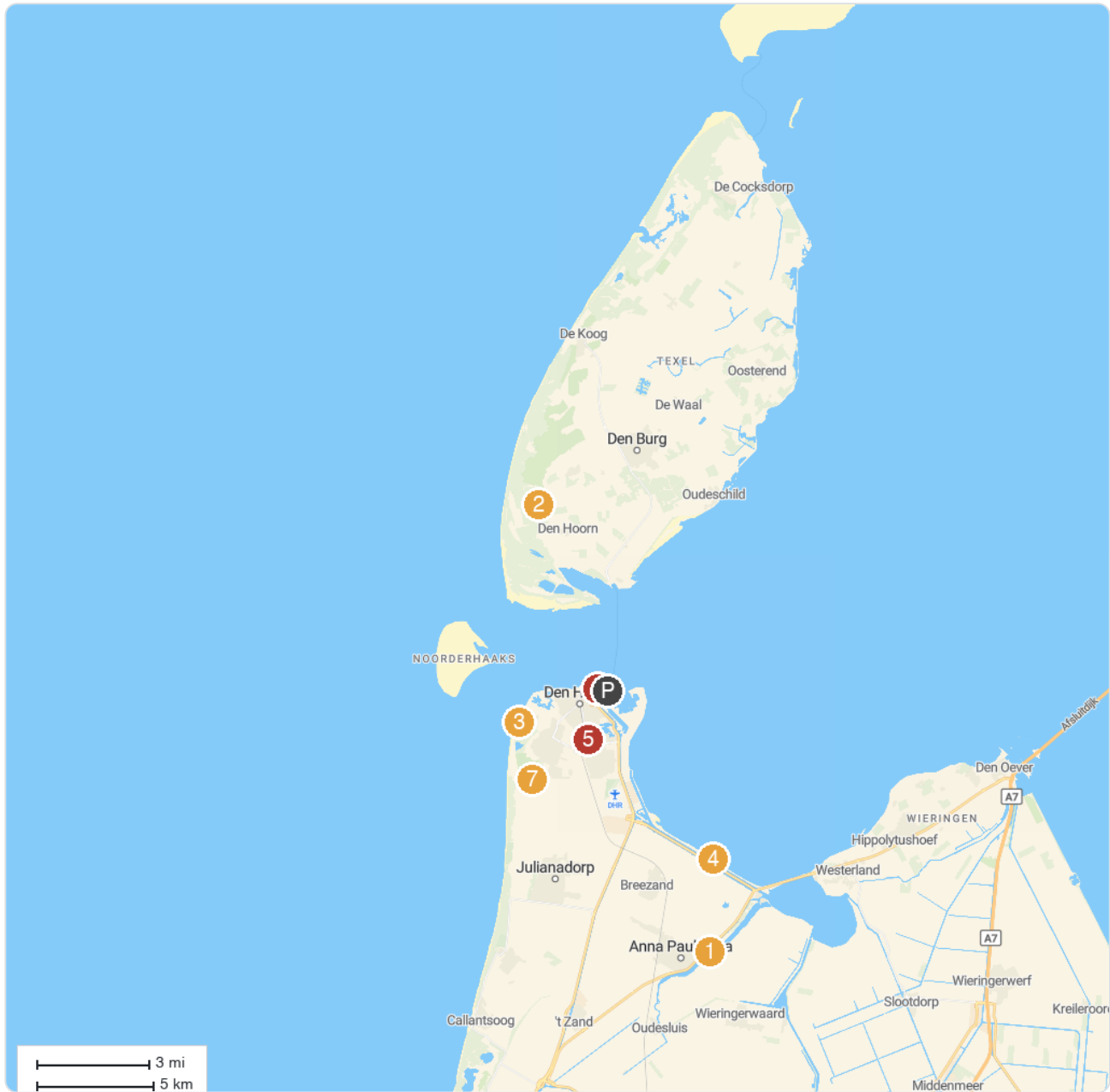
